Before Using

- Use this appliance for its intended household use as described in this manual.
- Before using, check trimmer for wear or damage. If the trimmer shows signs of wear or damage, do not use the trimmer as injury may occur.
- Clean the trimmer after each use. For instructions see chapter 'Cleaning'.
- Do not use while bathing, showering or immerse trimmer in water or other liquids as damage to the trimmer may occur.
- For hygienic reasons, it is recommended that the trimmer be used by only one person.

Inserting the Battery

- Make sure your hands and trimmer are dry when inserting the battery.
- This appliance requires 1 "AA" 1.5 volt alkaline battery.
- A new battery has an operating time of up to 2 hours.
- Keep the appliance at a temperature between 40°F and 100°F.
- Do not keep the appliance in direct sunlight.
- 1 Make sure trimmer is in the Off position.
- 2 Turn the battery compartment cover counterclockwise to remove (fig. 1).
- 3 Put the battery in the battery compartment positive side up (fig. 2).
- 4 If the battery is not inserted properly, the appliance will not work.
- 5 Place the battery compartment cover back onto the trimmer and turn clockwise until it snaps into place.
- Replace the battery when it begins to get weak to avoid pulling hairs.
- If the appliance will not be used on a regular basis, remove the battery when storing the appliance to prevent possible damage due to chemical leakage.
- If the battery does leak, remove carefully. Never allow your bare skin to come into contact with the leaking fluid.

Using the Trimmer

- You can use the trimmer to trim nose hair or ear hair.
- Test trimmer on a small area of your arm or leg. If any sensitivity occurs, discontinue using immediately. Do not use trimmer on sensitive or irritated skin.

Trimming Nose Hair

- Make sure nasal passages are clean before trimming.
- Remove the Protective Cap by pulling it off the trimmer.
- 3 Turn trimmer ON.

4 Carefully insert the trimmer tip into one nostril.

CAUTION: DO NOT INSERT THE TIP MORE THAN 1/4 in/6mm INTO NOSTRIL.

- 5 Slowly move the trimmer tip in and out of each nostril to remove unwanted hair (fig. 3).
- 6 For best results, make sure the side of the tip is held firmly against the skin. This will reduce the tickling effect that can occur.
- 7 Turn trimmer OFF.
- 8 Clean trimmer immediately after using.

- Clean outer area of ear and make sure it is free of wax.
- Remove the Protective Cap by pulling it off the trimmer.
- 3 Turn the trimmer ON.
- 4 Pull ear flat to head with one hand and hold trimmer with the other hand.
- Move trimmer tip around edges of ear to remove hairs extending beyond the outer ear. (fig. 9). Carefully insert trimmer tip into outer ear no more than 1/4 in/6mm (fig. 4).

CAUTION: To avoid injury do not put any part of the trimmer into the ear. Do not insert the trimmer further than 1/4 in/6mm into the ear as this could cause damage to the eardrum.

6 Clean trimmer immediately after using.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Do not apply pressure or touch trimmer with hard objects as this may dent or damage trimmer.
- Never use the appliance if the trimmer is damaged or broken.

After Each Use

- Clean the trimmer every time you have used it.
- Do not use compressed air, abrasive cleaning detergents, scouring pads or cloths, acetone etc. to clean the appliance.
- 1 Turn the trimmer OFF.
- Rinse the trimmer head under warm water (fig. 5).
- 3 Turn the trimmer ON.
- 4 Rinse the trimmer head under warm water again to remove any remaining hair/residue from the trimmer.
- 5 For more thorough cleaning, remove cutting head assembly by turning counterclockwise (fig. 6). Rinse cutting head assembly under running warm water to remove any remaining hair/residue from inside of assembly (fig. 7).
- 6 Put cutting head assembly back on trimmer (turn clockwise) and wipe entire trimmer dry with a soft cloth.
- 7 Put the protective cap on the trimmer for storage.
