

# **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

## MAINTENANCE

 When the power cord or plug is damaged or frayed, unplug this TV from the wall outlet and refer servicing to qualified service personnel.



 Do not overload wall outlets and extension cords as this can result in fire or electric shock.



 Do not allow anything to rest on or roll over the power cord and do not place the TV where the power cord is subject to traffic or abuse. This may result in a shock or fire hazard.



• If the TV has been dropped or the cabinet has been damaged, unplug this TV from the wall outlet and refer servicing to qualified service personnel.



Never push objects of any kind into this TV through cabinet slots as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short out parts that could result in a fire or electric shock.



 Do not attempt to service this TV yourself as opening or removing covers may expose you to dangerous voltage. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.



Do not place this TV on an unstable cart, stand or table. The TV may fall, causing serious injury to human and serious damage to the appliance.



 Avoid dusty places, since accumulated dust inside the chassis may cause failure of the TV when high humidity persists.



 Do not use this TV near water, for example, near a bathtub, washbowl, kitchen sink, or laundry tub, in a wet basement, etc.



 Never cover the slots or openings of the TV with cloth or other material.



 Never block the bottom ventilation slots of the TV by placing it on a bed, sofa, rug, etc.



 Never place the TV near or over a radiator or heat register.



 Never place the TV in a "built-in" enclosure, unless proper ventilation is provided.



• The TV shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the TV.



# **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

## MAINTENANCE

 Choose a place where light (artificial or sunlight) does not shine directly on the screen.



If the TV does not work properly and you are unable to restore normal operation by following the "TROUBLESHOOTING section in your instruction manual, do not attempt any further adjustment. Unplug the TV and consult service personnel."



Adjust only those controls that are covered in the instruction manual as improper adjustment of other controls may result in damage, please ask your service personnel to restore the TV to normal operation.



 For added protection for this TV during a lightning storm, unplug it from the wall outlet and disconnect the antenna or cable system.



• If a strange sound or smell gives off from the TV, please turn off and unplug it from the wall outlet, then refer to service personnel.



 To prevent fire, never place any type of candle or naked flames on the top or near the



 Avoid any kind of impact to the TV. Be special careful not to damage the screen face.




 If the TV is to remain unused for a period of time, turn off and unplug it from the wall outlet.

# **OP**ositioning the television set



Place your TV on a solid, stable surface, leaving a space of at least 5 cm around the appliance. To avoid accidents, do not put anything on the set such as a cloth or cover, a container full of liquid (vase) or a heat source (lamp). The set must not be exposed to water.

# Connections




Insert the aerial plug into the  $\fill \square \Gamma$  socket at the side of the set.

Insert the mains plug in the wall socket having a mains voltage of 100 240V AC, 50/60Hz.

This TV operates on DC supply, so through AC-DC adapter to socket at the back of the TV, The power is +12VDC.

# Remote control



- \* The remote control's effective range is 5 meters from the LCD screen at an angle of up to ±30 degree. Direct light may affect the remote controls effective range.
- Avoid subjecting the remote control to shocks or vibrations.
- Avoid placing the remote control in humid and hot environments such as direct sunlight.
- Remove the batteries when not using the remote control for long periods.







# **Remote Control Functions**

# **Remote Control Unit For TV**



### POWER BUTTONS

Switch the TV from on to standby or from off to operate.

## **MUTE BUTTON**

Press once to mute the sound, press again to return to previously set sound level.

## **DIGIT BUTTON**

This TV allows you to select channels from 0 to 124.

Press this button to select one-digit, two-digit or three-digit channels input options.


To select a one-digit channel (e.g. Channel 8), press this [-/--] button to change channel selection to "-" on screen display and press the "8" button only.

To select a two-digit channel (e.g. Channel 28), press this ---- button to change channel selection to "--" on screen display and press "2" and "8" buttons.

To select a three-digit channel (e.g. Channel 120), press this -/--- button to change channel selection to "---" on screen display and press "1", "2" and "0" buttons.

# AV/TV BOTTON


Press this buttonto switch among TV broadcast, AV input program and other source. With wraparound.



## MENU BOTTON

Press this button to enter the menu screens for various optional adjustable settings.

# **Remote Control Unit For TV**



PROGRAM UP P. / DOWN P. BOTTONS Press these buttons to select channels in ascending or descending order.

