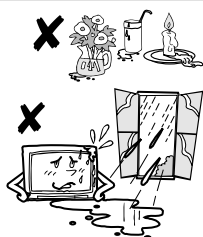

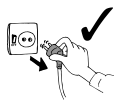
## WARNING

### TO PREVENT FIRE OR SHOCK HAZARD, DO NOT EXPOSE THIS APPLIANCE TO RAIN OR MOISTURE.

- The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus.
- Do not allow objects or liquid into the cabinet openings.



- Operate only from the power source indicated on the rear of the TV.
- Avoid damaging the power cord and mains plug. When unplugging the TV, grasp the mains plug. Do not pull on the power cord.
- This TV can be turned on/off power by connecting/disconnecting the AC plug into AC outlet. While this TV is being installed, enough space should be reserved for connection/disconnecting the AC plug into AC outlet by hand.



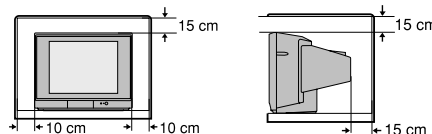
**In the event of a fault, unplug the unit and call a service technician. Do not attempt to repair it yourself or remove the rear cover.**

- Never listen to headphones at high volume!  
- It may damage your hearing.

## CAUTION

### TO ENSURE PERSONAL SAFETY, OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES REGARDING THE USE OF THIS TV.

- Never block or cover the ventilation openings.
- Never install the TV where good ventilation is unattainable.
- When installing this TV, leave spaces for ventilation around the TV of more than the minimum distances as shown.



- The surface of the TV screen is easily damaged. Be very careful with it when handling the TV. Should the TV screen become soiled, wipe it with a soft dry cloth. Never rub it forcefully. Never use any cleaner or detergent on it.



**If a television is not positioned in a sufficiently stable location, it can be potentially hazardous due to falling. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:**

- Using cabinets or stands recommended by the manufacturer of the television.
- Only using furniture that can safely support the television.
- Ensuring the television is not overhanging the edge of the supporting furniture.
- Not placing the television on tall furniture (for example, cupboards or bookcases) without anchoring both the furniture and the television to a suitable support.
- Not standing the televisions on cloth or other materials placed between the television and supporting furniture.
- Educating children about the dangers of climbing on furniture to reach the television or its controls.

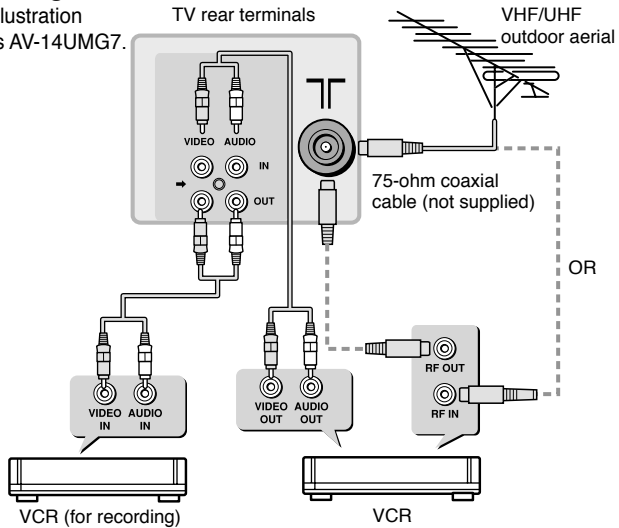
## Connections

Ensure to turn off all equipments including the TV before connecting the AC mains plug to the AC outlet.

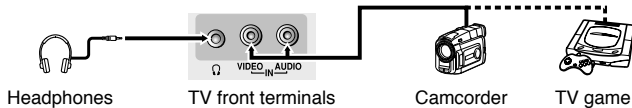
### Connecting to the aerial cable and VCR

\* This illustration shows AV-14UMG7.



