# **Customized setting**

#### **AUTO SIGNAL DETECT**

When the DVD input signal is detected, the input mode will automatically change to VIDEO-2 and when the DVD input signal is not detected, the input mode will automatically change to RF previous input mode. DVD players: Press the "POWER ON" button on the player for signal detection.


