STEP 1

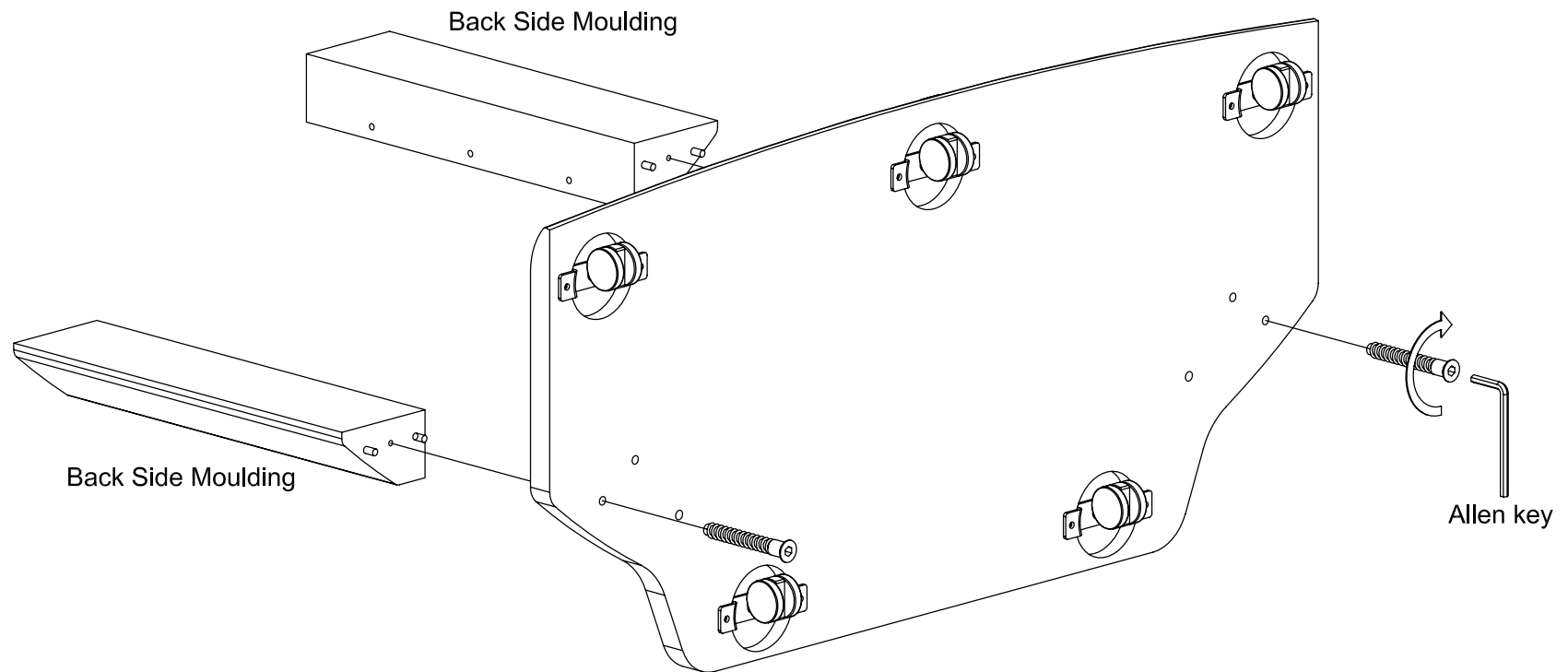


1. Fasten 5 Castors to the Base as shown.
2. Insert Wooden Dowels as shown above.

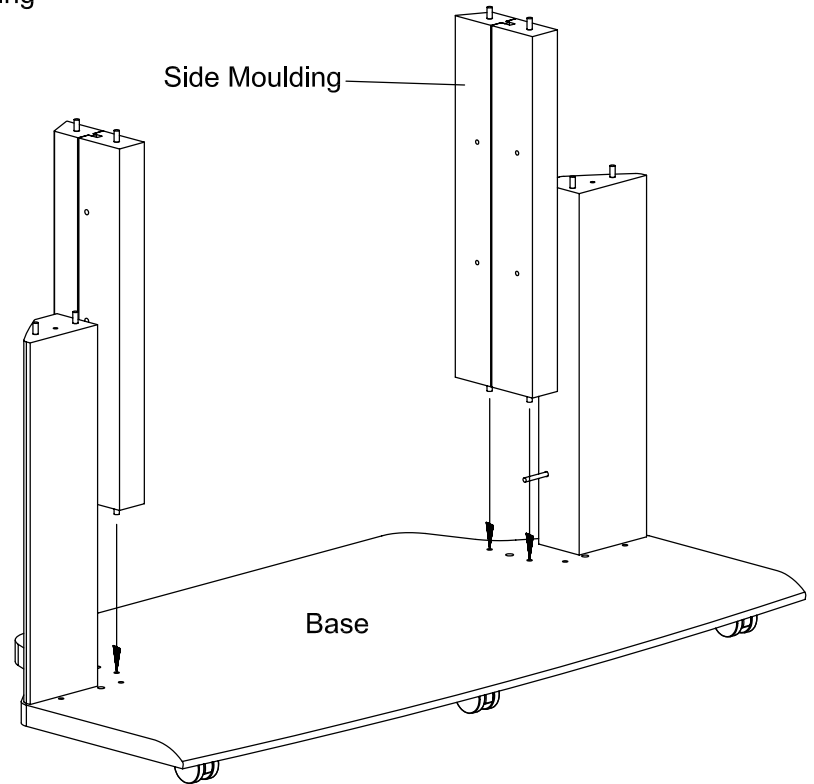
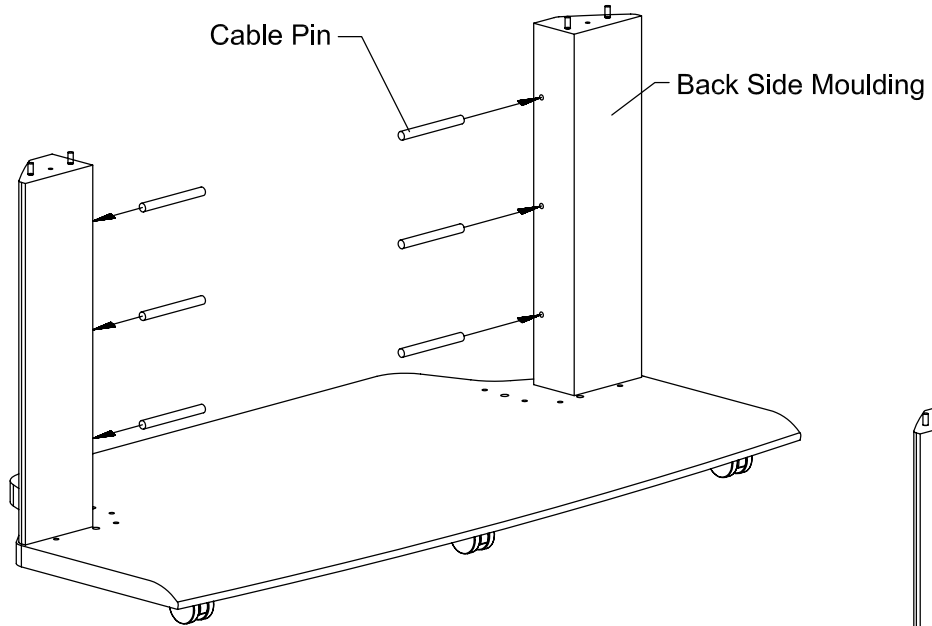


