Simple Troubleshooting Guide

The following checklist is helped to solve the problems which you meet when using the unit. Please double check and make sure if the connection and the procedure of the operation is properly before using the checklist below.

Problem	Cause/Solution
No power.	 Check and make sure whether the fuse is blown, replace with the proper value if necessary.
Some errors occur in the LCD or no function when pressing the button.	• Press RESET button.
Unable to receive stations.	• Check and make sure whether the antenna is inserted or the antenna is properly connected, if so, insert the antenna or connect it properly.
Poor effect on receiving a station.	 Antenna may not be the proper length. Make sure the antenna is fully extended; if broken, replace the antenna with a new one. The antenna is poorly grounded, check and make sure the antenna is properly grounded at its mounting location.
CDs cannot be loaded.	A CD is loaded in the mechanism.
Sound skips.	The CD is dirty or damaged.
No images.	The Video line from main unit to the TV is not connected properly.
Images skip.	 Improper setting of the color system. Set the color system to "PAL" or "NTSC" according to the connected television.

Note:

If any of the problem persist after check list had been made, consult your nearest service dealer. Never attempt to disassemble your unit by yourself.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS Abou

- Be sure to connect the color coded leads according to the diagram.
 Incorrect connections may cause the unit to malfunction or damage the vehicle's electrical system.
- Be sure to connect the speaker (-) leads to the speaker (-) terminal.
 Never connect the left and right channel speaker cables each other or to the vehicle body.
- Make sure all the connections are completely correct before turning on your unit.
- When replacing the fuse(s), the replacement must be of the same amperage as shown on the fuse holder.
- Do not block vents or radiator panels. Blocking them will cause heat to build up inside and may result in fire.
- 6. After completing the installation and beginning to play the unit(including replacing the battery), please remove the front panel at first, and then press RESET button on the base with pointed object (such as ball-point pen) to set the unit to initial status.

About this manual

This unit features a number of sophisticated functions ensuring superior operation. All the functions have been designed for the easiest po-ssible use, but many are not self-explanatory. This manual will help you understand the functions and operations of the unit. This manual main explains **remote control operation.** However, in addition to those functions related with DVD/VCD/CD/MP3 operation that can only be operated by the remote control, there are also functions can be operated by the buttons provided for the main unit.

Scanning/Memorizing Stations Automatically

During radio mode, briefly pressing **3 AMS** button to scan each stored station in cycle.

When press and hold AMS button, it will activate automatically memory storing function. The radio automatically selects a station and has it stored in any one of the Number Buttons from 1 to 6.

■ Notes:

Number Buttons

During radio mode, **Number Buttons** from 1 to 6 s can help you store your favorite station. You can follow the steps as below:

When receiving a station, press and hold any one of the Number Buttons until "CH" appears in the LCD, which indicates that station is already stored in the corresponding number button.


You can store up to 18 FM stations (6 each for FM1,FM2,FM3),up to 12AM stations (6 each for AM1/MW and AM2/LW).

Note:

* Pressing (§) 1~6 number buttons on the head unit performs the same function.

Band Selector

During radio status, repeatedly press **BAND** button to select bands in the following order:



(For Three Bands)

■ Note:

- * Press and hold BAND button to change the FM
- between USA and Europe.

 * Pressing BAND on the head unit performs the same function.

Manual/Automatic Tuning

Manual Tuning: Briefly pressing **()** (► or ►) button on the remote control continuously to select a station downward or upward respectively.

Automatic Tuning: Press and hold **6** (**▶** or **◄**) button for more than 3 seconds, the radio automatically searches a station downward or upward respectively and plays when it finds a station.

Note:

* Pressing ① button on the head unit performs the same function.

Selecting the Stored Station

During radio mode, press **6** ▲ to select the upward stored station, press **v** to select the downward stored station.

■ Note:

* This function is only operated by using remote control.

DX/LOC Selector

During radio status, press **3** LOC button on the remote control to select strong or weak station reception.

- 1 It is set to LOC mode when **3 LOC** button is first pressed. "LOC" appears on the display and only local station is available.
- 2 It is switched to DX mode when 3 LOC is pressed again. Both distance and local stations can be received.

