Preparing the Remote Commander

Battery Installation



- In normal operation, batteries will last up to half a year. If the unit does not operate properly, the batteries might be exhausted. Replace all of them with new ones.
- To avoid damage from possible battery leakage, remove the batteries when the Remote Commander will not be used for a long time.

The Mini Commander is supplied only for KV-27XBR50 and KV-32XBR50.

Mini Commander RM-K1T



This Mini Commander has the minimum function buttons for watching the TV.

Before use

The initial battery is installed at the factory. Remove the transparent insulating slip before operation.



How to replace the battery

- **1** Pull out the battery case.
- 2 Insert a Sony CR2025 battery with the flat surface (positive side) upward.

Use of a battery other than the Sony CR2025 lithium battery may create a risk of fire or explosion.



Notes on the lithium battery

- Keep the lithium battery out of the reach of children. Should the battery be swallowed, immediately consult a doctor.
- Be sure to observe the correct polarity when installing the battery.
- Do not hold the battery with metallic tweezers, otherwise a short-circuit may occur.
- Replace the battery with a Sony CR2025 lithium battery. Use of another battery may present a risk of fire or explosion.

Connecting the TV Antenna/Cable

Either an indoor antenna or outdoor antenna can be connected. For better quality picture, connecting an outdoor antenna is recommended. Cable TV reception is only possible by connecting a cable supplied by your local cable company.

To Connect a VHF, UHF, or VHF/UHF Combination Antenna* or CATV Cable



 Most combination antennas are equipped with a signal splitter. Remove the splitter and attach the appropriate connector. For a better quality picture, it is recommended to use the optional cable so that the 300 ohm twin-lead cable can be kept at a distance from the TV set.



When the U/V mixer is used Snow and noise may appear in the pictures of the cable TV channels over 37 (W+1).

The special converter/decoder will be supplied by the cable company.

When you connect a cable with a special converter/decoder* for pay cable TV systems Pay cable TV systems use scrambled or encoded signals and require special converters (decoders) in addition to the normal cable connection.





The main speakers and the super woofer are supplied only for KV-27XBR50 and KV-32XBR50.



*The main speakers can be attached deep at the rear portion of the TV, too.

The main speakers can be placed anywhere within the reach of the speaker cords instead of attaching them to the TV. When installing them on the TV, be sure not to place them on the woofer. The speakers are provided with camera screws for installation on a speaker stand, tripod, etc.



Connecting the Super Woofer



- 1 Insert the projecting parts at the bottom of the super woofer into the receptacles on the top of the TV.
- 2 Connect the super woofer cord to the SUPER WOOFER jack on the rear of the TV.

The super woofer is factory-set at the powerful sound. Press WOOFER on the Remote Commander to make bass sound less emphasized.

Notes on the speakers

- · Do not carry the TV holding the main speakers.
- The low bass sound is output from the super woofer. Be careful not to block the openings of the super woofer when installing the TV. Otherwise, the low bass sound will not be fully reproduced.
- Be sure to use the supplied speakers, since the TV and the speakers produce sounds as one unit.

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Connecting Other Equipment

The S VIDEO jacks of VIDEO 2 IN and VIDEO 3 IN are equipped only for KV-32XBR15, KV-27XBR15, KV-32XBR50 and KV-27XBR50.

Connecting a VCR

With this connection, you will be able to... --View the playback of video tapes --Record TV programs



Notes

- If you connect a monaural VCR, connect the audio output of the VCR to the L (MONO) jack of VIDEO 1/2/3 IN of the TV. The monaural sound will be heard from both speakers.
- For operation, refer to the instruction manual furnished with the VCR.
- The signals input from VIDEO 1/2/3 IN are not output from MONITOR OUT.
- Keep the VCR away from the TV if the picture or sound is affected.

About S video input

Video input and output signals can be separated into Y (luminance or brightness) and C (chroma or color) signals. Usually these two signals are combined in a VCR and sent as one signal to a TV. Separation of the Y and C signals prevents them from interfering with one another, thereby improving picture (especially in color) quality. This unit is equipped with an S video input jack through which these separated signals can be input directly.



To view one TV program while recording another Press the TV/VTR mode select button on the VCR or Remote

Commander so that the VCR will be in the TV mode. Press the TV button on the Remote Commander, and select the channel you want to view. When you cannot obtain a clear picture and/or sound Make sure that the TV/VTR mode select button on the VCR is set to TV. Re-select the desired channel with the buttons on the TV or the Remote Commander.

Connecting an Audio System

-To listen to the TV or connected VCR sound through an audio system



When an audio system is connected to AUDIO OUT, be sure to set the SPEAKER SW (switch) on the TV to OFF. The sound from the TV's speakers will be cut off. For better sound, we recommend that you use the optional video rack (see page 50).

Connecting Extra (not supplied) External Speakers

The models equipped with external speaker terminals are: KV-32XBR15 KV-27XBR15



If you connect external speakers,

they must be rated at 8-ohm impedance (with normal power holding capacity of more than 7W).

Phasing

Correct \oplus \bigcirc connection of both speaker systems ensures proper in-phase operation. If the speaker system is out-ofphase, the bass tones seem to be missing and the position of the instruments becomes obscure.

Enjoying Convenient Features



Muting the sound

Press MUTING.

The "MUTING" indication will appear on the screen. To restore the sound, press MUTING again or VOL +.

Heeping the channel displayed

Press DISPLAY.