1. Fasten the Back Side Mouldings to the Base as shown.

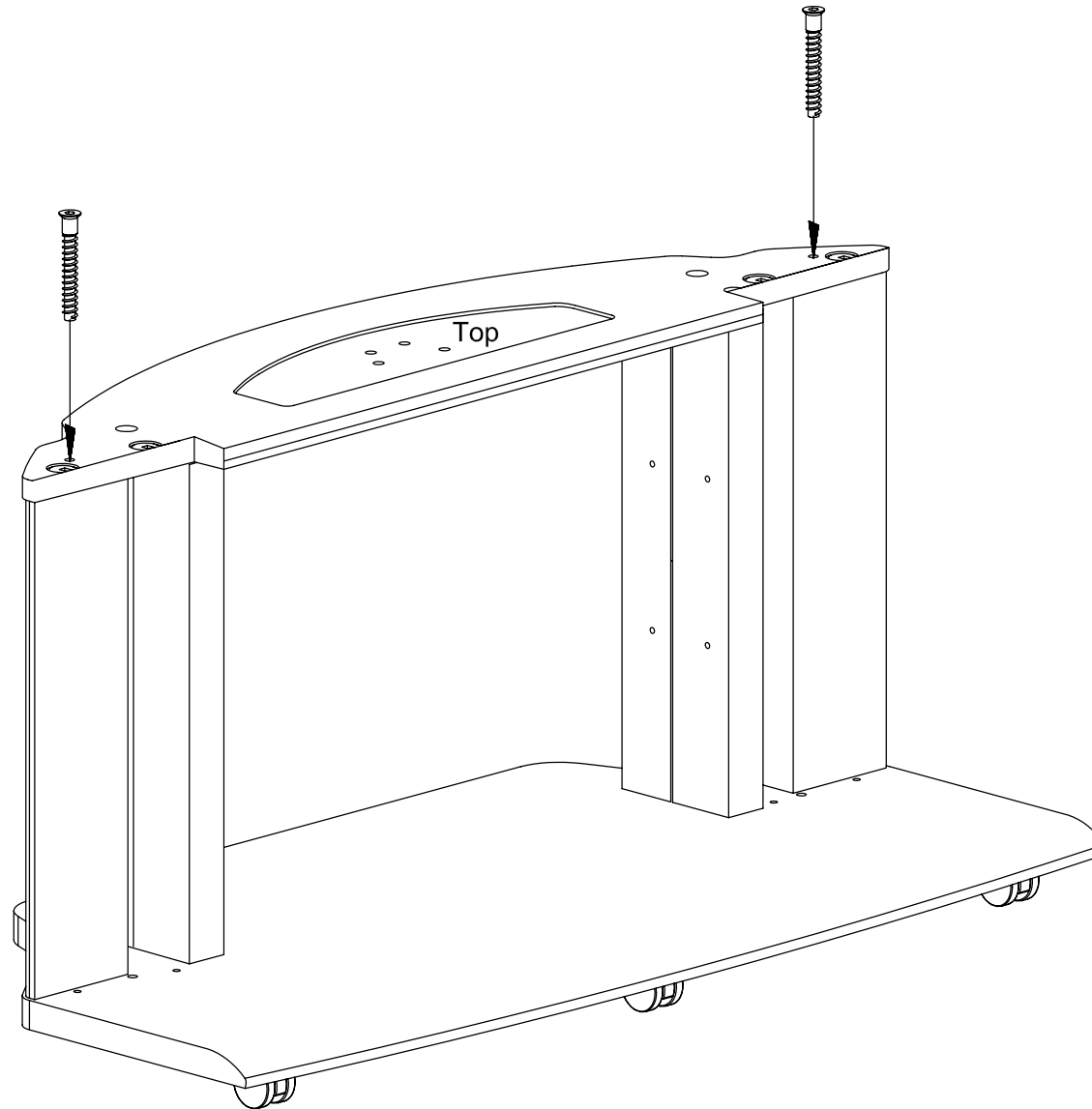
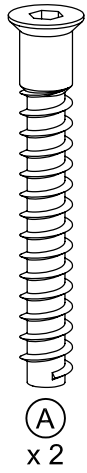

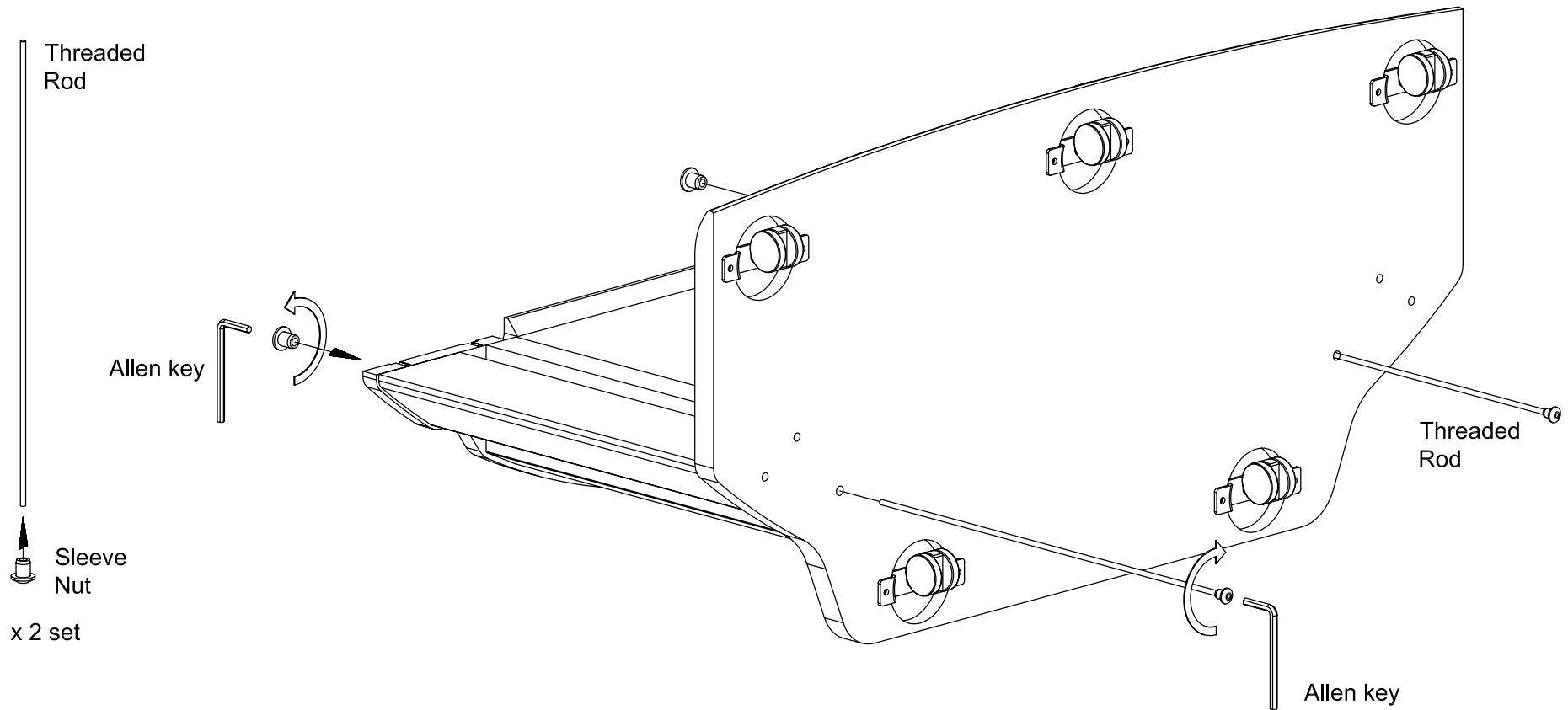
1. Fully insert 6 Cable Pins into the holes in the sides of the Back Side Mouldings as shown.
2. Fit Side Mouldings to the Base as shown.

