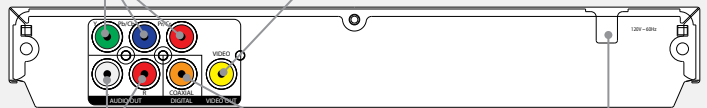

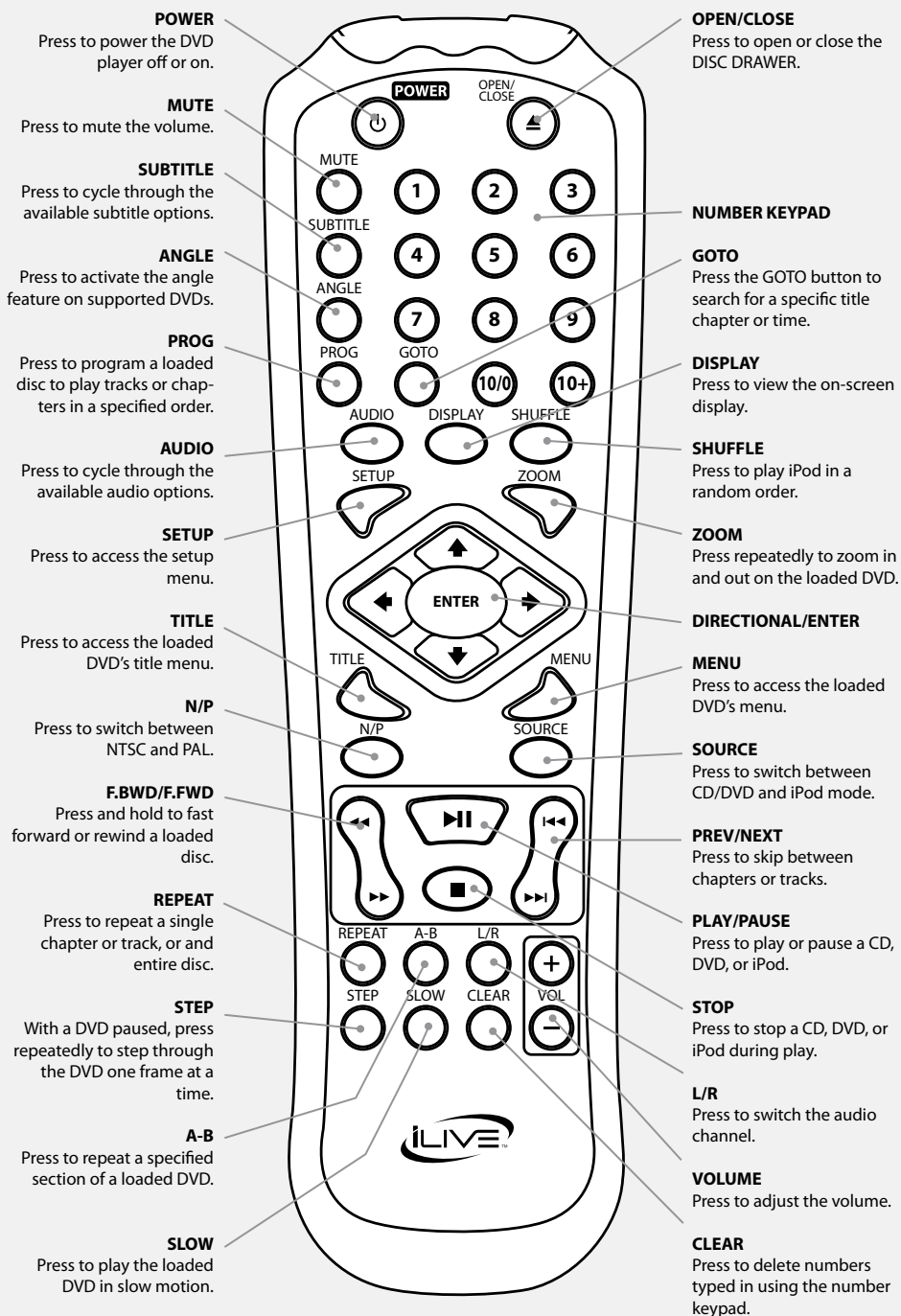

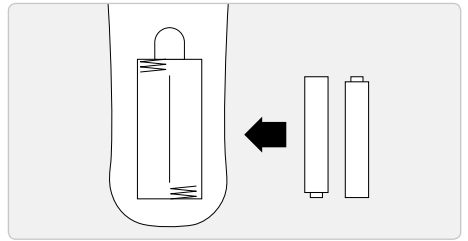
Power

Plug the attached AC cord into a standard AC power outlet to power the home theater system.