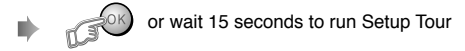

## Remote control buttons and functions

- Insert two batteries by following the ⊕ and ⊖ polarities and inserting the ⊖ end first.
- Use AA/R6/UM-3 dry cell batteries.
- If the remote control does not work properly, fit new batteries. The supplied batteries are for testing, not regular use.

Batteries shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as direct sunshine, fire or the like.

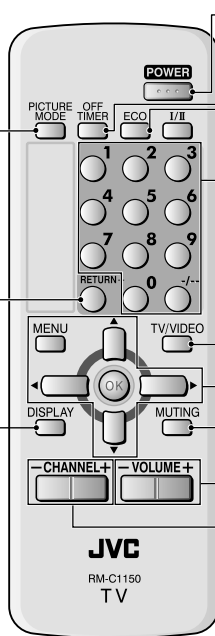

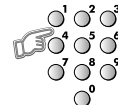

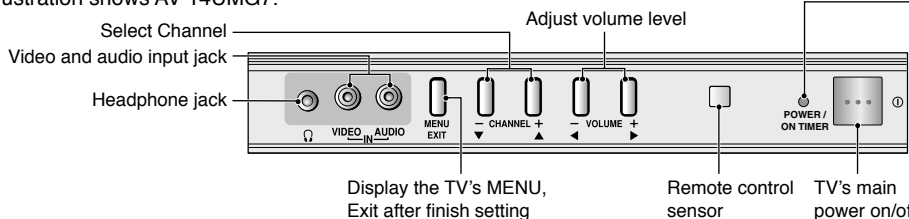

POWER lamp - Indicates the TV's status.

No colour : TV's main power is being turned off.

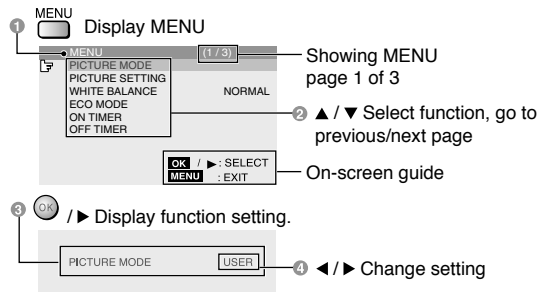
Red : TV's main power is being turned on.

Blink : While the TV is in standby mode, ON TIMER function is in used. While the TV is in turn on mode, OFF TIMER function is in used.

Note: When you turn off the power switch while TV is in standby mode, the power lamp will go off in 5-10 seconds. When you operate the TV, POWER Lamp will blink.

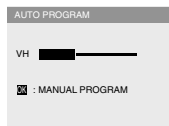

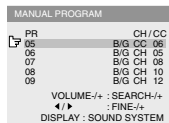

3 **To search for a channel manually (SEARCH)**

1. Select the PR number you wish to store the channel.
2. Press the **VOLUME +/-** button to start searching from the present channel. Searching stops when the following channel is found.

**To fine-tune a channel (FINE)**

1. Select the channel you wish to fine-tune.
2. Press the **◀** or **▶** button until a clear picture is obtained.

If noisy sound is heard and unsuitable sound system for your broadcasting (➔ Page 7)

1. Press **DISPLAY** button then on screen will change to Sound System,
2. Choose an appropriate sound system.

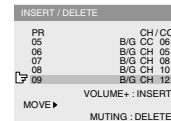

After this operation, other channel's PR number will be changed.

3 **To add the new channel (INSERT)**

1. Select the PR number you wish to store the new channel.
2. Press the **VOLUME+** button.
3. Press **▶** button to choose "CH" or "CC".
4. Enter the CH/CC number for the channel you wish to add. The TV starts to search for the channel. Certain channels are not available in some countries. If you cannot receive a channel by INSERT, use **MANUAL PROGRAM**.

