Timer Link

Note: Timer-Link works by using the timer function of most Cable/Satellite Boxes. Please check whether your current box has a "Timer" function.



Note: Timer-Link doesn't work, if Cable/Satellite Box keeps a "Screen Saver" in "Power Off".
Timer-Link works only with "Input 1" connector.





Note: If the Timer-Link "On", "●" indicator blinks on the JVC deck's display window.




1 Set Up Timer of Cable/Satellite Box

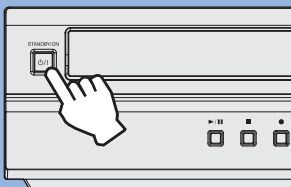

5 Power Off DR-MV79B

6 Hold "● (REC)" Button for 3 seconds

1. When your Cable/Satellite Box is powered on by the timer function, DR-MV79B is also powered on and starts to record (It takes about 1 seconds) automatically.
2. When your Cable/Satellite Box is powered off using the timer function, DR-MV79B also stops recording (It takes about 3 seconds) and then powers off automatically.

Timer-Link mode: Deactivate



This operation makes "Timer-Link" been off after finishing Timer-Link record. If you keep "Timer-Link" on, you don't need this step.

Dubbing from VCR to DVD

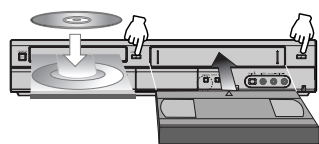

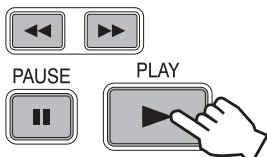
You can copy the contents of a VHS tape to a DVD using the **DUBBING** button. This allows you to archive your old VHS tapes to DVD.

Preparation : Press VCR button to set the VCR mode.

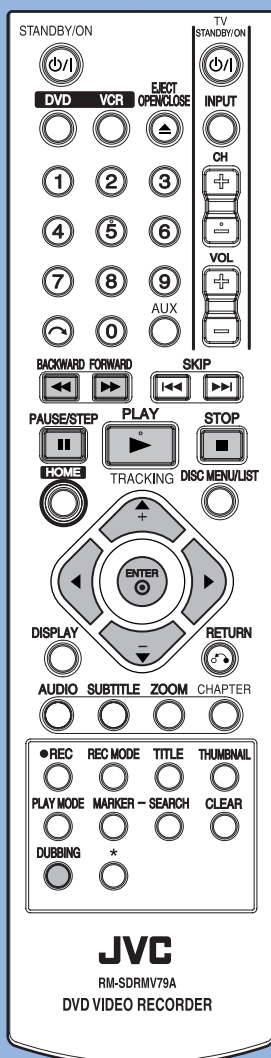
- 1** Insert Blank Disc and Cassette



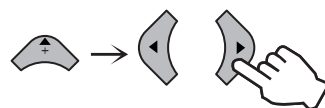
- 2** Find the place on the VHS tape from which you want to start dubbing.



- 3** Access the Dubbing menu screen.

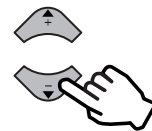


- 4** Select the desired Record Mode.



Select XP, SP, LP or EP

- 5** Select [Dubbing].



- 6** Start Dubbing.



- 7** Stop Dubbing.
