

1. Introduction

Your Simplicity® DVR remote control is simple to program, easy to use, and can operate two (2) devices, which include:

CABLE Digital cable set-top terminals

TV Televisions

Before you can use your remote control, it must be programmed (setup) to operate the above devices.

Programming your remote is a simple procedure using Point and Press® Programming, an automatic method whereby the remote self-programs to your TV, without using codes.

2. Installing / Replacing Batteries

Install four (4) new "AA" batteries as indicated by the diagram in the battery compartment.

When the indicator light becomes dim or no longer illuminates during use, install 4 new "AA" size batteries.

Your remote control has Memory Guard®, which eliminates reprogramming after battery changes.

3. Operating Your Cable Terminal

Your Simplicity® DVR remote control supports the newest digital set-top terminals from Scientific-Atlanta and Motorola. It is designed to control channels and other features on your cable terminal, as well as power, volume / mute on your TV.

Model RT-U27A DVR is pre-programmed to operate the Motorola DCT® 62xx series digital set-top terminal.

Model RT-U27B DVR is pre-programmed to operate the Scientific-Atlanta Explorer® 8000 series digital set-top terminal.

Model RT-U27AB DVR is pre-programmed to operate the Motorola DCT® 62xx digital set-top terminal running Passport software.

Note: If you do not have a cable set-top terminal and wish to control channels through your TV, refer to Section 5 after you've programmed your remote to operate your TV (Section 4)

4. Programming Your TV

If you have a TV that's operated by remote control, it is recommended that you plug it directly into a wall outlet instead of the cable set-top terminal.

Programming Your TV by Code Entry Method

- 1. Turn on the TV you want to program your remote to operate.
- 2. Press [SEL] ([OK]), then [MUTE] together until the LED illuminates.
- 3. a.Locate the 3-digit code for your brand in the <u>TV Setup Code</u> list and enter it on the keypad of the remote control. Entry of the correct code will cause your TV to turn off.

If multiple codes are listed for your brand, you may have to enter several different codes until your TV turns off.

b.As soon as you have entered a 3-digit code that turns your TV off, press [MUTE].

1.If your TV turns back on, press [SEL] ([OK]) to lock in the code. The LED will blink and go out.

Or

2. If the TV does not turn back on, enter a different 3-digit setup code until your TV turns back on. Then press [SEL] ([OK]) to lock in the code. The LED will blink and go out.

Programming Your TV by Point and Press® Method

- 1. Turn on the TV you want to program your remote to operate.
- 2. Press [SEL] ([OK]), then [MUTE] together until the LED illuminates.
- 3. Press and hold the [CH ▲] button until your TV turns off. While you are pressing the [CH ▲] button, the LED will blink.

As soon as your TV turns off, release the [CH ▲] button.

- 4. Press [MUTE]. If your TV...
- a. Turns back on, press [SEL] ([OK]) to lock in this code. The LED will blink and go out.

Or

b.Does not turn back on, press [CH ▼] one step at a time until your TV turns back on. Each time you press the [CH ▼] button, the LED will blink.

Once you have found a code that turns your TV on / off, press [SEL] ([OK]) to lock in this code. The LED will blink and go out.

5. Programming Channel Control-If You Don't Have A Cable Set-Top Terminal.

When you first program your Simplicity® DVR remote, it will control channels (CH +/-, 0-9, Last) through your cable set-top terminal.

If you do not have a cable set-top terminal and wish to control these features on your TV, follow these steps:

- 1. Press [CBL POWER], then [MUTE] together hold both buttons down until the LED illuminates.
- 2.Press [0, 0, 0]. Each time you enter a 0, the LED will blink green and remain illuminated.
- 3. When you enter the third digit (0), the LED blink three times and go

Note: when controlling functions / channels on the TV (VOL+/-, MUTE, 0 - 9, Ch +/-, LAST, SEL), the LED will Illuminate green.

To return channel control through your <u>Cable set-top terminal</u>, repeat step 1 above, then press [9, 9, 9] in step 2.

6. Programming Volume Control

When you first program your Simplicity® DVR remote, volume and mute are controlled through your TV.

To program volume control to your Cable set-top terminal:

- 1. Press [CBL POWER], then [MUTE] together until the LED illuminates.
- 2. Press [VOL ▲], then [CBL POWER] for Cable volume.
- 3. The LED will blink and go out.

[SWAP] - Swap tuners in dual-tuner Motorola DVR terminals. (RT-U27A DVR)

[PPV] - Display PPV events. (RT-U27A DVR) (RT-U27A DVR)

[EXIT] - Exit Program Guide, menu. (RT-U27A DVR)

To program volume control to your TV:

- 1. Press [CBL POWER], then [MUTE] together until the LED illuminates.
- 2. Press [VOL ▲], then [TV POWER] for TV volume.
- 3. The LED will blink and go out.

7. Code Number Readback

To identify the 3-digit TV setup code stored under the Point and Press™, method...

- 1. Press [TV POWER], then [MUTE] together until the LED illuminates.
- 2. Press [LAST / FAV] to identify your TV setup code. The indicator light will "blink back" the code numbers, with a 1-second interval between each digit of the code.

Example: For code "035", the indicator light will blink 10 times, then 3 times, then 5 times.

8. Resetting Your Remote

To reset your remote control to its default settings...

- 1. Press [CBL POWER], then [MUTE] together until the LED illuminates.
- 2. Press [CBL POWER], then [CBL POWER] again. The LED will blink and go out.

9. Helpful Tips and Troubleshooting

1. Your remote is equipped with a Point and Press® Programming label on the back of its case. This will help you quickly program the remote

OR

without using codes.

until your TV turns on and off.

b. you may have gone past the correct matching code. Try pressing [CH ▼] one step at a time until you find a code that turns your TV back on

2. The LED will remain on while the remote is in a programming mode.

3. When using the Point and Press® programming method, you may

find a code that turns your TV off but not back on. If this happens...

a.the correct code has not been found. Continue pressing [CH ▲]

In the absence of an entry, the LED will go out after 45 seconds.

When locking in your devices, the LED will blink and go out.

- 4. If you have any questions concerning the operation of your Cable set-top terminal, contact your cable operator.
- 5. Time Out If the same button is pressed and held for 45 seconds, your remote control will turn itself off automatically.

This extends battery life should the remote become lodged under or between heavy objects, for example sofa cushions.

10. Using Your Remote Control

The operation of each button on your Simplicity¢Á DVR remote is as follows:

[CBL Power] - Cable power on / off.

[TV Power] - TV power on / off.

[LIST] - Listing of DVR recordings

[REC] - Record DVR program

[0] - [9] - Enter channel numbers.

[MUTE] - Mute volume.

[INFO] - Display channel / program information.

[SETTINGS] / [MENU] - Display digital terminal settings.

[LAST / FAV] - Recall last or favorite channel.

[VOL ▲ / ▼] - Increase or decrease volume.

[CH ▲ / ▼] - Increase or decrease channel.

[▲, ▼, ◀, ▶] - Navigates through Program Guide, menu.

[SELECT] / [OK] - Select Program Guide choice.

[STOP] - Stop DVR program

[REW] - Rewind DVR Program

[PLAY] - Play DVR program

[FWD] - Fast forward DVR program

[PAUSE] - Pause DVR Program

[GUIDE] - View Program Guide.

[A], [B], [C] - On-screen decision buttons.