**To delete a channel (DELETE)** Select the channel you wish to delete and press **MUTING**.

**To change the PR number (MOVE)**

1. Select the PR number you wish to move.
2. Press the **▶** button.
3. Press **▲** or **▼** button to move it to the new PR number.
4. Press **◀** button.





## Using the timer



### ON TIMER

- 1  → 
- 2  or  → 
- 3 Choose the PR (channel) that you want to watch when the TV turns on. External input, AV position and any un-preset channel cannot be chosen for PR.
- 4 Set the ON TIMER to your desired period of time. When the ON TIMER is set to other than 00:00, the ON TIMER is activated. You can set the period of time to a maximum of 12 hours in 15-minute intervals.
- 5 To off the ON TIMER, set the time to 00:00.

### OFF TIMER

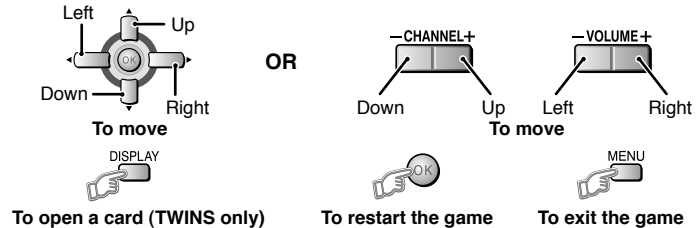

- Note** You can select OFF TIMER function by direct key.
- 2 You can set the period of time to a maximum of 120 minutes in 10 minutes intervals.
  - 3 When the remaining elapse time is one minute, "GOOD NIGHT!" appears on the screen.
  - 4 You can display the OFF TIMER screen again to confirm or change the remaining time.
  - 5 To off the OFF TIMER, select OFF or turn off the TV's main power.

<b>PUZZLE</b>	This game needs you to rearrange the numbers 1 to 15 in order by swapping the blank card with the numbered card.
<b>TWINS</b>	This game needs you to find all the matching pairs of cards. If you open a correct pair, the card will stay uncovered. If you miss, they will flip back.

## Troubleshooting

If a problem occurs when you are using the TV, check the below troubleshooting guide before calling for repair.

Problem	Cause / Solution
No or poor picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Turn OFF BLUE BACK if it is ON. (➡ page 5)</li> <li>• Adjust the COLOUR or BRIGHT setting. Refer to "PICTURE SETTING". (➡ page 5)</li> <li>• Choose the appropriate colour system. (➡ page 5)</li> </ul>
Snowy picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check the aerial and TV connections. (➡ page 3)</li> </ul>
Stripes or coloured patches appeared	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Interference caused by electrical appliances or speakers. Move them away from the TV.</li> </ul>
Double-picture (ghosting)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Interference caused by signal reflecting from mountains or buildings. Adjust the aerial's direction or use another antenna.</li> </ul>
No or poor sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Choose the appropriate sound system. (➡ page 5)</li> </ul>
White and bright still image looks as if it is coloured	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inevitable phenomenon due to the nature of the picture tube. This is not a malfunction.</li> </ul>
Image from video input is distorted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The image was not properly recorded. This is not a malfunction.</li> </ul>
Cannot operate the remote control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Replace the batteries. (➡ page 2)</li> <li>• Operate it at less than 7 meters from the TV.</li> </ul>
Cannot operate the MENU	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Exit and enter the MENU again.</li> </ul>
Cannot operate the front panel buttons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Turn OFF CHILD LOCK if it is ON.</li> </ul>
Image takes a while to be displayed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Image requires time to stabilize before display. This is not a malfunction.</li> </ul>
TV emits crackling sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Caused by a sudden change in temperature and it is not a malfunction. Call a service technician for inspection.</li> </ul>
Static shock when touch the TV screen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Caused by static electricity of the picture tube and it will not harm the human body. This is not a malfunction.</li> </ul>
The TV turns off suddenly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is not a malfunction. If you had set the BLUE BACK function to ON, TV will be turned off automatically when no signals are received from an antenna for about 15 minutes or longer.</li> </ul>