VOLUME UP V.+ / DOWN V.- BOTTONS Press these buttons to adjust the volume level up or down.

HOT KEY - inapplicability

# Q.VIEW BOTTON

Press this button to return to the previously viewed program.

# S.S. BUTTONS

Sound mode set(D/K, B/G, I, L, L')

# P.P. BUTTON

TV mode, press this button to adjust the picture mode.




## **DISPLAY BOTTON**

Press this button to display the settings on the screen. (e.g. Channel number for TV input, colour system, sound system and sound mode.)

# I/II SOUND MODE SELECTION BOTTON

When stereo program is received, press this button to select STEREO or MONO. When bilingual program is received, press this button to select NICAM-I, NICAM-II or MONO.

# SLEEP BUTTON

This key is used to set the sleep time . The choices are 15,30,45,60 and off.

# REVEAL

Press the key to reveal/conceal the hidden information. Such as solutions to riddles and puzzles.



# **PICTURE**



Enter Picture menu, you can select CONTRAST, BRIGHTNESS, COLOUR, SHARPNESS, COLOR TEMP. and PICTURE MODE items by pressing PROG+/- Buttons.

# CONTRAST

Press the **VOL+/-** button to increase/decrease the contrast of the picture.

## **BRIGHTNESS**

Press the **VOL**+/- button to lighten/darken the picture.

Press the **VOL+/-** button to increase/decrease the colour saturation.

SHARPNESS Press the button to sharpen or soften the picture.

# COLOR TEMP.

Press the button to select a suitable colour temperature to display.
The choices are "Warm", "Normal", "Cool".

# PICTURE MODE

Press the button to change the contrast and brightness and colourvalue of picture. The choices are "USER", "NATURE", "SOFT", "BRIGHT", with wrap arround.

# AUDIO



Enter AUDIO menu, you can select BASS, TREBLE, BALANCE, SOUND MODE, NICAM and AVL items by pressing PROG+/- Buttons.

Press the VOL+ or VOL- button to adjust the bass boost value.

# **TREBLE**

Press the **VOL+** or **VOL-** button to adjust the high frequency signal value.

# **BALANCE**

Press the VOL+ or VOL- button to adjust to the left to right sound channel volume.

SOUND MODE Press the button to obtain special sound effects. The choices are "USER", "STANDARD", "MOVIE" and "MUSIC" with wrap arround .

## NICAM

The choice is "MONO","NICAMI"and "NICAMII".

Automatic Volume Leveling. The choices are "on" and "off".

# **CHANNEL**



Enter CHANNEL menu, you can select AUTO SCAN, CHANNEL, COLOUR SYS., SOUND SYS., SKIP, MANUAL, FINE, COUNTRY and PROGRAMitems by pressing PROG+/-Buttons.

# **AUTO SCAN**

The auto searchaction takes care of program tuning, storing and retrieving program information.

# CHANNEL

You can choose program from 1 to 124 you ecpect by pressing VOL+/- buttons.

# COLOUR SYS.

Press the button to select a new colour standard value

The choices are "AUTO", "PAL" and "SECAM".

# SOUND SYS.

Press the button to select a new sound standard value in TV. The choices are "B/G" ," I", "D/K" ," L" and "  $\acute{L}$  ".

# SKIP

Press the skipto enable or disable the selected program from being tuned to by pressing **VOL+/-**Buttons.

The choices are "on" and "off".

# **MANUAL**

The manual can get program you expect by PROG+/-, and can gainfrequency accordingly by VOL+/-.

### FINE

Press VOL+/- button to adjust the little change of frequency.

# COUNTRY

The choose are AUSTRIA, GERMANY, SWITZERLAND, BELGIUM, NETHERLANDS, UK, IRELAND, DENMARK, FINLAND, ITALY, NORWAY, SPAIN, SWEDEN, LUXEMBURG, FRANCE, CZECH, POLAND, HUNGARY.



# **PROGRAM**

It can choose some channel you except by PROG+/-or VOL+/-, and can name, delete and insert the one.

The red marker is call some channel . When chooseing some channel and pressing the red mark, it appears one small white frame and you can start to call the channel .


Note: moving the positon by VOL+/-; choosing the letter,number and sign by PROG+/-.


