





Installing the recording paper and stacker




Automatic dial mode setting

When the power cord and the telephone line cord are connected, the unit will start detecting the dial mode (tone or pulse). If you cannot dial and " $\hbar 117 - 061$ " is displayed, change the dial mode setting.



Changing the dial mode

- 1. Press [機能] (function).
- 2. Press # 0 7 9.
- 3. Press [選択] (select) to select the dial mode (カイセンシュヘ・ツ).



- 4. Press (登録) (register).
- 5. Press 🔘 (stop).

Confirming the dial mode

- Set the dial mode to "20".
 (See "Changing the dial mode" shown on the left.)
- 2. Dial ①①⑦ (time signal).

 If you cannot dial, change to "10".

 If you cannot dial after changing to "10", set to " プ ッシュ " (tone).


Note:

If this unit is connected to a PBX or used as an extension, dial the access code (ex. \bigcirc) before the time signal.

Setting the Date, Time, Facsimile Telephone Number and Logo


Before using your unit, program the correct date, time, facsimile telephone number and logo. These will be printed on the top of each page transmitted from your unit.

Setting the date and time



- 1. Press [機能] (function).
- 2. Press # 0 0 1.
- 3. Enter the correct year/month/day/hour/minute by selecting each 2 digits. Example: Aug. 10, 1998 3:05PM Press 9 8 0 8 1 0 1 5 0 5.
- 4. Press [登録] (register).
- 5. Press 🔘 (stop).

Setting your facsimile telephone number




- 1. Press [機能] (function).
- 2. Press # 0 0 4.
- 3. Enter your facsimile telephone number up to 20 digits.

Example: 098-765-4321

Press 0 9 8 9 7 6 5 9 4 3 2 1.



Telephone Operations

Making/Answering voice calls ——



Making calls

1. Lift the handset or press (speakerphone).

Note:

When a slow beep or no sound is heard, press (start/copy) and replace the handset.

The unit will start fax receiving.

Paging the portable handset



- 1. Lift the handset or press (4) (speakerphone).
- 2. Press ^{子機} (portable handset).
- 3. Talk to the portable handset user. スピーカー
- When finished, replace the handset or press (speakerphone).

Transferring calls to the portable handset


- Press ^{子機} (portable handset) while you are talking to an outside party.
 - The portable handset is paged.
- 2. When the portable handset user answers, tell them a call is being transferred, then hang up.
 - The portable handset user can talk to the outside party.

Note:

When the portable handset user does not answer, press $\stackrel{?\#}{\bigcirc}$ (portable handset) again.

You can talk to the outside party.



Changing the stored name or number



- 3. Press (*).
- 4. Press (*) or (#) to move the cursor to the incorrect character, then make the correction.
- 5. Press ©電話帳登録 (telephone directory register/edit/erase).
- 6. Enter the correct phone number.
- 7. Press ②電話帳登録 (telephone directory register/edit/erase).

Transmitting documents manually


- 1. Open the document tray and adjust the guides.
- 2. Insert the document FACE DOWN until a beep is heard. (up to 5 sheets at a time)
- 3. Press $\stackrel{\text{\tiny egf}}{\longrightarrow}$ (resolution) to select the resolution.
- 4. Lift the handset or press (speakerphone).
- 5. Dial the phone number.
- 6. When a fax tone is heard, press (start/copy).
- 7. Replace the handset.
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Selecting the resolution

Transmitting documents using automatic dialing

Setting the Receive Mode

This unit has five types of receive modes. Choose the desired mode according to your needs. Press (auto receive) to switch the manual receive and auto receive modes.

Telephone mode (デンワユウセン)

When you want to answer all calls manually. After answering the call, press the start button for fax receiving.

Facsimile/Telephone mode (FAXユウセン)


When you want to answer voice calls but do not want to be disturbed by fax calls.

If no one answers the call, the unit will receive the documents automatically. Or you can answer the call and press the start button for fax receiving.

Auto receive mode



Answering machine/Facsimile mode (FAX /ルスデン)

When you want to use the unit to record voice messages and receive documents.

When a call is received, the unit plays your greeting message and records the voice message.

If a fax is detected, the unit receives the documents automatically.

Facsimile mode (FAXセンヨウ)

When you want to use the unit solely as a fax machine. The unit receives documents automatically. You can not answer voice calls and the answering device will not function.

Answering machine mode (ルスデンセンヨウ)

When you want to use the unit to record voice messages only.

The unit will not receive documents automatically.


Scanning documents —





Using a Caller ID Display Service

This unit can work with NTT's number display service. A contract with NTT (charge fee) and setting this unit are required.



How the number is displayed ——

When you do not want to display your telephone number to the other party when calling, there are two methods available.

First choose the method and then you must apply to NTT.

Per-call Blocking


If you enter **184** before the number you call, your number will not be displayed.

Per-line Blocking

Your number will not be displayed for any call you make. However, you can display your number if you enter **186** before the number you call.

Setting up —

Subscribe to NTT, and then set the display to " \mathcal{P} \mathcal{I} " (ON).



- 1. Press [機能] (function).
- 2. Press # 1 3 3.
- 3. Press $\bigcirc_{[\overline{\mathbb{B}}\overline{\mathbb{H}}]}$ (select) to select " アリ " (ON).

If you do not set the unit to " \mathcal{P} \mathcal{I} " (ON), the first bell will ring shorter than usual, even if you receive the Caller ID Display service.

Caller ID Display Service Functions

Using the Caller ID Display Service, this unit can store phone numbers and the date and time of the calls in memory. (Up to 30 calls, except 99 calls, can be stored in the search dial.) By using the search dial, you can search for the phone number, and the date and time of a call on the display of the unit.

Searching for a phone number with the main unit

How your fax is sent to the other party's fax machine •



- 1 If any transmission errors occur between your unit and the fax server, your unit will automatically redial the fax server up to 3 times.
- 2 If any transmission errors occur between the fax server and the other party's fax machine, the fax server will automatically redial the other party's fax machine up to 4 times. If your fax is still not transmitted after 4 attempts, the fax server will fax a non-delivery notice to you. In this case, there is no charge. Set your unit to receive a fax.