Notes:

- * The initial mode is DX mode.
- * LOC mode is functional only in selecting & memorizing stations.
- * This function is only operated by using remote control.

MO/ST Selector

During radio status, you can press **3** ST button on the remote control to select **Mono** mode or **Stereo** mode.

- 1 Sterco reception is charged when "ST" and "D" appear.
- 2 It is switched to MONO mode when "ST" and "D" disappear.

■ Note:

* Pressing ⑦ ST button on the head unit performs the same function.

NOTE: The unit is compatible with $\ensuremath{\text{VCD1.0/2.0/3.0}}$ version and DVCD disc.

- Do not attempt to modify the unit, modifying the unit may cause an accident.
- Stop the vehicle before carrying out any operation that could interfere with your driving.
- Do not work in extremely high or low temperature. Be sure the temperature inside the vehicle is between +60° C and -10° C before turning on your unit.
- To enjoy optimum sound and images while playing, handle the discs as follows:
- ——Handle the disc by its edge to keep the disc clean, and do not touch the surface.

——Do not use your CDs with paste residue or ink attached.



——Do not use CDs with labels or stickers attached, which may leave a sticky residue while beginning to peel off. (Shown as the picture)



—Clean the discs with an optional cleaning cloth. Wipe each disc from the center out. (Shown as the picture)



Maintenance

Replacing the Fuse

Make sure the amperage matches the specified value when replacing the fuses. If the fuse is blown, check the power connection and replace with a new one. If the same problem occurs, it would be subjected to the malfunction. In such cases, please consult to the nearest service dealer.

A Warning

Never use the fuse with the rated amperage more than that supplied to your unit, otherwise it will damage the unit.


Replacing the Battery

When the range of the operation of the card remote control becomes short or no functions while operating. Replace the lithium battery with a new button cell (CR2025). Make sure the battery polarity before replace.

Gently pull out the Battery Holder while pressing the Stopper.



Put the button-type battery with mark(+) upward into the Battery Holder.



Insert the Battery Holder into the Remote



Precautions on Using Lithium Battery

Always keep the lithium battery beyond children's reach. In case swallowed, see a doctor immediately.

Cleaning the battery with a dry cloth, to ensure its perfect connected.

Make sure the proper polarity when loading with the battery.

To prevent short circuit, do not use metal tweezer to clip the battery.

▲ Warning!

Improper handle with the battery may lead to explosion.

It cannot be charged, disassembled or thrown into a fire.

Program Playing

VCD

During VCD mode, you can set the program order to play. Follow the steps as bellow: when playing a VCD, press button firstly, then press PGM button, the monitor will display:

Press \bullet [\blacktriangle] [\blacktriangledown] button to set the programs you desired, press \bullet [\blacktriangleleft] [\blacktriangleright] to remove the icon to $\stackrel{\square}{\Longrightarrow}$, then press ENTER. The tracks you selected appear in the "Program" menu, and press ENTER to play. During programs playing, press \bullet PGM button directly to cancel the playing.

Press **6** [**4**] [**▶**] button to remove the icon to **1**, all the tracks under "List" were transfer to "Program", then press **ENTER**. The all racks appear in the "Program" menu.

If you want to delete the tracks in "Program" one by one, Press **⑥** [◀] [▶] button to remove the icon to □.

If you want to delete all tracks in "Program", Press **6** [**4**] [▶] button to remove the icon to [**1**].

■ Note:

- * This function is operated by using the remote control.
- * Press 22 CLEAR to decrease the large image.

Pause the Playback

VCD

During VCD playback, press 9 II button to suspend the playback, LCD will display: "PAUSE", press it again to return to normal playback,

■ Note:

* Pressing | on the head unit also performs the same operation.

MO/ST Selector

During VCD playing, repeatedly press 4 AUDIO button to select MONO or STEREO mode as bellow:

Mono left → Stereo → Mono right

■ Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control.

Playing PBC (Menu)

During VCD status, firstly pressing TITLE, PBC playback starts and the menu of entire disc appears on the monitor. And then you can select your favorite track by using Number Buttons 5 . When a track is playing, you can press 16 button to return to the menu if you would like to end the track and select others. To cancel PBC playing, press 25 TITLE button again.

