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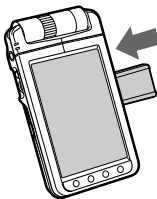
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# Getting Started

## Features

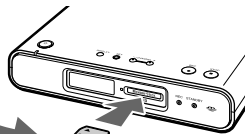
This Video Recorder contains a TV tuner and can record a TV program on “Memory Stick” media.



CLIÉ handheld

- 1 Insert a “Memory Stick” media into your CLIÉ handheld.
- 2 Set the timer REC preset\* on your CLIÉ handheld.

Video Recorder



“Memory Stick” media

- 3 Insert a “Memory Stick” media into the Video Recorder.  
The timer REC preset on your CLIÉ handheld is automatically set on the Video Recorder.

- 4 Record a TV program.



CLIÉ handheld

- 5 Play the program using a Movie Player software such as **Movie Player** on your CLIÉ handheld.

\* A “Timer REC Preset” is a scheduled (preset) recording of a program, set up in advance by the user.

## Notes

- You have to install **Video Utility** on your CLIÉ handheld from the supplied Installation CD-ROM to set a timer REC preset.
- You cannot use this Video Recorder to play back recordings made on “Memory Stick” media.
- When you insert or remove a “Memory Stick” media or press any button on the Video Recorder, hold the Video Recorder with your hand to keep it steady.



## Hints

- The Video Recorder has LINE IN jacks, for recording pictures from other equipment.
- Although the Video Recorder contains a TV tuner, you may want to record pictures using the tuner section of other equipment, such as a satellite receiver, CATV, etc., in which case, connect the other equipment to the Video Recorder.

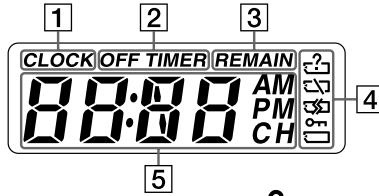
# Guide to Parts

## Front panel



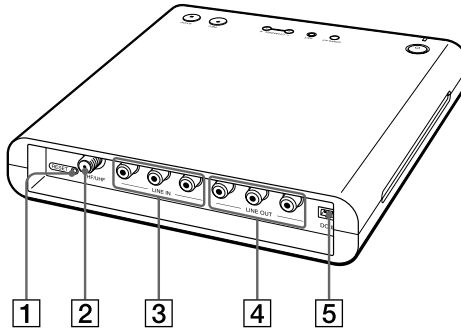
- 1** POWER indicator  
Lights up in green after blinking momentarily after the power has been turned on.
- 2**  (power)  
Turns the Video Recorder on and off.
- 3** Display  
Changes the information of the front panel display as follows:
- Time → Remaining time → Channel → REC Mode  
↑
- 4** SET  
Press and hold momentarily to activate clock setting mode. Use this button also to activate certain other settings.
- 5** CHANNEL+/-  
Selects the channel or line input.
- 6** ● REC  
Starts recording.
- 7** ■ STOP  
Stops recording.
- 8** Front panel display
- 9** "Memory Stick" media indicator  
Lights up in orange when recording onto a "Memory Stick" media.
- 10** "Memory Stick" slot  
Insert a "Memory Stick" media.
- 11** REC indicator  
Lights up in red when recording starts.
- 12** STANDBY indicator  
Lights up in red when a timer REC preset is activated or in standby mode.

## Front panel display



- 1** **CLOCK**  
Lights up when displaying the current time.
- 2** **OFF TIMER**  
Lights up when OFF TIMER recording is activated.
- 3** **REMAIN**  
Lights up when displaying the remaining time of a recording.
- 4** Displays the “Memory Stick” media status. The “Memory Stick” media status symbols and meanings are as follows:
- : The “Memory Stick” media is not formatted properly for use with this Video Recorder.
  - : “Memory Stick” media is not inserted.
  - : The “Memory Stick” media is not being read correctly.
  - : The “Memory Stick” media is write protected.
  - : “Memory Stick” media is inserted.
- 5** Displays the time and AM/PM, or the current channel.

