





## **AV Component Hookup**

If you have an HDMI-compatible TV and players, you can connect them to the AV receiver with HDMI cables. The audio and video signals received via the HDMI inputs are output by the HDMI OUT as they are (pass-through). To listen through the speakers connected to the AV receiver, please make the audio connections shown below.


If your TV or player doesn't support HDMI, use the analog or digital connections shown below.




## **Assigning the HDMI Input**