Note:

- * This function is operated by using the remote
- * PBC playing confirms to version 2.0 of SVCD/ DVD disc only.


Eject a Disc

Firstly press ② **REL** on the base, then press (3) ▲ button to eject a disc.



Press this button to turn on or off the unit, keep pressing it to turn on the LCD.

- ② RELEASE button

 Press REL button to release the front panel.
- (3) VOL/SEL button

Rotate (VOL) button clockwise to increase the volume level; and rotate (VOL) button anticlockwise to decrease the volume level. Press it to set the volume characteristics.

- 4 LCD (LIQUID CRYSTAL DISPLAY)
 To display current status.

 During radio mode, shortly press to scan each stored station 5 seconds.
 Hold and press it to activate automatically storing function.
- (15) NUMBER BUTTONS

 During radio mode, press for preset tuning; during playback mode, press for activating ▶||, RPT, INT, RDM, DOWN, UP functions.
- (16) Disc Loading Slot
- 17 Infrared Sensor
- (18) MUT button
 Press it to mute, press it again to resume
 to the initial status.

Number Buttons

During VCD status, you can select any track directly by using **3 Number Buttons(0~9)**. For example, if you need the 15th track, you can firstly press **Button 10+**, and then press **Button 5**, the corresponding track (15th) will be played.

Note:

- * This function is operated by using remote control only.
- * The continuously pressing should be within every 3 seconds.

Setting CDs Playback Time

During VCD status, press **② GOTO** button to set the time when you begin playing the track, and the television will display the time: -:---. Enter your desired time by using **③(0~9) Number Buttons.** Then press **⑥** ► to play the track. For example, enter <u>0:25:00</u>, it will automatically starts playing the track from the point of twenty-fifth minutes in the disc.

■ Note:

- * This function is operated by using the remote control.
- * Press 22 CLEAR to decrease the large image.

Repeat Playing

Press **① RPT** to perform replaying function when you need to repeat the track you like.

Firstly press **(1)** button to replay the current track.

Press it again to release single track replaying function.

■ Note:

- * Pressing **RPT** on the head unit also performs the same operation.
- * The default setting is Disc Repeat.

Scanning Tracks Automatically

During VCD status, press (3) **INT** button to play the first 10 seconds of each track on the disc, and the display shows *the track number* and *the elapsed time*.

Press it once more to revert to normal playing.

■ Notes:

- * This function can only be operated by the head unit.
- * It is valid in DISC REPEAT mode.

Playing Tracks in Random Order

During VCD status, when pressing **@ RDM** button, "*RDM*" will appear on the monitor, the unit plays any track at random. Press it again to return to the normally playing.

■ Note:

 Pressing RDM on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Stop the playback

During VCD mode, firstly pressing **(6)** ■ to pause playing, press **(6)** ► or **(9)** II to play, press ■ button twice to stop playing completely, press PLAY button to start playing.

■ Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control.

Basic operation of VCD

Insert a VCD disc into the slot, the unit will automatically switch on, if a VCD disc is loaded, press **2 SOURCE** on the remote control to start the playback.

■ Note:

* You can eject a disc by pressing ▲ on the base.

System Button

During VCD playback status, press **P/N** button to set the TV standard to PAL or NTSC system.

■ Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control.


Playing the Previous/Next Track

During VCD playback, firstly pressing **6** to replay the current track, press **6** within 3 seconds to play the previous track, press to play the next track.

Note:

* Pressing 12 button on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Playing Track F.F/F.REW



Note:

* Pressing ② button on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Slow motion playback

During VCD playback, press
■ to go slow forward. There are 5 speeds each press decreases the speed until the minimum speed is reached.



■ Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control.

Increase the Size of the Picture

During VCD playback, press **5 ZOOM** to increase the picture in size. There are 2 sizes. Each press increases he size until the maximum size is reached.

■ Note:

- * This function is operated by using the remote control.
- * Pressing 8 to remove the image on the screen.
- * press CLEAR to decrease the large image.