## Rear panel



- 1** **Reset**  
Push to reset the Video Recorder.
- Notes**
- When you reset, do not push the Reset button using a sharp pointed object. Use the stylus or similar object.
  - When you reset, the Video Recorder returns to the default setting. Perform initial settings again following the procedure described in “Step 5: Setting the Clock” on page 20 and “Setting the tuner and channel” on page 22.
- 2** **VHF/UHF IN jack**
- 3** **LINE IN (VIDEO/AUDIO L/R) jacks**  
Connect to auxiliary equipment (VCR, satellite receiver, etc.).
- 4** **LINE OUT (VIDEO/AUDIO L/R) jacks**  
Connect to a TV.
- 5** **DC IN connector**

To prepare for recording, use the following the procedures to connect the antenna, TV, VCR, satellite receiver, and AC power adapter. Then install **Video Utility** from the supplied Installation CD-ROM and make initial settings.

# Step 1: Connecting the Antenna Cable

Select one of the following antenna hookups to record a TV program:

## Hookup 1

For antenna only (page 14)

## Hookup 2

For a connected signal source from your wall to your TV or VCR (page 14)

## Hookup 3

For a cable box (page 15)

### **Note to CATV system installer:**

This reminder is provided to call the CATV system installer's attention to Article 820-40 of the NEC that provides guidelines for proper grounding and, in particular, specifies that the cable ground shall be connected to the grounding system of the building, as close to the point of cable entry as is practical.

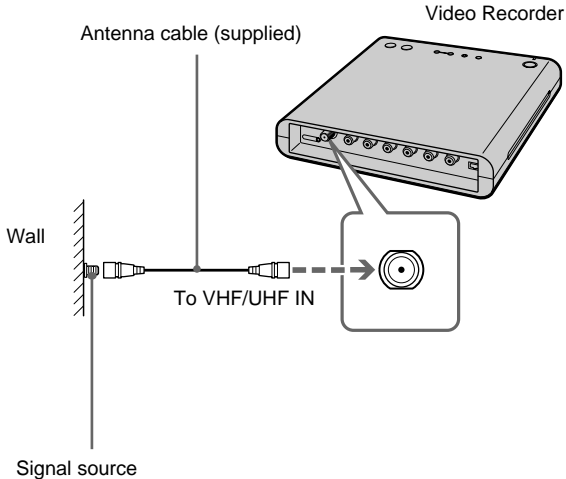
### **Note**

Use the supplied antenna cable to connect the VHF/UHF IN jack on the Video Recorder.

## Hookup 1: Connecting the antenna only

Use this hookup to connect a VHF/UHF antenna (or separate VHF and UHF antennas) to the video recorder.

Use an antenna cable to connect the signal source coming from your wall to the VHF/UHF IN jack on the Video Recorder.



### Notes

- If your antenna is a flat cable (300-ohm twin lead cable), use an external antenna connector (not supplied) to connect the antenna to the Video Recorder.
- If you have separate cables for VHF and UHF antennas, use a VHF/UHF band mixer (not supplied) to connect the antenna to the Video Recorder.