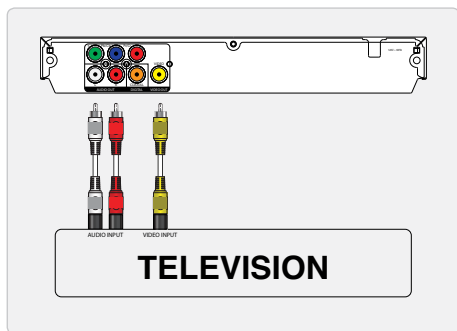

Composite Video Output

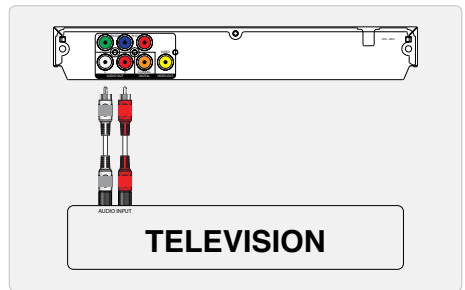
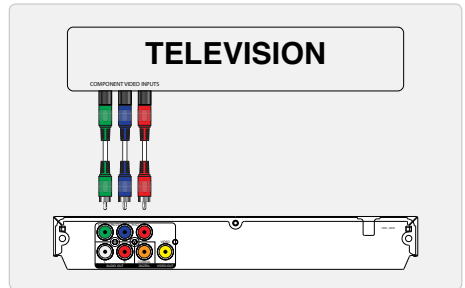
- 1 Plug the included RCA audio/video cable into the **COMPOSITE VIDEO OUTPUT** (yellow) on the DVD player and the composite video input (yellow) on a television.
- 2 Plug the remaining plugs on the included RCA audio/video cable into the **RCA STEREO AUDIO OUTPUTS** (red and white) on the DVD player and the RCA stereo audio inputs (red and white) on a television.
- 3 Adjust the television's input setting to correspond to the inputs used when connecting the DVD player.

ADVANCED TELEVISION CONNECTION

Component Video Output

Requires a component video cable (not included).

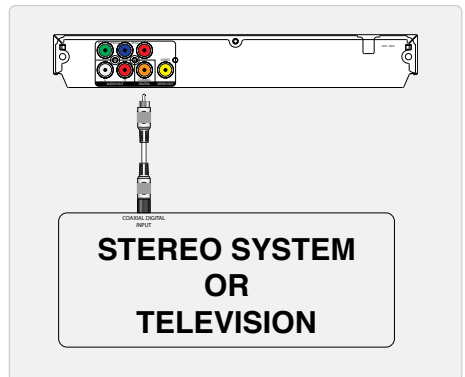
- 1 Plug a component video cable into the **COMPONENT VIDEO OUTPUTS** (green, blue, red) on the DVD player and the component video input (green, blue, red) on a television.
- 2 Plug the included RCA audio/video cable into the **RCA STEREO AUDIO OUTPUTS** (red and white) on the DVD player and the RCA stereo audio inputs (red and white) on a television.
- 3 Adjust the television's input setting to correspond to the inputs used when connecting the DVD player.



Digital Audio Output

Requires a coaxial digital audio cable (not included).

- 1 Plug a coaxial digital audio cable into the **COAXIAL DIGITAL AUDIO OUTPUT** (black) on the DVD player and the coaxial digital audio input (black) on a television or stereo system.
- 2 Adjust the television or stereo system's input setting to correspond to the input used when connecting the DVD player.



TV Interface

- 1 When connected to a television, the docked iPod can be controlled from the on-screen display.
- 2 Use the **DIRECTIONAL/ENTER** buttons to navigate and make selections on the on-screen display.