The green marker is delete some channel. The yellow marker is insert some channle.

# Enter submenu,

Pressing the red marker after call some channel and ok; Pressing the green marker after call some chanel and cancel.

# **FUNCTION**





Enter FUNCTION menu, you can select TIMER, PIC MISE, SCALING, BLUESCREEN, TXT LANGUAGE and FACTORY RESET items by pressing CH+/- Buttons.

# TIMER

The user-controlled timers are the CURRENT, TURN OFF, TURN ON, TURN ON PROGRAM, SWITCH TIME and SWITCH PROGRAM.

Press VOL+ to enter the submenu.

# **CURRENT**

Set the time for the Real-time Clock.

# **TURN OFF**

Set the offtimer value.

# **TURN ON**

TV set will turn on automaticallly if you set turn on time which behind the turn off time.


# TURN ON PROGRAM

Set the programyou expect which will appears automatically when TV set on again.

# SWITCH TIME

Set the switch timer value.

SWITCH PROGRAM
Set the program to switch to when the switch timer expires.



# PIC MISC

The function is picture adjustment which are LTI, CTI, BLACK EXTEND and DNR.

It is the improvement of brightness. The choices are on and off.

It is the improvement of colour. The choices are on and off.

# **BLACK EXTEND**

It is extendability of black level. The choices are on and off

It is reduce noise.

The choices are NORMAL, STRONG, WEAK

Choosing the scale of picture you expect. The choices are normal and full.

## **BLUE SCREEN**


The choices are on and off. It appears blue screen in TV set when choose on or appears snowflake dot.

# TXT LANGUAGE

The choices are WEST, EAST, RUSSIAN, ARABIC, FARSI and AUTO.

FACTORY RESET The function can cancel all current channels.

# OSD



Enter OSD menu, you can select LANGUAGE, H-POSITION, V-POSITION, DURATION and HALFTONE.

# LANGUAGE

The choices are ENGLISH, CHINESE.

# H-POSITION

Moving the main menu position in left or right by pressing VOL+/- buttons.

# V-POSITION

Moving the main menu position inup ro down by pressing VOL+/- buttons.

### DURATION

Changing the main menu's display time by pressing VOL+/- buttons.

# **HALFTONE**


Chaning the main menu's background color by pressing VOL+/- buttons.

In AV state, There are 5 geneal menu supported all function sare the same as in TV mode.

In YPBPB state there are 4 geneal menus (Picture)

Press the TV/AV Button to select the AV source .

In YPBPR state, there are 4 geneal menus (Picture, Audio, Function, OSD) supported all functions are the same as inTV mode.

In PC state, there are 4 geneal menus(Picture, Audio,Function,OSD) as TV.
When entering the PC mode, select the PICTURE menu, you can select CONTRAST, BRIGHTNESS,

H-POSITION, V-POSITION, CLOCK, PHASE, COLOUR and AUTO ADJUST items by pressing CH+/- buttons.

## H-POSITION

The H-Position menu allows control of horizontal position of the picture on the display.

## V-POSITION

The V-Position menu allows control of vertical position of the picture on the display.

### CLOCK

Changing the clockin pc by pressing VOL+/- buttons.

### PHASE

Changing the phase in pc by pressing VOL+/- buttons.  $\mbox{COLOR}$ 

Press VOL+ button to enter the submenu.

# **COLOR TEMP**

Press the button to adjust the best visual effect of picture.

The choices are USER, NORMAL, WARM, COOL and SRGB.

When choosing the user, the belowing all item will adjust by VOL+/-. They are USER-R, USER-G and USER-B.


# **AUTO ADJUST**

Start the auto-adjust procedure to automatically determine the values for horizontal position, vertical position, phase adjust and clock adjust.

Recommend: Don 'tchanged theses values after auto adjust at best.


CONTRAST, BRIGHTNESS functions are the same as functions in TV.

# Notice of PC connection

- 1. Power off both computer and display before making any connections.
- The monitor comes with a 15-pin PC socket. Connect the end of signal cable to the socket of the TV and connect the other end to the 15-pin connector to the computer.
- Tighten the screws of the Display cable until the connectors are fastened securely at both ends (finger-tighten only).
- If you are using Windows operating system running on a PC with a Microsoft Plug & Play compatible video card, your system will select the appropriate timing for your monitor.