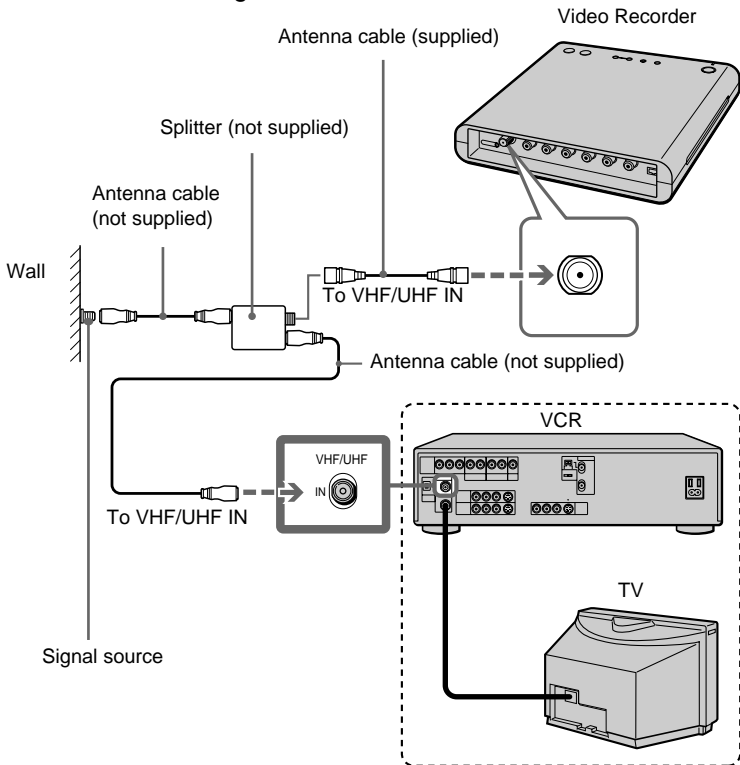
## Hookup 2: Connecting to a TV or VCR

Use this hookup if the signal source coming from your wall is already connected to your TV/VCR via a single antenna socket.

- 1** Use an antenna cable (not supplied) to connect the signal source coming from your wall to the single (input) jack of the splitter (not supplied).
- 2** Use an antenna cable (not supplied) to connect one of the splitter's two output jacks to the VHF/UHF IN jack on your TV or VCR.

- Use the supplied antenna cable to connect the splitter's other output jack to the VHF/UHF IN jack on the Video Recorder.

When connecting a TV and VCR



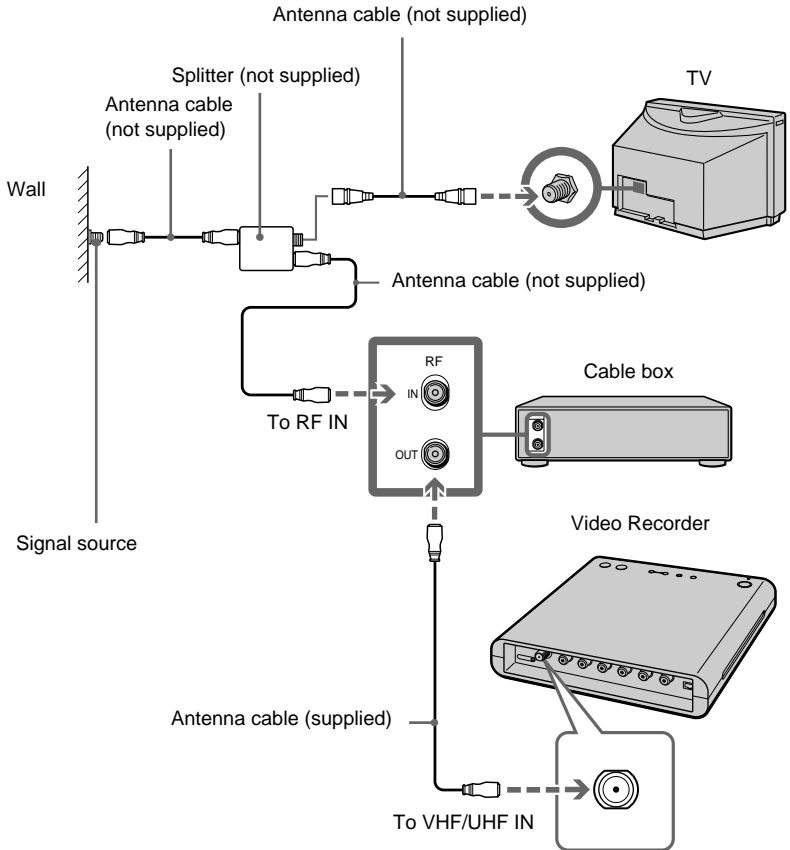
For details on the connections above, refer to the operating instructions of your VCR or TV.

### Hookup 3: Connecting to a cable box

Use this hookup for a cable box.

- Use an antenna cable (not supplied) to connect the signal source coming from your wall to the single (input) jack of the splitter (not supplied).
- Use an antenna cable (not supplied) to connect one of the splitter's two output jacks to the VHF/UHF IN jack on your TV.