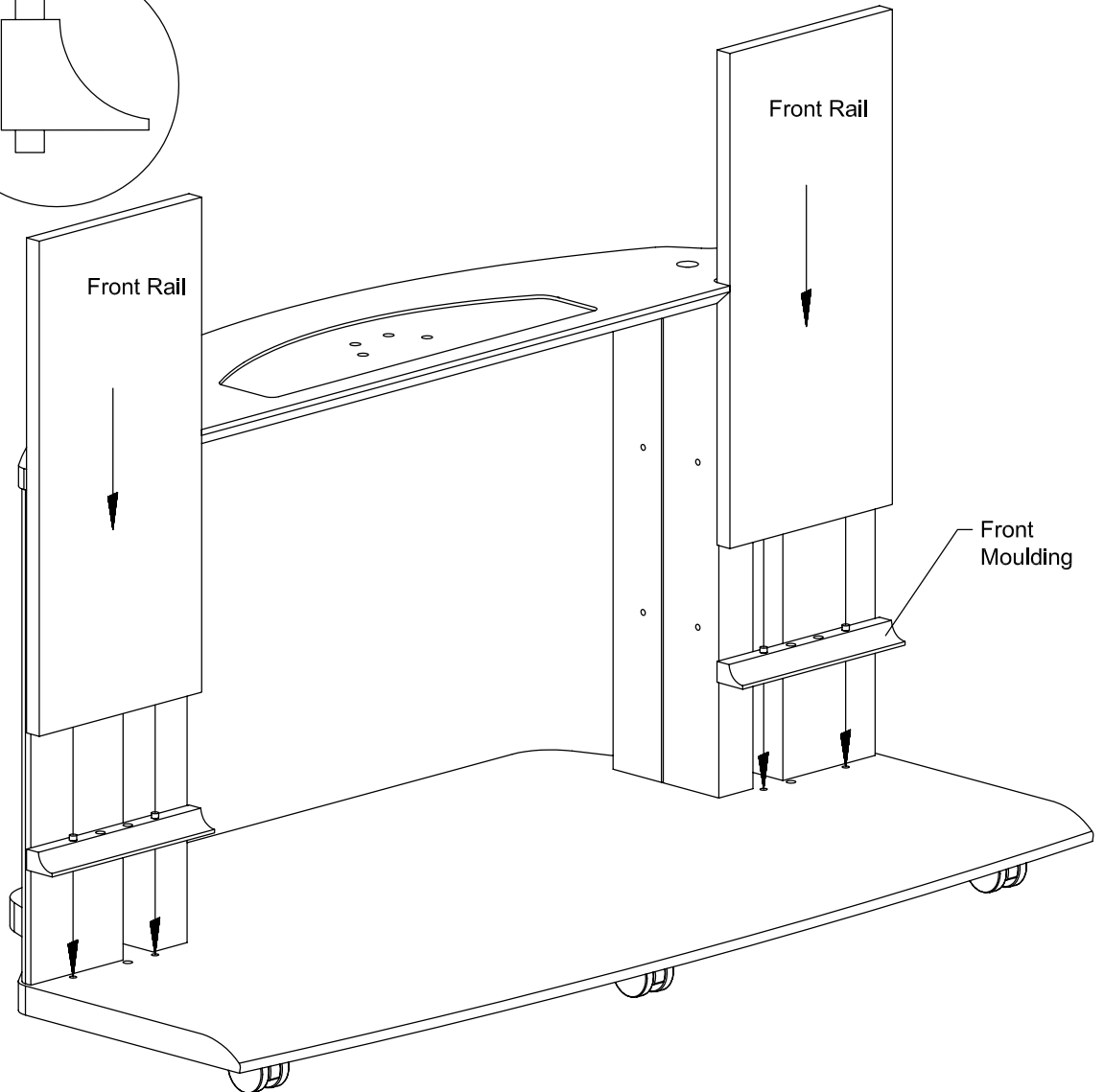
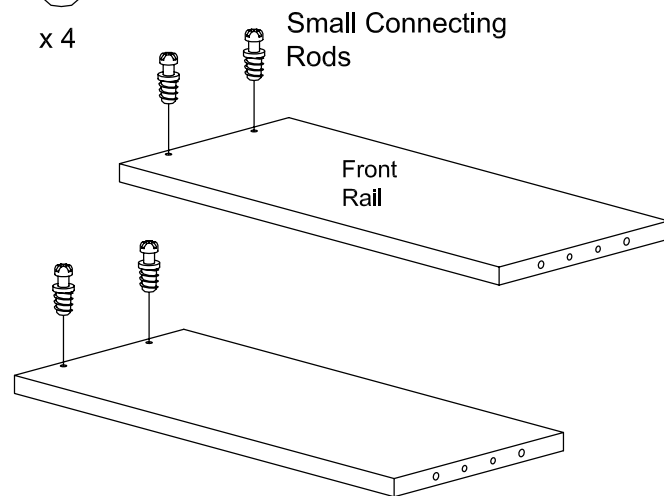
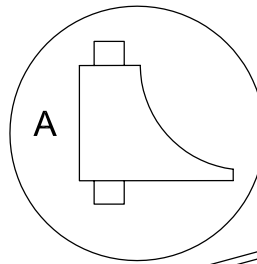
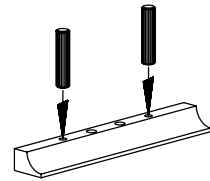
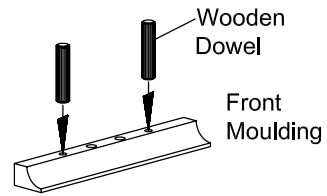
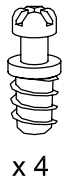
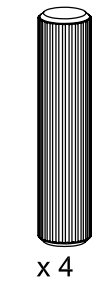
1. Secure Top to Back Side Mouldings with 2 Screws as shown.

