Displays the phrases menu.

✓ Viewing the Demonstration

To see a demonstration of this translator, press (MENU), press J until *Demo* appears, and then press (ENTER). To stop the demonstration at any time press (CLEAR).

✓ Auto-Shutoff

If you forget to turn this translator off, it will shut off in two minutes. When you turn on your translator again, operation resumes with your current settings.

To Set the Message Language

The first time you use this translator, you must set the message language. The message language is the language of screen instructions and menu items.

- 1. Press ON/OFF.
- 2. Press one of the language keys (ENG, FRA, ESP, or TA) to select the message language.

To Change the Message Language

- 1. Press MENU.
- 2. Press I to scroll to *Message Language*, and then press ENTER to select it.
- 3. Press a language key to change the message language.

✓ About Screen Illustrations

Some screen illustrations in this User's Guide may differ from what you see on the screen. The examples in the English section of this User's Guide use English as the message language.

✓ Changing Screen Contrast

To adjust the screen contrast, press (CLEAR) to go to a source language screen and then press \mathcal{J} or \mathcal{T} repeatedly to change the contrast.

Translating Words

You can use this translator to translate a word from a source language into a target language. You can change the source language at a source language screen by pressing the desired language key.

- 1. Press CLEAR.
- 2. To change the source language, press a language key.
- 3. Type up to two words.

To type a space, press \Rightarrow .

To erase a letter, press \square or \triangleleft .

4. Press a language key to select a target language.

Or press ENTER to translate the word into the most recently selected target language.

5. If needed, use ↓ or ↑ to select a desired form or phrase and press ENTER. To see a word or phrase that does not fit on the screen, press c) repeatedly.

6. Press ENTER to toggle between the source language and the target language. Or press BACK to go back to the previous screen. To translate the word into another target language, press one of the language keys.
Press CLEAR when finished.

Correcting Misspellings

If you misspell a word in any language, or if you enter a word that is not contained in this translator, a list of corrections appears. Use \mathcal{I} or \mathcal{T} to scroll to a correctly spelled word and press ENTER.

✓ Follow the Arrows

The flashing arrows on the right of the screen show which arrow keys you can press to move around the screen.

Typing Special Characters

You can type accent marks, diacritical marks, non-English letters, and capital letters, but they are not needed to find matches.

Special characters can be typed by first typing the desired letter and then repeatedly pressing \uparrow or \square until the desired character is displayed.

You also cannot type any punctuation marks. Simply type the word without punctuation marks.

Translating Phrases

NOTE: The phrases in this product will be listed in the current source language.

- 1. Press PHRS.
- 2. Use \mathcal{I} or \mathcal{T} to scroll to a category.
- 3. Press ENTER.
- 4. Type a phrase or use \mathcal{L} or \mathcal{T} to scroll to it.



To see a phrase that does not fit on the screen, press \Rightarrow repeatedly.

5. Press a language key to translate the phrase.

To see another translation, press another language key.

6. Press CLEAR when finished.

Finding Telephone Numbers

You can find telephone numbers for airlines and airports around the world.

- 1. Press MENU.
- 2. Press I repeatedly until *Telephone Number* appears.
- 3. Press ENTER.
- 4. Use 𝔅 or ☆ until *Airline* or *Airport* appears and press ENTER.

You can also type the abbreviation for the airline or airport.

- 6. Press ENTER.

If needed, press \Rightarrow to view the country telephone code in parentheses.

- 8. Press ENTER to view the phone number.
- 9. Press (CLEAR) when finished.

Calculator and Conversions

To Use the Calculator

- 1. Press CALC.
- 2. Use the numbered keys to type a number. To type a decimal point press I. NOTE: in this product, a (•) is used as a decimal indicator. To erase a single digit, press (BACK). To clear the number, press (CLEAR).
- 3. Press (+), (+), (-), (-), (x), or (+) (+) to add, subtract, multiply, or divide.
- 4. Type another number.
- 5. Press ENTER (=) to calculate the equation. Or press V (%) to calculate the percentage.
- 6. To clear the calculation, press CLEAR.

To Use Conversions

1. If not already at the calculator press CALC and then press (ਟ) (CONV). Or press MENU, press ↓ until Conversions

appears, and then press ENTER.

2. Use \clubsuit to scroll to a category, and then press ENTER to select it.

- Use J repeatedly to scroll to the conversions (i.e., °F→°C) and then press ENTER.
- 4. Follow the screen directions to convert and press ENTER.
- 5. Press (CLEAR) when finished.

✓ Converting Money

When you select the money converter, you must set the exchange rate equal to one unit of the home currency. First, select *Money* from the *Conversions* menu, select *Set rate*, and then type an exchange rate and press **ENTER** to select it. Finally, select a conversion (e.g., *Home→other*) and enter the amount to be converted.

To change the conversion rate, select *Money* from the *Conversions* menu, select *Set rate*, and type a new exchange rate.

Playing the Games

To Play Hangman

Hangman challenges you to type the letters of a mystery word.

- 1. Press MENU.
- 2. Press J. until Hangman appears and press ENTER.
- 3. To change the language of the mystery word, press one of the language keys.
- 4. Type letters.

The ?'s represent letters of the mystery word. The numbers show how many guesses remain.

5. To show the word and end the round, press [ENTER].

6. Press ENTER again to play a new round.

To Play Quiz

Quiz tests your translation skills. Note: To change the language for Quiz, you must change the source language before you play. See "Translating Words" for more information.

- 1. Press MENU.
- 2. Press J until Quiz appears and press ENTER. Say the word and try to guess its translation.
- 3. Press a language key to see its translation.
- 4. Press ENTER again to start a new round.

Replacing the Battery

This product uses one CR2032, 3-volt lithium battery. Should you need to replace the battery, unscrew the screws on the back with a very fine screwdriver and carefully remove the back cover. Then install a new battery, plus sign (+) facing you, and replace the cover.