- 3 Use an antenna cable (not supplied) to connect the splitter's other output jack to the RF IN on your cable box.
- 4 Use the supplied antenna cable to connect the RF OUT on your cable box to the VHF/UHF IN jack on the Video Recorder.





## Step 2: Connecting to Other Equipment with the Audio/Video Cable

If you want to input or output signals to other equipment (e.g., a TV, VCR, or satellite receiver) using the audio/video cable (supplied), refer to the following connections.

### Note

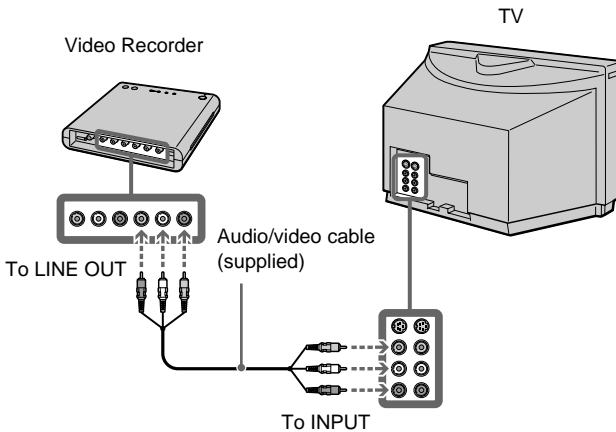
When connecting a cable, make sure to match the color-coded pins to the appropriate jacks on the equipment.

### Connecting to a TV with the Audio/Video Cable (Output a signal to the TV)

When you connect to a TV, you can do the following:

- Watch a TV program via the Video Recorder's VHF/UHF IN jack
- Confirm a recording TV program

Connect LINE OUT on the Video Recorder to INPUT on your TV with the audio/video cable (supplied).



### Note

You cannot use this Video Recorder to play back recordings made on “Memory Stick” media.

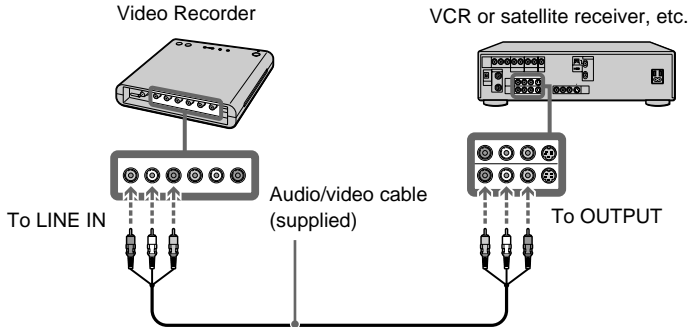
## Connecting a VCR or satellite receiver (Input a signal from other equipment)

When you connect to other equipment, you can do the following:

- Record a signal from other equipment (VCR or satellite receiver, etc.)

Connect the Video Recorder to the other equipment with the audio/video cable (supplied).

When you want to input a signal from the other equipment, connect LINE IN on the Video Recorder to OUTPUT on the other equipment.

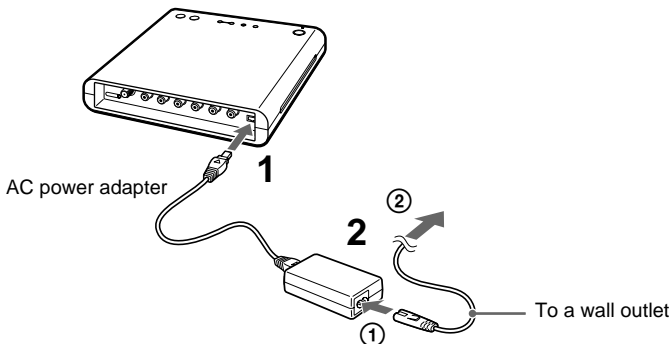


### Note

You cannot record programs containing a copy protection signal or a Copy-Once signal. You can record copy-free programs.

