### Using the e-mail services

Panasonic Communications Co., Ltd. (hereafter called "PCC") offers individual information services, such as e-mail.

Your fax machine with e-mail features will enable you to send an e-mail to another party's personal computer (PC) or another e-mail fax machine anywhere in the world through the Internet. Also, you will be able to receive an e-mail from them.

To access the Internet using your fax machine,

- you need a credit card (VISA, JCB or MASTER as of June 2003) and
- have to subscribe to individual information services offered by PCC beforehand.

The application fee including call charges will be charged to your Credit Card.

#### Important:

 If your fax machine is connected to a home telephone system or a private branch exchange (PBX) system, these services are not available.
