**4** Select the component name you want the Remote Commander to preset by pressing the Label key (on this case, TV).

The TV and current preset code (in this case, "0000") appear on the Label key. The "TV", "CABLE" and "POWER" flash.

**Note**  
If you enter a preset code that is not in the table, the Remote Commander does not operate. If you enter a preset code that is not in the table, the Remote Commander does not operate.

**5** Press the "0", "1", "2", "3", "4" and "1" member keys.

To return the CHANNEL to the previous channel, press the "0" member key.

**6** Press the OK Button.

A beep sounds and the input procedure appears on the Label key momentarily.

"PSET" appears on the Display title.

**7** Press and hold the COMMANDER OFF button for more than 3 seconds.

The Remote Commander is set off.

**If you want to quit before finishing the setting:**  
Press the COMMANDER OFF button for more than 3 seconds. The power status returns to the Remote Commander is off.

**If you want to return to the previous display:**  
Press the COMMANDER OFF button for more than 3 seconds.

**Note**  
If you enter a preset code that is not in the table, the Remote Commander does not operate. If you enter a preset code that is not in the table, the Remote Commander does not operate.

**Example to set up a Philips TV**

**1** See the leftmost right, and find the four-digit preset code for the desired component.

If you have a component that is not in the table, you need to set up the component manually. For example, to set up a Philips TV, you would use the preset code "0000".

**2** While pressing the COMMANDER OFF button, press the "MUTING" button.

"SET" appears on the Display title.

**3** Press "PSET" on the Label key.

"PSET" appears on the Display title. The component name appears on the Label key.

If a program number with "1" appears on the right side of Display title, change the program number. Press the number to go to the next page.

"PSET" appears on the Display title.