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## Step 3: Connecting the AC Power Adapter



- 1 Connect the AC power adapter to the DC IN connector of the Video Recorder.
- 2 Connect the AC cord to the AC power adapter (①), then plug the AC cord into a wall outlet (②).

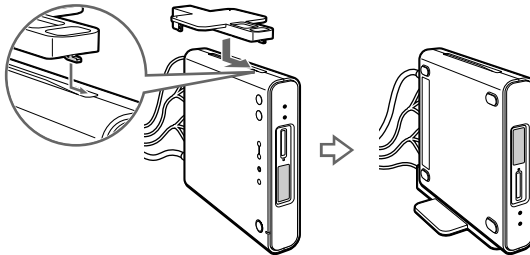
**Notes**

- The clock blinks in the front panel display when you turn on the Video Recorder for the first time.
- For details on setting the clock, refer to “Step 5: Setting the Clock” on page 20.

**When installing the Video Recorder vertically**

You can install the Video Recorder vertically when you attach the supplied stand to either side of the Video Recorder.


When you attach the stand, lay the Video Recorder down on one side and slide the stand into the slot on the other side of the Video Recorder.

**Note**

Attach the stand after connecting all cords.


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## Step 4: Turning the Video Recorder on and off

Press  (power) on the Video Recorder.

The Video Recorder turns on, and the POWER indicator blinks momentarily and then stays lit in green. The Video Recorder cannot be operated while the POWER indicator is blinking.


### Turning off the Video Recorder

Press  (power) on the Video Recorder.

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## Step 5: Setting the Clock

Follow this procedure to set the clock.

- 1** Press  (power) on the Video Recorder.  
The Video Recorder turns on, and the POWER indicator blinks momentarily and then stays lit in green. The Video Recorder cannot be operated while the POWER indicator is blinking.
- 2** Press and hold SET on the Video Recorder.  
The clock setting mode is activated. The setting for year appears.
- 3** Press CHANNEL+/- to select the year, then press SET.  
The year is set. The setting for month appears.
- 4** Press CHANNEL+/- to select the month, then press SET.  
The month is set. The setting for date appears.
- 5** Press CHANNEL+/- to select the date, then press SET.  
The date is set. The setting for hour appears.
- 6** Press CHANNEL+/- to select the hour, then press SET.  
The hour is set. The setting for minute appears.

- 7 Press CHANNEL+/- to select the minute, then press SET.  
The minute is set. The clock starts and the time is displayed.

---

## Step 6: Performing the Setup Using Your CLIÉ™ Handheld

After completing the first 5 steps, install **Video Utility** from the supplied Installation CD-ROM and make initial settings for timer REC presets (tuner, channels, etc.) using your CLIÉ handheld.

### Installing the software on your CLIÉ handheld

Follow the procedure below to install **Video Utility** on your CLIÉ handheld from the supplied Installation CD-ROM.

#### Note

Before installing, it is necessary to connect your CLIÉ handheld to your computer using a cradle or a USB HotSync cable to perform the HotSync operation. For details on how to connect your CLIÉ handheld to your computer, refer to the “Handbook” of CLIÉ handheld.

- 1 Insert the supplied Installation CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive of your computer.

The **Install CD-ROM** window is displayed.



#### Hint

If the installer does not start automatically, double-click on the CD-ROM icon, then double-click [Setup] (Setup.exe).

- 2 Click [CLIÉ Software] from the categories displayed on the left side of the **Install CD-ROM** window and click [Install] for **Video Utility**.
- 3 Proceed with the installation following the on-screen instructions.  
Select a CLIÉ user name on the user name selection screen.

**Note**

If you want to use more than one CLIÉ handheld, you need to install this utility on each CLIÉ handheld.

**4** Click [DONE].

Click [OK] when the **Confirmation** dialog box is displayed.  
The **Install CD-ROM** window is displayed.

**5** Click [Exit] on the **Install CD-ROM** window.

The **Install CD-ROM** window closes. In the next step, you will perform the HotSync operation to carry out the installation to your CLIÉ handheld.

**6** Execute a HotSync operation on your CLIÉ handheld.

The HotSync operation starts and **Video Utility** is installed on your CLIÉ handheld.