STEP 5



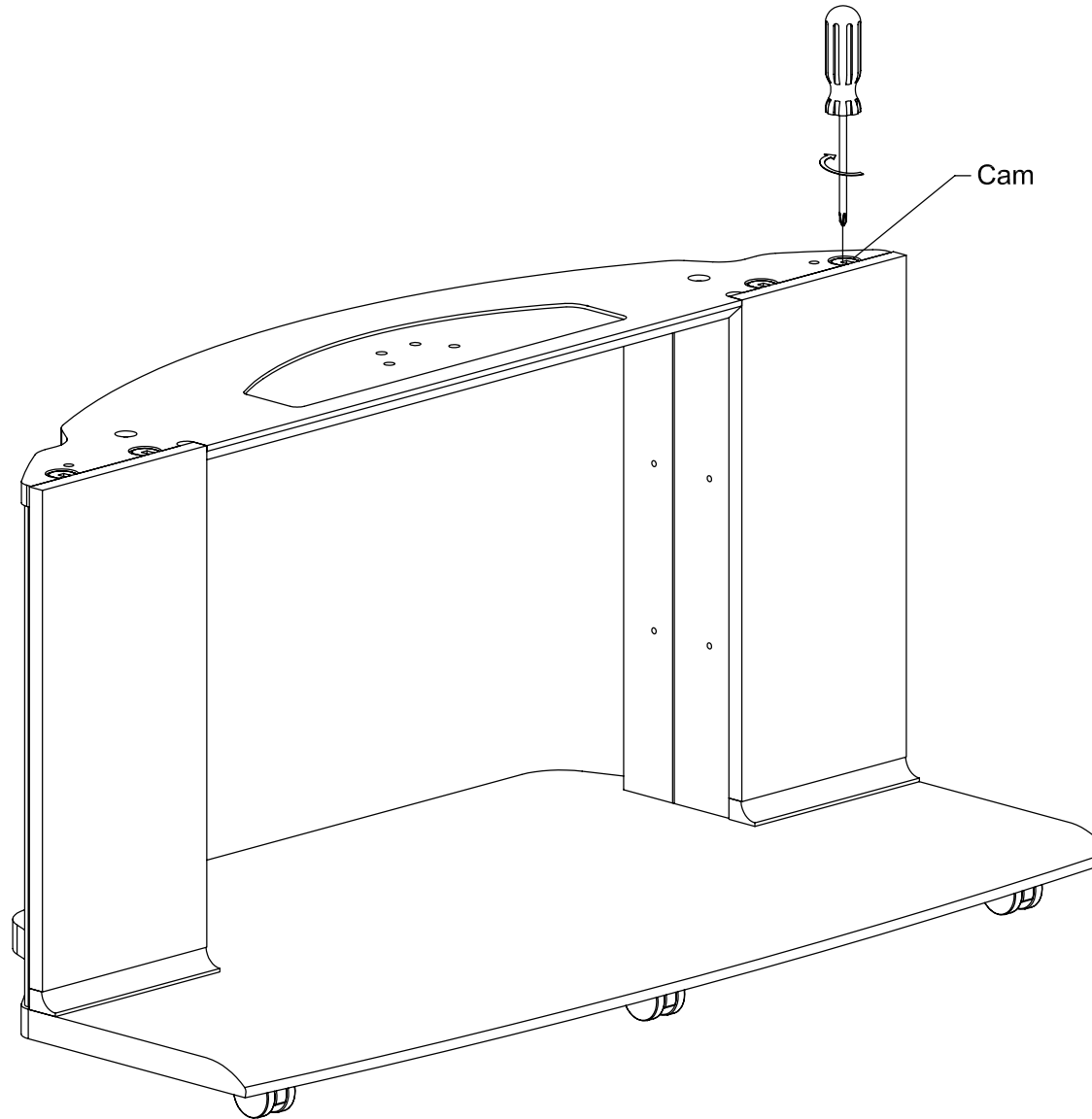
1. Fit Sleeve Nut at one end of each Threaded Rod using an Allen Key.
2. Insert Threaded Rod into Assembly through Base as shown.
3. Fit another Sleeve Nut at other end of Threaded Rod from Top and tighten it turning both Allen Keys in opposite direction of each other.

STEP 6



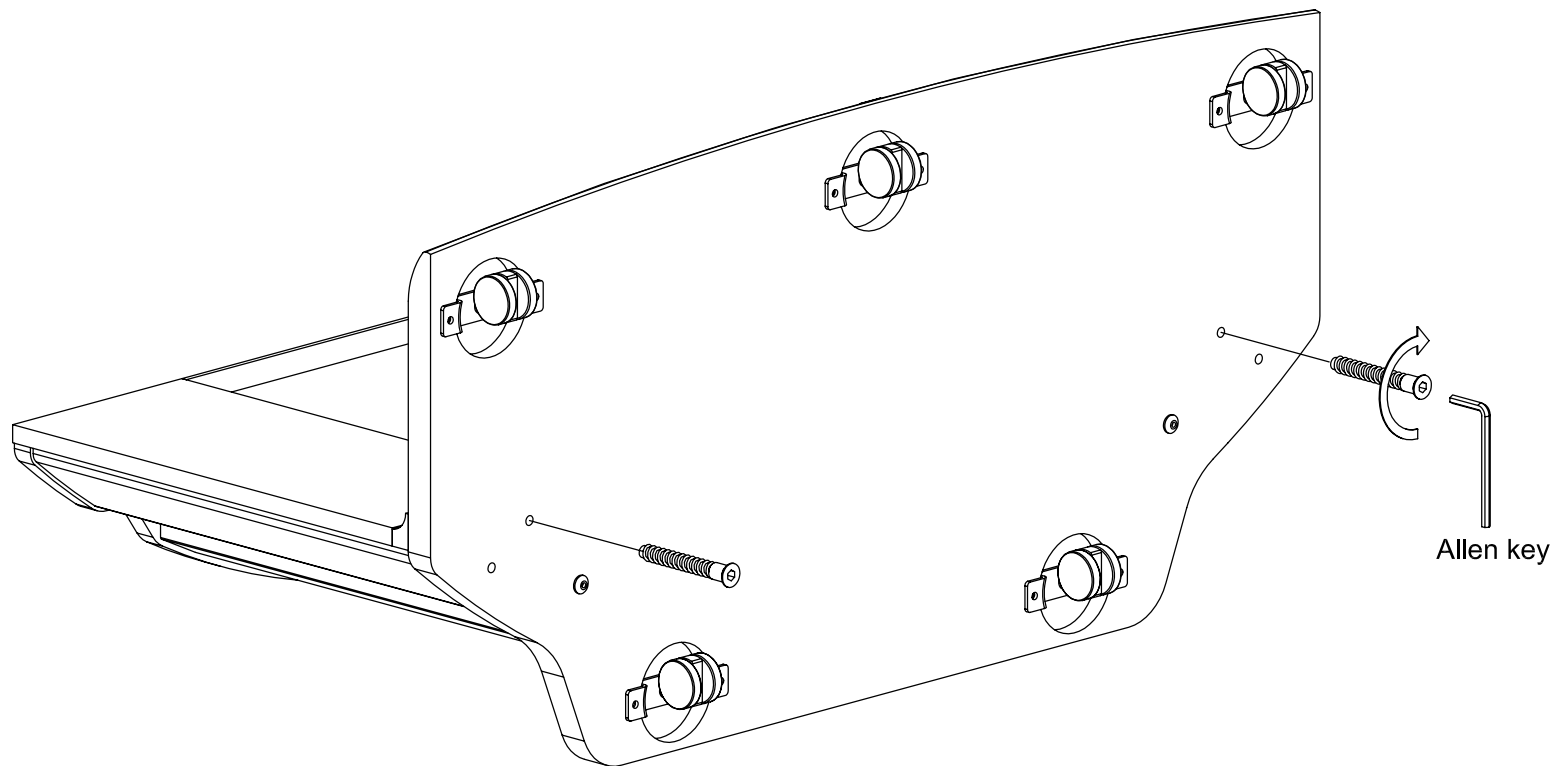
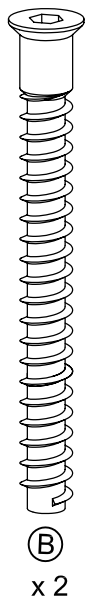
1. Fit 2 Small Connecting Rods to each Front Rail as shown.
2. Insert 2 Wooden Dowels into each of Front Moulding so that the Dowels project equally on both sides, as shown above in A.
3. Fit Front Mouldings to Base as shown.
4. Fit Front Rails on to Front Mouldings as shown.

