Basic playback

- Press POWER switch on the front paneal to turn on, and the TV screen will display log.

 The LED will display NO DISC if the DVD player has no disc in the tray. If a disc is already in the tray, it will begin to play the disc.
- 2. Press OPEN / CLOSE to open the disc tray, place a disc on the disc tray. There are two different disc sizes. Place the disc in the correct guide on the disc tray. If the disc if off the guide, it may damage the disc and cause the DVD player to malfunction. Do not place a disc which is unplayable in this DVD player.
- 3. Prass OPEN/CLOSE to close the diac tray, the playback will automatically start. Some diacs may not playback automatically, you can press ENTER/ PLAY button to start playback and also you may start playback with a menu, cursor button on the remote controller, select menu options and press ENTER/PLAY or prass figures to select a manu options.

Stop playback

- Prass the button to go to stop mode, the TV screen will show the start logo, as some disc the player can recall the location where stopped,


Please use the [PROG] mode under the state stopping!
