
Changing the Programme Order of the broadcast channels

First: Media Receiver Unit 1 Second: Display Unit 2























The first time you press the **b** Power switch, a Language menu displays automatically on the TV screen.

1 Press the 4/4/4 or 4 button on the remote control to select the language, then press the **OK** button to confirm your selection.

From now on all the menus will appear in the selected language.

2 The **Country** menu appears automatically on the TV screen.

Press the **◆** or **♦** button to select the country in which you will operate the TV set, then press the **OK** button to confirm your selection.