STEP 7



1. Tighten the 4 prefitted Cams in Top, by turning them clockwise.

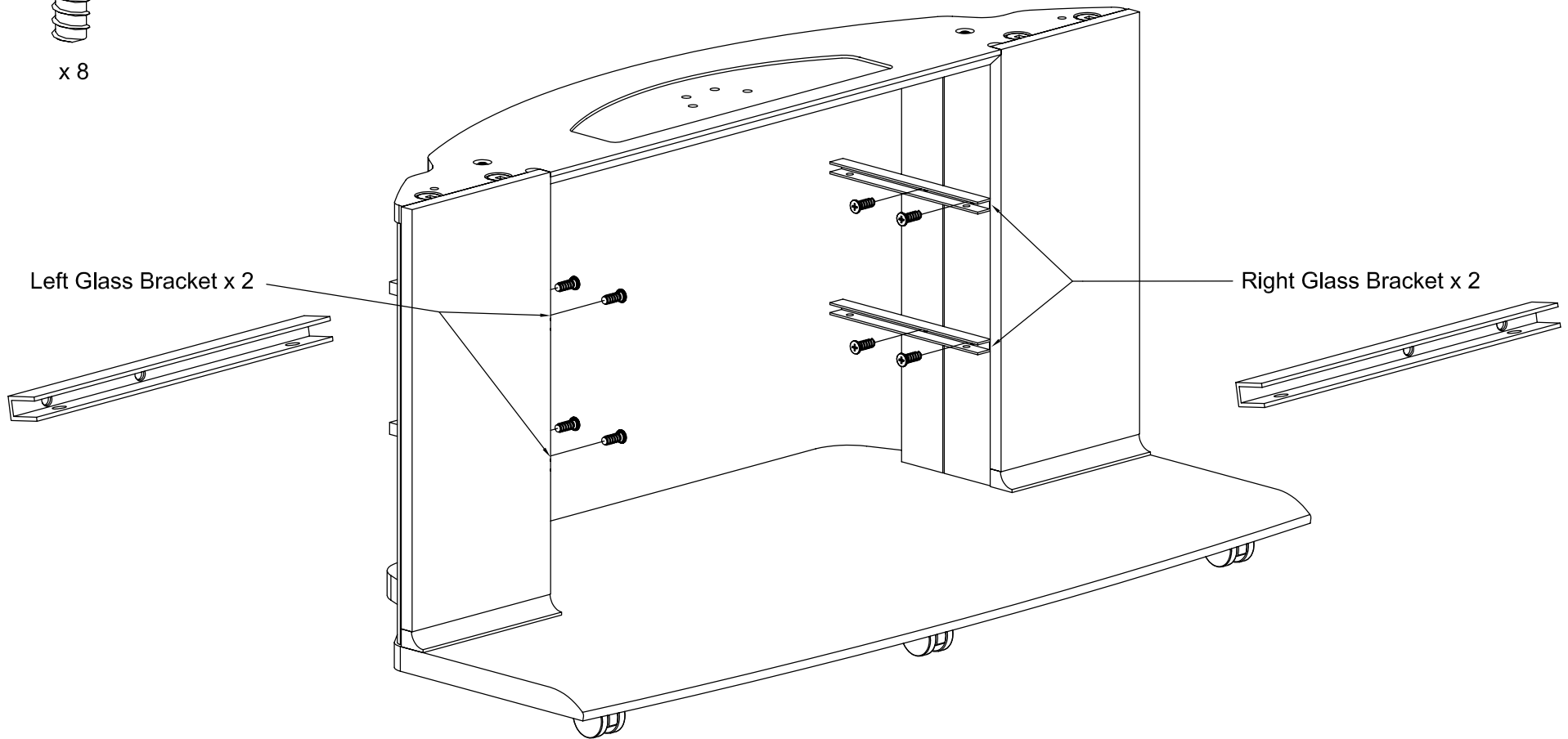


1. Fasten the Front Rails and Front Mouldings to the Base using 2 Locking Screws Ⓑ

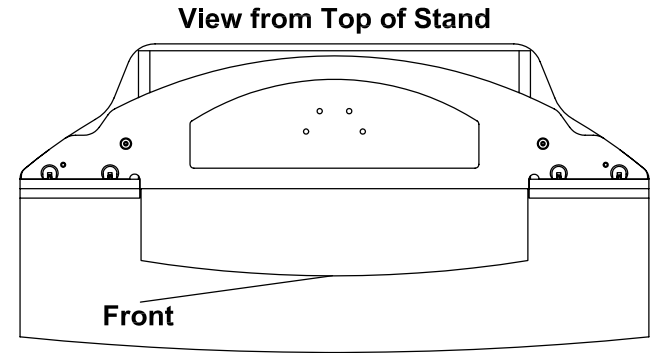
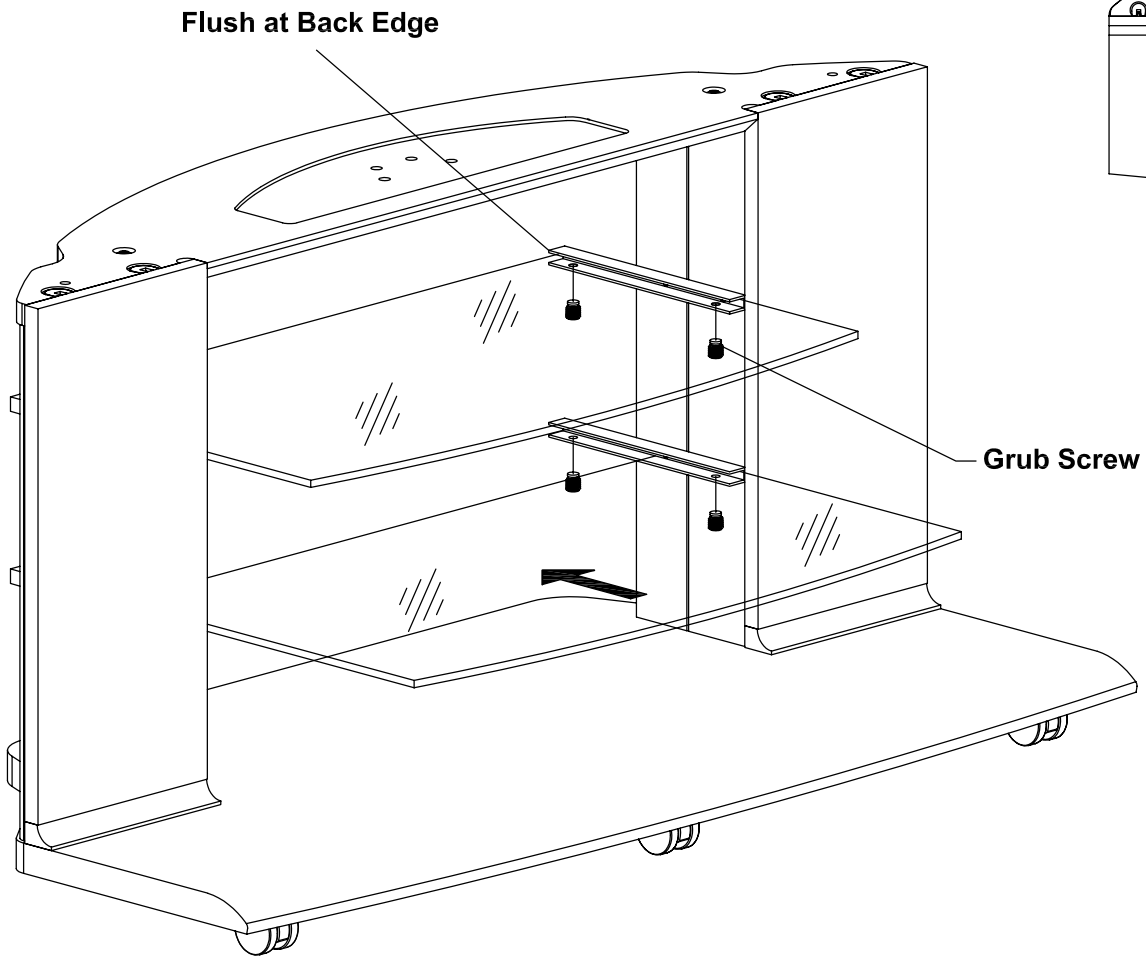