To make the channel display disappear, press DISPLAY again.

Using the SLEEP timer

Press SLEEP.

The TV will be turned off automatically after about 1 hour. The "SLEEP" indication will appear on the screen for a few seconds and the SLEEP indicator on the TV will remain lit until the TV is turned off. To cancel the SLEEP timer, press SLEEP again so that the SLEEP indicator goes out, or turn off the TV.

For KV-27XBR50/32XBR50, the green "SLEEP ON" indication will appear on the screen for three seconds when the SLEEP button is pressed. And the red "SLEEP" indication will appear one minute before the TV is turned off automatically. When the SLEEP button is pressed again, the "SLEEP OFF" indication will appear three seconds before the SLEEP timer is canceled.

Only for KV-27XBR50/32XBR50

Getting the most vivid picture

Press ASC.

The "ASC ON" indication with the rotating mark (O) will appear on the left bottom of the screen for a few seconds to let you know the ASC is activated. The ASC continually adjusts sharpness, brightness, color and picture settings for optimum picture quality. The ASC automatically reduces noise when the signal is weak (in weak electric field).

To cancel the ASC, press ASC again. The "ASC OFF" indication will appear on the screen.

Fror more natural sound reproduction

Press SRS (sound retrieval system). The "(●) SRS" indication will appear on the screen. To cancel SRS, press SRS again.

For KV-27XBR50/32XBR50, each time SRS is pressed, SRS (STEREO), SRS (MONO) or SRS OFF is selected in sequence. On the SRS (MONO) mode the natural sound of a monaural source can be also enhanced.

Receiving a Multichannel TV Sound program

Each time **MTS** is pressed, MAIN, SAP (Second Audio Program), or MONO is selected in sequence. To listen to stereo sound, select the MAIN mode so that the on-screen MAIN indication appears. The STEREO indicator on the TV lights up whenever a stereo broadcast is received.

There may be cases of stereo broadcasts where excessive noise will be heard due to a weak incoming signal. You may be able to eliminate this noise by selecting the MONO mode.

Builtching quickly between two channels

Press JUMP.

Each time JUMP is pressed, the channel which appeared on the screen directly before is recalled. This button enables you to keep track of two programs alternately. JUMP also switches programs in the ANT/AUX mode.

Adjusting the Picture and Sound

You can adjust the picture and sound levels and have the unit store them for each input mode (TV/VIDEO 1/2/3).

The GUIDE function calls up the on-screen menu and instructions on how to set the current time, timer, channel block, video label, and channel caption.



- All settings will be erased from the unit's memory if the unit is unplugged, or if a power failure occurs.
- The ON/OFF TIMER and CHANNEL BLOCK will operate only if the clock is set correctly.

Setting the Clock

Labeling Each Video Input Mode

Each video input mode can be labeled as VTR, S VIDEO, or LD so that you can easily identify what equipment is connected to which input terminal. When the label is entered, this TV automatically adjusts itself internally to enhance the picture quality for the labeled equipment.

Example: Label VIDEO 1 with S VIDEO, VIDEO 2 with LD, and VIDEO 3 with VTR.

Caution

When replacing the batteries, do it within approximately 30 minutes. Otherwise, the memorized functions may be erased.

Notes

- The Remote Commander beeps repeatedly if there is inappropriate operation. Try again from Step 4.
- Be sure to confirm that the functions have been memorized as a few commanders of other manufacturers are not storable on this Remote Commander.
- Do not use the learning function for equipment other than video and audio.
- When operating equipment with learned functions, the selectors should be set to the same position as they were when the functions were memorized.
- When a new function is assigned to a button, the previous function is cleared automatically.
- When the memories are full, the LEARN indicator lights steadily if you try to memorize a new function. In such a case, set the USE/LEARN selector to USE to turn the indicator off, then clear the unnecessary functions (see page 49).

The learning function will not work in the following cases:

- There is a fluorescent lamp or equipment which emits infrared energy.
- → Move the Remote Commanders away from such infrared sources.
- The batteries are exhausted.
 → Replace all the batteries with new ones.
- There is an obstacle between the Remote Commanders, or the Remote Commanders are not positioned head to head and exactly aligned.
 → Position the Remote Commanders properly.

Disturbances in picture and sound can often be eliminated by checking the symptoms and following the suggestions listed below.

Good picture, no sound	 Press VOLUME + on the TV or VOL + on the Remote Commander. Press MUTING on the Remote Commander. Check that the MTS button is set correctly. Check that the TV/VIDEO or input select button is set correctly. Set the SPEAKER SW (switch) to ON.
No picture (screen not lit), no sound	 Is POWER switched on? Plug the unit into a wall outlet. Check that the TV/VIDEO or input select button is set correctly.
No color	Is it a color program?Adjust COLOR.
Snow and noise only	 Is it an active or the correct channel? Check the CABLE setting. Check the ANT/AUX button setting. Check antenna/cable connections.
Learning function on the commander does not work.	 Check the USE/LEARN selector setting. Check that the Remote Commanders are positioned property. Check if the batteries are exhausted. If there is fluorescent lamp near by, move the Remote Commanders away from it.
Dotted lines or stripes	This is often caused by local interference. (e.g. cars, neon signs, hairdryers etc.) Adjust the antenna for minimum interference.
Double images or ghosts	Reflections from nearby mountains or buildings often cause this problem. A highly directional outdoor antenna or a CATV cable may improve the picture.
