

Install the aligning stands in the correct direction.

Step 2

Connect one or two wireless PS3 controllers to the charging port. Controllers will only fit one way.



Step 3

Connect the small end of the supplied USB cable to your charging station and the bigger end to the USB port on your PS3 console to power your charging station.

Note: Remove controllers when fully charged.