1. Fasten the Glass Brackets to Side Mouldings using Screws as shown.

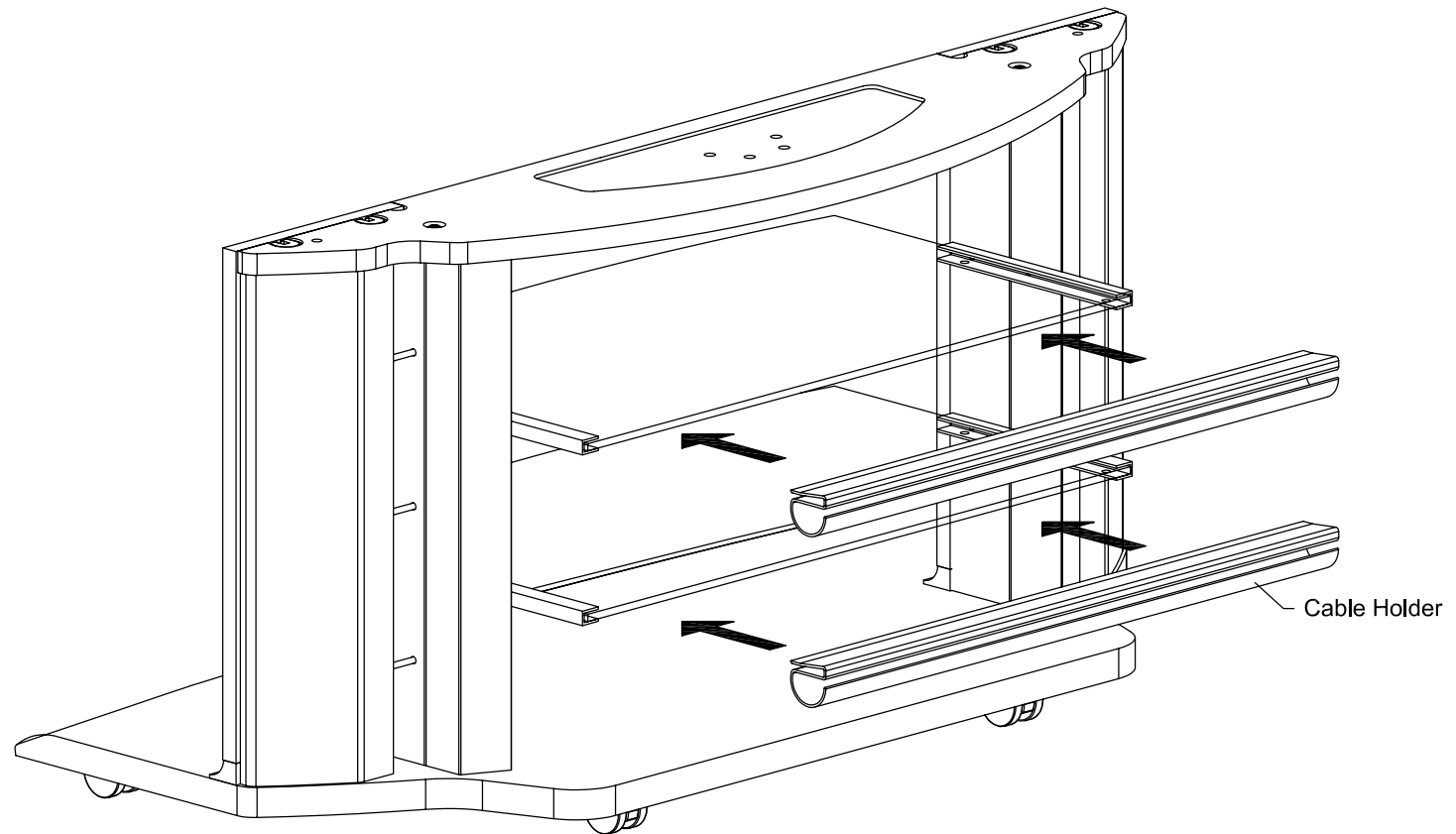

IMPORTANT: Curved Edge of Glass faces Front of Stand.

1. Slide each Glass Shelf into Glass Brackets and tighten Grub Screws from the underside of brackets as shown, make sure the Back Edge of Glass Shelf is flush with Glass Bracket.

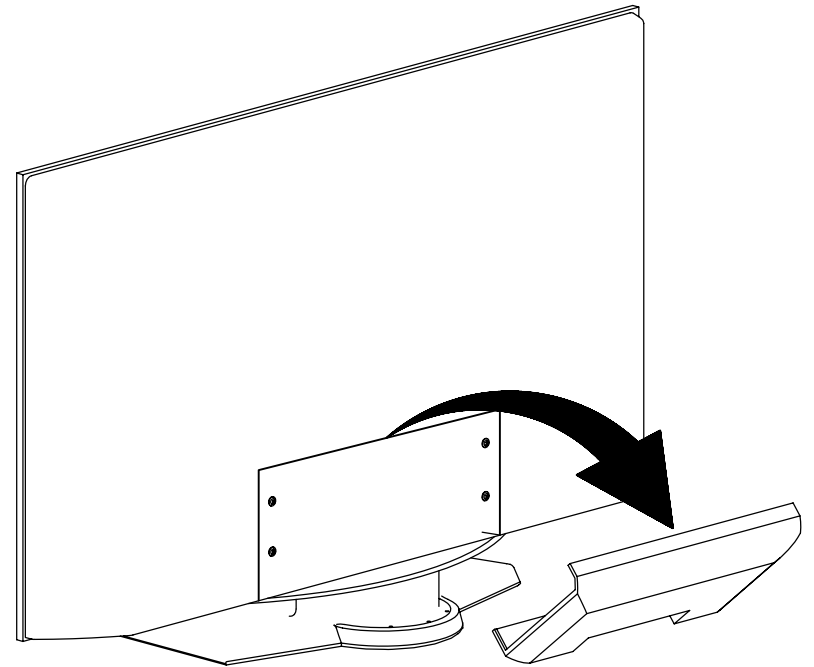
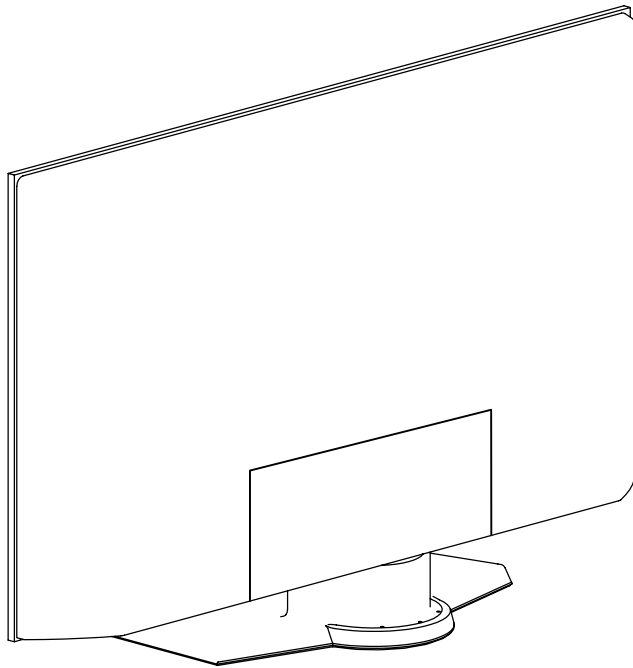