On Screen Display

During VCD status, press **OSD** button on the card remote control, the display shows "single track elapsed time, single track left time, the track being played and the amount of the whole disc"

Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control.

During radio mode, press it to select the mono or stereo channel; during DVD mode, press it to select the audio language.

(0-9) /A~Z (Number/Letter) Buttons During radio mode, press 1-6 buttons to select the preset stations; during playback mode, press to select track directly.



MP3 Menu Mode

* Insert a MP3 disc, the TV screen will display the picture as following:



In this picture, the right menu is the left menu's sub-menu, you can press \S [Number **Buttons**] to select tracks; or press \S [\Join / \Join] to select the front or rear track. If you'd like to select director or tracks quickly, please press \S [\blacksquare] firstly, then press \S [\blacktriangle] [\blacktriangledown], and then press \S [ENTER] button to enter what you do.

When playing a disc including PIC file, press $\{ [\ \blacksquare \] \}$ firstly, then press $\{ [\ \blacksquare \] \}$ [Title] to enter PHOTO menu, and then press $\{ [\ \blacksquare \] \}$ button to set up.

Under Mp3 status, press (5) 5/DOWN button to skip to play the previous 10th track of the current track. Such as from the 60th track skip to the 50th track. Press (6) 6/UP button to skip to the next 10th track of the current track; such as from the 60th track to the 70th track.



■ Note:

* Pressing on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Scanning Tracks Automatically

During CD status, press (3) **INT** button to play the first 10 seconds of each track on the disc, and the display shows *the track number* and *the elapsed time*.

Notes:

- * This function can only be operated by the head unit.
- * It is valid in DISC REPEAT mode.

ID3 Function

During MP3 status, press DID3 button to switch between ID3 ON and ID3 OFF.

During ID3 ON mode, the LCD displays the current moving Mp3 information.

During ID3 OFF mode, to perform the common Mp3 operation directly.

■ Notes:

* Pressing **BAND** on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Eject a Disc



Firstly press button to replay the current track. Press it again to cancel this function.

- * The default setting is Disc Repeat.

Playing Tracks in Random Order

During CD/MP3 playback status, when pressing **@ RDM** button on the remote control, **"RDM"** will appears on the monitor, the unit plays any track at random under the directory which you select. Press **RDM** again to return to normally playing.

■ Note:

* Pressing RDM on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Stop the playback




Detach the front panel before disassembling the unit. For more details regarding this section, refer to "Detach the Front Panel".

1. Take out the Outer Trim Frame after detaching the front panel.





Cleaning the Connector

If the connector between the main unit and the front panel is dirty, it may result the unit in abnormal working condition. To avoid such problems happening, please detach the front panel, and clean the connector with an alcohol swab. Gently clean and avoid damaging the connector.




The backside of the front panel





The Starting Animation

The animation appears when starting up. During operating a model, the animation appears at the lower level, and the operational information appears at the upper one. If there is no operation within 10 seconds, the LCD displays the animation automatically (no information appears).

■ Note:

* The animation do not display in ID3 mode.

Reset the Unit

Operating the unit for the first time or after replacing the car battery, you must reset the unit.

Remove the front panel at first, and then Press (RESET button on the base with a pointed object, (such as a ballpoint pen) to set the unit to initial status.

■ Note:

- * When some errors occur on the display, you can also press RESET button to resume to normal, and it will erase the clock setting and some memorized functions.
- * This function can only be operated by the head unit.

Turning the Unit On/Off

Press **1 PWR** button to turn on the unit, press it again, the unit is still in the waiting status. When insert a disc, the unit will automatically start playing. Keep pressing it to turn off the unit completely.

■ Note:

- * After the unit is off, the volume level is memorized during the area between 6 and 30. If the volume level is set less than 6, it will resume to 6; if it is higher than 30, it will resume to 30; if it is between 6 and 30, it still stores in the status which you set.
- * Pressing PWR button on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Volume Control

Press **VOL+** button to increase the sound level and press **VOL-** button to decrease the sound level.

Turning Loudness On/Off /My Best Position(MBP)














Basic operation of DVD

Insert a DVD disc into the slot, the unit will automatically switch on, if a DVD disc is loaded, press **2 SOURCE** on the remote control to start the playback.