Docking an iPod

- 1 Press the face of the **iPod DOCKING DRAWER**.
- 2 Connect the iPod to the connector inside the **iPod DOCKING DRAWER**.
When the speaker is plugged in, using AC power, the docked iPod will charge.

Playing an iPod

- 1 Follow the instructions for docking an iPod.
- 2 Press the **POWER** button to turn the DVD player on.
- 3 Press the **SOURCE** button to switch to iPod mode.
After switching to iPod mode, "INITIALIZING" will appear on the TV display if connected. Wait until the display reads "CONNECT OK" before moving on to step 4.
- 4 Use the **DIRECTIONAL/ENTER** buttons to navigate and make selections on the on-screen display.

DVD and CD

Playing a DVD or CD

- 1 Connect the DVD player to a television and press the **POWER** button to turn the DVD player on.
- 2 Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to open the **DISC DRAWER**.
- 3 Load a DVD or CD into the **DISC DRAWER**, label side facing up, and press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to close the **DISC DRAWER**.
- 4 The loaded DVD or CD will begin playing automatically. If it does not, press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button.

Programming a DVD or CD

- 1 Follow the instructions for "Playing a DVD or CD".
- 2 Press the **PROG** button on the remote.
- 3 Press the **DIRECTIONAL/ENTER** buttons to select a program memory slot.
- 4 Add titles and chapters or tracks to the program menu using the **NUMBER KEYPAD**.
Titles and chapters or tracks will play in the order they are added.
- 5 Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to play the programmed DVD or CD.
- 6 To cancel the program, press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to open the disc drawer.

Playing a JPEG Photo CD

- 1 Press the **SOURCE** button to switch to DVD mode.
- 2 Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to open the **DISC DRAWER**.
- 3 Load a JPEG Photo CD into the **DISC DRAWER**, label side facing up, and press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to close the **DISC DRAWER**.
- 4 Press the **DIRECTIONAL/ENTER** buttons to highlight and select photos from the loaded JPEG CD.

Accessing the DVD Setup Menu

To access the DVD setup menu, press the **SETUP** button on the remote.

Overview

Just as Apple continues to update and improve its software and hardware, iLive works to remain up-to-date with the latest offerings from Apple.

Continue to check the iLive website (www.ilive.net) for future updates to your ID200B.

Checking your DVD player's current software

1. Power on DVD player.
2. Remove any CD or DVDs from the **DISC DRAWER**.
3. Press "9735" using the **NUMBER KEYPAD** on the remote.
4. Your DVD player's current software version will be listed after "Software data-code". Write down this number for reference.
5. Go to www.ilive.net and click on the support tab. Then select ID200B from the list of products.
6. Select **DOWNLOADS**, then compare your DVD player's software datacode to the code listed in the Firmware Update section. If your DVD player's datacode does not match the most recent firmware update, then your player can be updated.
7. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button on the DVD player to exit the software menu.

WARNING: Do not adjust the region code on the DVD player. Changing the region code can result in issues with your DVD player's ability to read DVDs.

Preparation

You will need all of the following.

- Computer connected to the Internet.
- CD drive that is capable of reading and writing CD disk
- Blank CD-R or CD-RW disc.

Creating a Firmware Disk

1. Go to www.ilive.net and click on the support tab. Then select ID200B from the list of products.
2. Select DOWNLOADS, then click on the most recent firmware update and save file to your computer.
3. Load a blank CD into a CD writable drive.
4. Copy and Paste or Drag and Drop firmware file to CD drive, and write (burn) file to CD.

Installing Updates

1. Power on DVD player.
2. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to open the **DISC DRAWER**. Insert the firmware disc. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to close the **DISC DRAWER**.
The DVD player will read disk and automatically begin update process. The update process will take several minutes.
3. The DVD player will automatically power off when the update is complete.
4. Once update is complete, power on the DVD player and remove update disk.
5. Press the **SETUP** button to access the system setup menu.
6. Select "Default Reset" and press the **ENTER** button.
7. Your DVD player is now updated.

The following events may cause the writing of the firmware update to the player to be halted and the player to no longer operate properly.

- DO NOT unplug the power cord during the firmware update process.
- Avoid loss or interruption of power during the firmware update process.
- DO NOT press the power button on the unit during the firmware update process.
- Check the firmware update disc for dirt or scratches before beginning the firmware update process.