1. Slide fit each Cable Holder onto the Back Edge of each Glass Shelf.

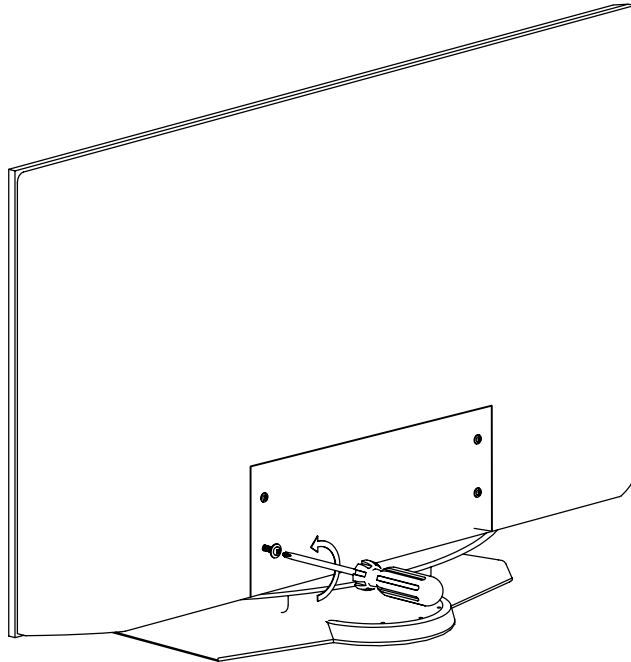

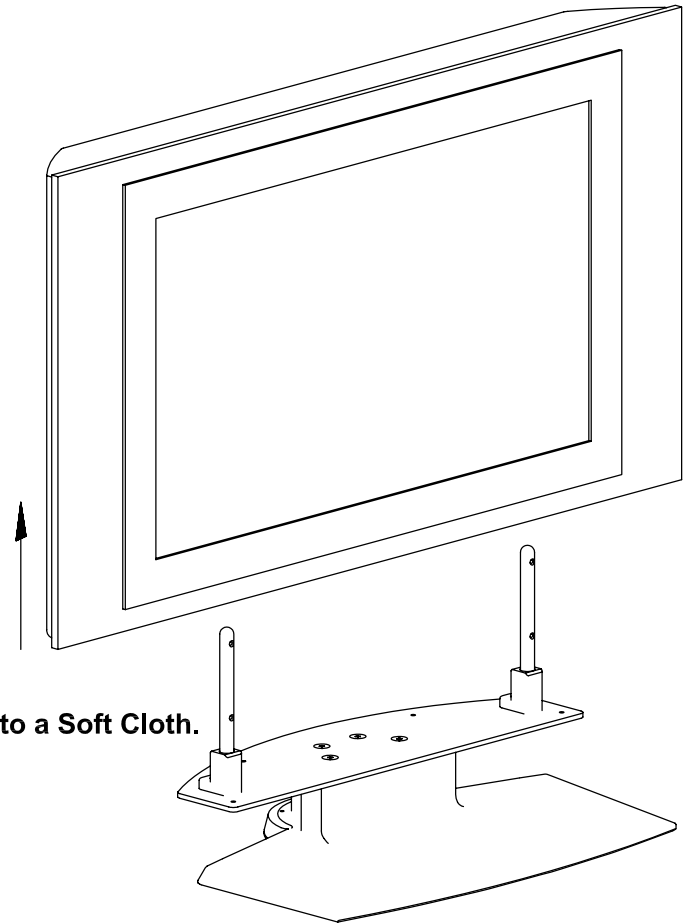
1. Remove the Television from Box. CAUTION: TWO PERSON LIFT.
2. Remove Back Cover of Television to expose 4 Mount Screws.

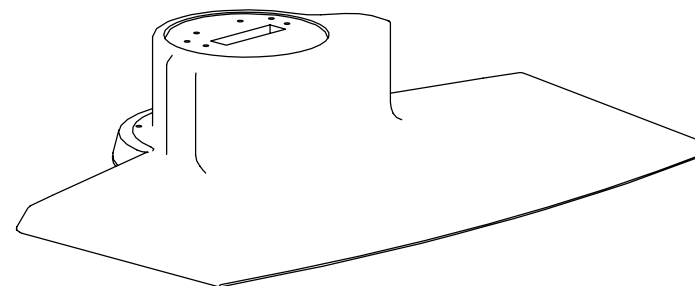
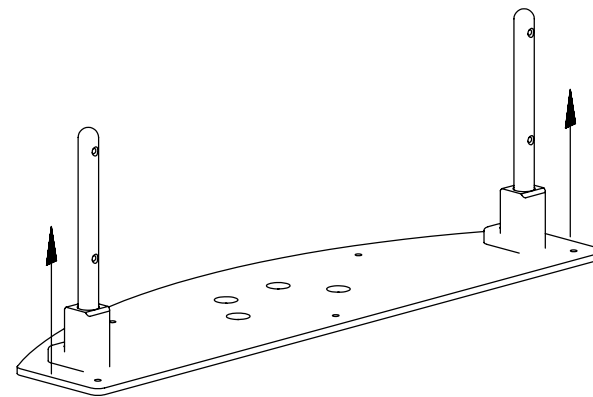
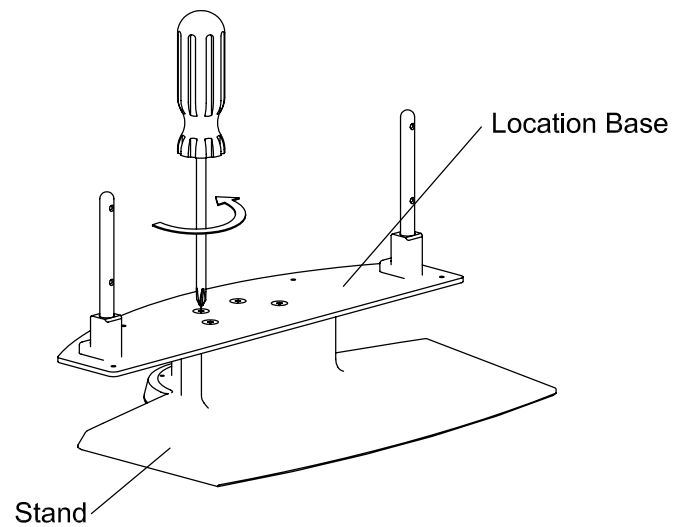


With great care place Television Screen Face up onto a Soft Cloth.



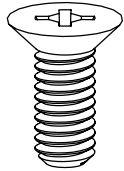
1. Remove 4 Screws from inside of Back Cover as shown.