For details on how to perform a HotSync operation, refer to “Read This First (Operating Instructions)” in the supplied instruction manual of CLIÉ handheld.

**Note**

When you update the system for playing movies, click [CLIÉ Software] from the categories displayed on the left side of the **Install CD-ROM** window, then click [Install] for “Movie Player Software Update Program” and follow the on-screen instructions to install it.

## Setting the tuner and channel

Before you use the Video Recorder, set the tuner and channel on your CLIÉ handheld. These settings are then automatically transferred to the Video Recorder when the “Memory Stick” media containing these settings is inserted.

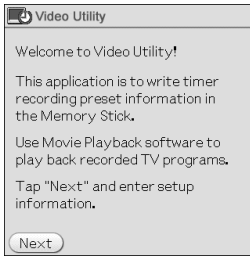
**Note**

In the default setting, all channels are displayed in the front panel display.



**1** Insert a “Memory Stick” media into your CLIÉ handheld.

## 2 Tap (Video Util) on the CLIE Launcher.

The welcome message on the **Video Utility** screen is displayed.

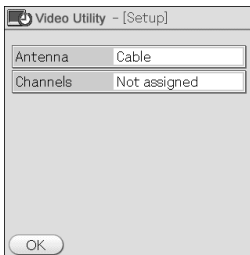


### Note

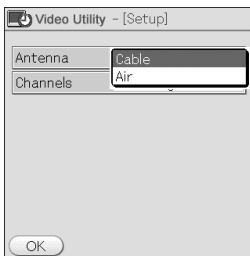
When you tap  (Video Util) for the first time, a welcome message appears on the screen. From the next time, whenever you need to make tuner and channel settings, tap  at the bottom of the **Video Utility** screen and display the **Video Utility** screen for [Setup].

## 3 Tap [Next].

The **Video Utility** screen for [Setup] is displayed.

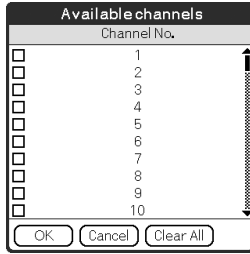


## 4 Select [Cable] or [Air] (broadcast signal) in the list box next to [Antenna].

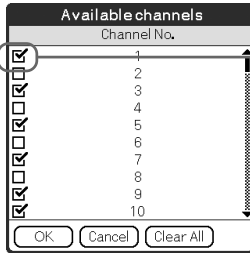


## 5 Tap [Channels].

The **Available channels** screen is displayed.



## 6 Tap a channel you want to receive by changing to in the **Available channels** screen.



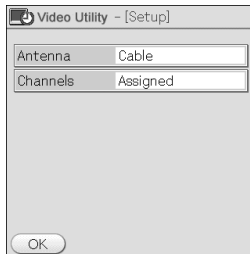
When you change  to  here, the channels you select are displayed in [Channel] in the **Video Utility** screen for **[New Preset]** and also in the front panel display of the Video Recorder.

### Note

Unselected channels will not appear in the front panel display of the Video Recorder, nor as channel options in the **Video Utility** screen. Make sure to put a checkmark before every channel that you want to use.

## 7 Tap [OK].

The **Video Utility** screen for **[Setup]** is displayed.



## 8 Tap [OK].

The tuner and channel settings are complete.



## 9 Remove the “Memory Stick” media from your CLIÉ handheld.

### Note

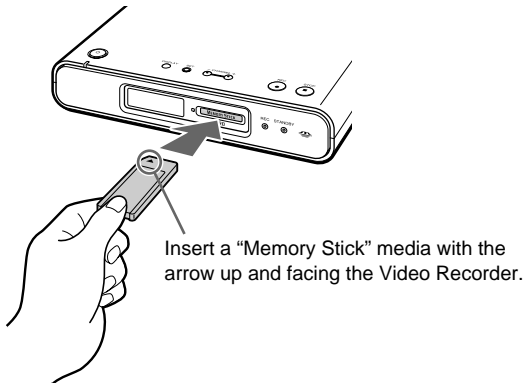
Do not remove the “Memory Stick” media from your CLIÉ handheld while the “Memory Stick” LED is lit.