■ Note:

Playing the Previous/Next Track

During DVD playback, firstly pressing 6 ⋈ to replay the current track, press 6 ⋈ within 3 seconds to play the previous track, press ⋈ to play the next track.

■ Note:

* Pressing 1 button on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Playing Track F.F/F.REW

Press → or ← to play the track fast forward or fast rewind: each pressing, the change is as following:

$$\longrightarrow 2X \longrightarrow 4X \longrightarrow 8X \longrightarrow 16X \longrightarrow$$

■ Note:

* Pressing 12 button on the head unit also performs the same operation.

Stop the playback

During DVD mode, firstly pressing **(b)** ■ to pause playing, press **(b)** ► or **(c)** II to play, press **(e)** button twice to stop playing completely, press PLAY button to start playing.

■ Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control.

Slow motion playback

Press to slow forward or slow backward. There are 5 speeds each pressing decreases the speed until the minimum speed is reached.

* This function is operated by using the remote control.

System Button

During DVD playback, press **© P/N** button to select standard TV system: AUTO, NTSC, PAL.

■ Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control

Increase the size of the picture

Press **7 ZOOM** to increase the picture in size. There are 2 sizes, Each pressing increases the size until the maximum size is reached.

■ Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control.

* Pressing 8 to remove the image on the screen.

* press 22 CLEAR to decrease the large image.

Repeat Playing

press **(1) RPT** on the remote control to replay the current track, press it again to cancel this function.

■ Note:

- * Pressing RPT on the head unit also performs the same operation.
- * The default setting is **DISC REPEAT**.

On-screen display

During DVD playback, press **OSD**, the monitor shows: total titles, total chapters, total elapsed time, remain time and the current chapter being played.

 This function is operated by using the remote control.

Setting the Playing Time

During DVD playback, press **GOTO** to set the time, when the LCD display-:--:--, input the numbers you want to set. For example, input <u>00:20:00</u>, the playing will be start playing form the 20 minutes point of the dise.

Changing the viewing angle (Multi-angle)

With DVDs featuring multi-angle (scenes shot from multiple angles) recordings, you can press **ANGLE** to switch among viewing angles during playback.

- This function is operated by using the remote control.
- * This function only operates with DVDs featuring multi-angle recordings.
- * The "A" mark on a DVD's package indicates it features multi-angle scenes.

 The number in the "A" mark indicates the number of angles from which scenes were shot.
- * You cannot switch angles during slow motion playback.
- * If you press ANGLE during fast forward/fast reverse or pause, fast forward/fast reverse or pause is canceled and normal playback resumes but the viewing angle does not change.

Changing audio language (Multi-audio)

DVDs can provide audio playback with different language. With DVDs featuring multi-audio recordings, you can press **4 AUDIO** to switch between language and audio systems during playback.

Selection options switch as follows:

AUDIO 1 — AUDIO 2 — AUDIO 3

■ Note:

- * This function is operated by using the remote control.
- * This function only operates with DVDs featuring multi-audio recordings.
- * The number in the "③" mark on a DVD's package indicates the number of recorded languages/audio systems.
- During VCD mode, you can press AUDIO to select left channel, right channel or stereo channel.

Changing the subtitle language (Multi-subtitle)

With DVDs featuring multi-subtitle recordings. You can press **SUB-T** to switch between subtitle languages during playback.

Selection options switch as follows:

Subtitles 1 — Subtitles 2 — Subtitles OFF

Note:

- * This function is operated by using the remote control.
- * This function only operates with DVDs featuring multi-subtitle recordings.
- * The number in the " mark on a DVD's package indicates the number of recorded subtitle languages.

Selecting Different Menu/Title

Under **DVD** playback mode, press MENU or TITLE to return to the root menu or the title menu, the monitor display all the chapters or all titles. You can press and Number Buttons on the remote control to select different chapter or title.

* This function is operated by using the remote control.

Eject a Disc

SET UP MENU

During DVD playback, press **®SET UP**, the screen will display system setting picture, the user can select some relative constant parameters.