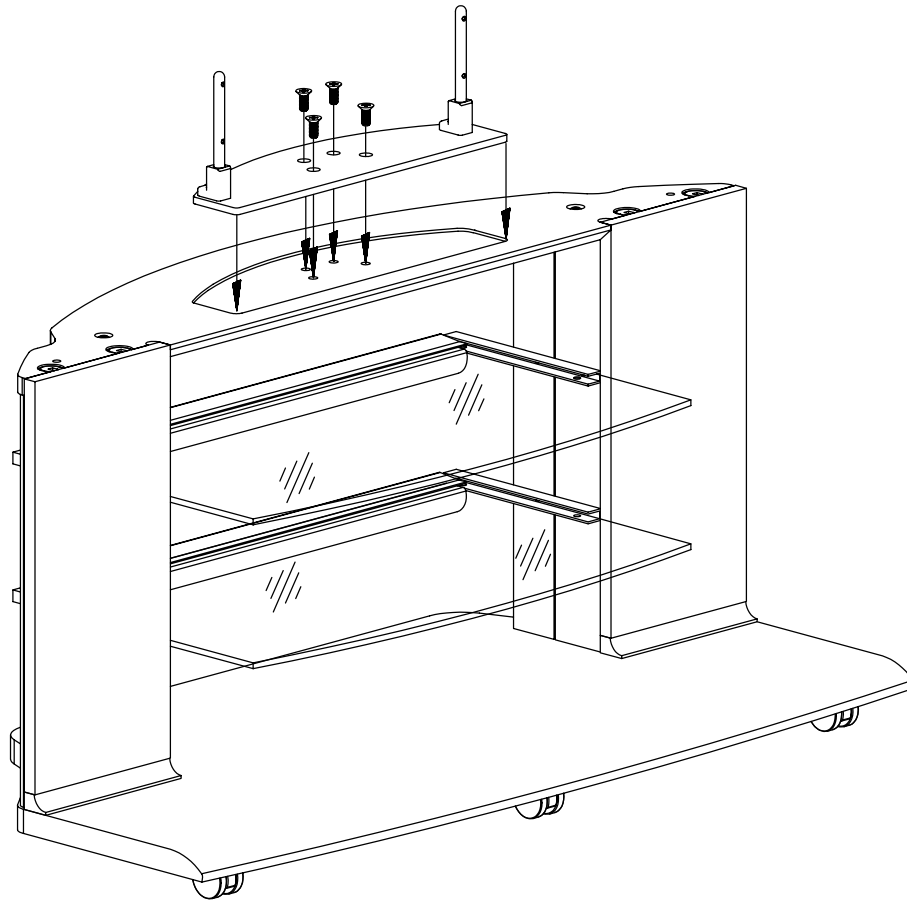


1. Remove 4 Screws from the Location Base as shown.
2. Lift the Location Base off the Stand.

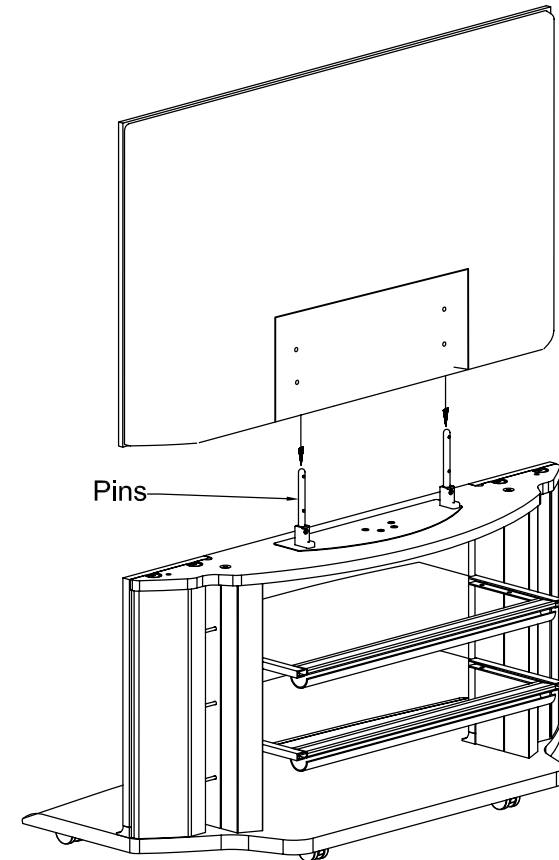

CAUTION TWO PERSON LIFT.



1. Fasten the Location Base to the Top of the Cabinet as shown above using 4 Screws removed during Step 14.
2. With help of an Assistant, lift the Television onto Pins ensuring that the Pins line up with the Holes in base of Television.

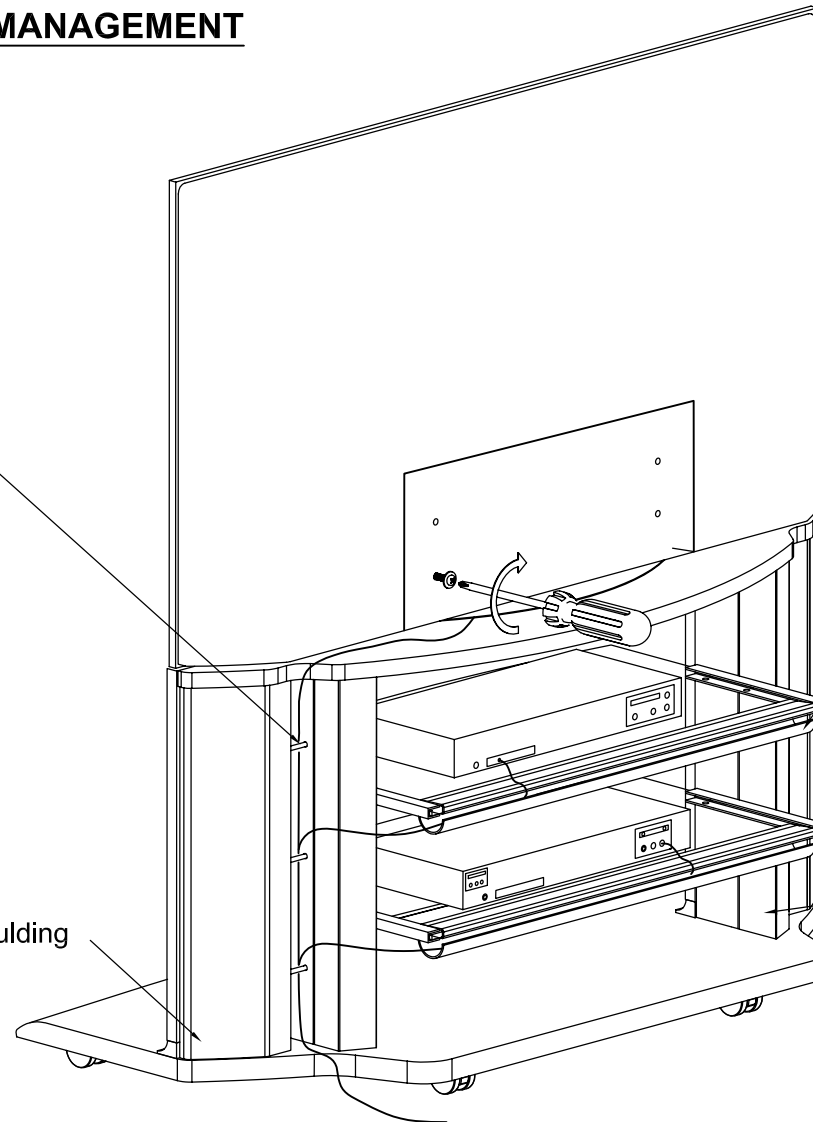
CABLE MANAGEMENT

Once Cables are behind Pins, slide the Cable Pins across into the Side Moulding.

Back Side Moulding

Place Cables from Electronic Equipment into Cable Holder.

Side Moulding



1. Secure the Television to the Cabinet using Screws removed during Step 13.
2. Replace Cover onto Back of Television.
3. With Cable Pins pushed into Back Side Mouldings, place Cables behind pins, then slide Pins across into the Side Mouldings.

Congratulations you have now finished the assembly for your Panasonic Television Stand.