## 10 Press (power) on the Video Recorder.

The Video Recorder turns on, and the POWER indicator blinks momentarily and then stays lit in green.

## 11 Insert the “Memory Stick” media into the “Memory Stick” slot of the Video Recorder.

When you insert the “Memory Stick” media containing the tuner and channel settings, the Video Recorder automatically reads them and adjusts the appropriate settings. When the Video Recorder is finished, the “Memory Stick” media indicator turns off.



### Notes

- Do not remove the “Memory Stick” media from the Video Recorder when the “Memory Stick” media indicator is lit. It is possible that all data on the “Memory Stick” media may be erased or a malfunction may occur.
- When removing a “Memory Stick” media, push it in slightly and then release. The “Memory Stick” media will pop out of the slot.

**The initial setup is complete!**

# Operations


## Setting a Timer REC Preset

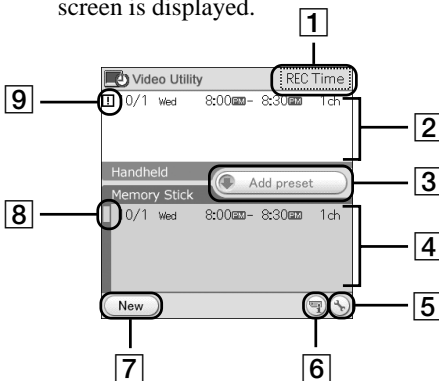
You can set, edit, or delete a timer REC preset using **Video Utility**. You can also set the same timer REC preset on other “Memory Stick” media.








### Note

The Video Recorder performs timer recordings using timer REC preset settings specified on a “Memory Stick” media. To record, insert the “Memory Stick” media containing the timer REC preset information into the Video Recorder.

## Guide to the Video Utility screen

When you tap  (Video Util) on the CLIE Launcher, the **Video Utility** screen is displayed.




- 1 Tap here to display a drop-down menu. Select “REC Time”, “Title”, or “REC Mode” (recording mode and sound).
- 2 Displays the timer REC presets in the backup list of your CLIÉ handheld.
- 3 When you tap [Add preset], you can add a timer REC preset from the backup list of your CLIÉ handheld to the “Memory Stick” media.
- 4 Displays the timer REC preset on the “Memory Stick” media.
- 5 When you tap , the **Video Utility** screen for [Setup] is displayed. Use this screen to make the antenna settings.

# Recording TV Programs Manually

Follow the procedure below to record a TV program without setting the timer REC preset.

- 1 Press  (power) on the Video Recorder.

The POWER indicator blinks momentarily and then stays lit in green.

- 2 Insert a “Memory Stick” media into the “Memory Stick” slot of the Video Recorder and press CHANNEL+/- to select the channel or input source you want to record.

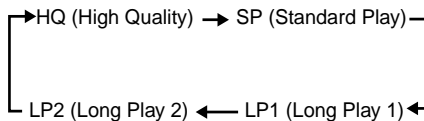


**Hint**

When you record from other equipment connected to the LINE IN jacks on the Video Recorder, select LINE using CHANNEL+/-.


- 3 Press DISPLAY to select the recording mode.

Each time you press CHANNEL+, the front panel display changes in the following sequence.



## Notes

- When you select LP1 or LP2, the sound will be recorded in monaural. When you record a stereo sound program, it is recorded in mono (L+R). When you select LP1 or LP2, you cannot select the sound format.
- You cannot select SAP (Second Audio Program) manually.

- 4 Press  REC.

Recording starts and the REC indicator lights up in red.

Recording continues until you stop the recording or when the “Memory Stick” media is full.



**Hint**

The maximum recording time is two hours.

## Note

While recording, you cannot change [REC Mode].

## To cancel recording

Press **■ STOP**. The REC indicator blinks momentarily and then turns off when recording is finished.

### Note

When you press **■ STOP**, recording continues on the “Memory Stick” media for approximately one minute and the “Memory Stick” indicator remains lit. Do not remove the “Memory Stick” media while the “Memory Stick” media indicator is lit. It is possible that all data on the “Memory Stick” media may be erased or a malfunction may occur.

## Using the OFF TIMER recording

During recording, if you press **● REC**, OFF TIMER mode is activated and recording will stop automatically at the time you set.

You can set the OFF TIMER duration according to 15 minute increments.



The maximum recording time is two hours.

Press **● REC** and OFF TIMER lights up.

When the duration appears in the front panel display, press **● REC** repeatedly to select the duration time. Each press advances the time by 15 minute increments.

Press SET when the desired time is displayed.

00:15 → 00:30 → 00:45 → ... 02:00 → Normal recording (CLOCK)



During recording, the time counter decreases minute by minute to 00:00, then recording stops.

## To change or cancel the OFF TIMER

To change the recording time while OFF TIMER is activated, press **● REC**. When the duration appears and flashes, select the duration you want using **● REC**, and then press SET.

To cancel OFF TIMER, press **● REC** until CLOCK lights up and the current time is displayed in the front panel display.

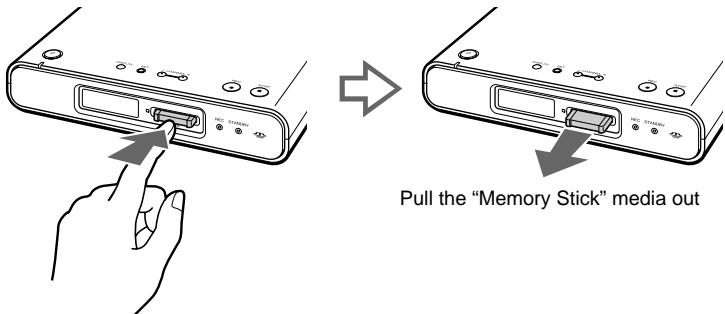

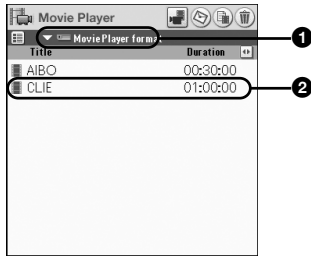

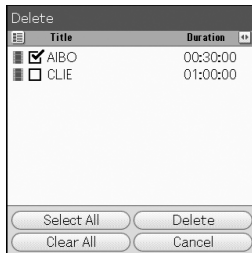

Read this Troubleshooting section before calling Sony Customer Information Services Center. If the problem persists even after reading this section, check our official Sony CLIÉ website (URL on back page).

### Power

---

The power does not turn on. → Check that the AC power adapter is connected securely.

---

### Recording/Presetting

---

You cannot add a new timer REC preset. → You can have up to 100 presets on your CLIÉ handheld and up to 20 on a “Memory Stick” media. Delete one or more timer REC presets or insert another “Memory Stick” media and set the timer REC preset again.  
→ Make sure that the “Memory Stick” media is not write protected.  
→ The Video Recorder cannot record more than two hours continuously. Change the recording time.  
→ The new timer REC preset overlaps with another preset in a “Memory Stick” media. The new preset will be added only to the backup list of your CLIÉ handheld.

---

Nothing was recorded even though you set the timer REC preset correctly. → The Video Recorder’s internal clock stopped due to a power failure that lasted for more than 30 minutes. Reset the clock.  
→ Make sure that the “Memory Stick” media is inserted properly.  
→ Check that there is enough storage space on the “Memory Stick” media.  
→ The program may contain a copy protection signal that restricts copying. Check the error message in the front panel display.  
→ Check the clock setting of the Video Recorder.

---

The timer REC preset stops in the middle of the program. → There was a power failure during recording. If the power recovers within 30 minutes, the Video Recorder resumes recording.

You move to a new area.

→ Set [Antenna] and [Channels] in the **Video Utility** screen for [Setup] again.

---

The sound is noisy.

→ Make sure that the antenna is connected using the antenna cable.  
→ Keep the antenna cable away from other connecting cords and fasten the antenna cable with a band.
