AIR (TV)/CABLE MODE SELECTION

The AIR/CABLE menu option is set at the factory to "AIR" to allow reception of over-the-air TV broadcast using the included antenna. If you wish to tune cable television channels, this option must be set to "CABLE". Please refer to page 16 of this owner's manual for the details of this menu.

TV RECEPTION

1. Reception of over-the-air TV broadcast varies with location. Lack of reception of certain stations or interruptions in playback does not indicate a problem with your product but rather a weak received signal. Try repositioning the antenna, moving the unit to another location with better signal or connecting to your cable, satellite or home antenna. If you have recently relocated the TV, please re-scan channels.
2. TV broadcast is not intended to be received in a moving vehicle. For best reception, be sure to use this TV only in a stationary setting.



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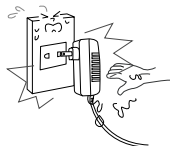
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Power Supply

Warnings

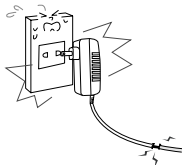
Do not touch the power plug with wet hands.

- Doing so may result in electric shock.



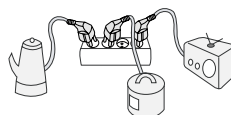
Do not use a damaged power cord or plug or a loose outlet.

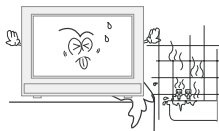


Installation

Warnings

Do not place the unit where it is exposed to rain, excessive moisture or grease.

- Doing so may result in fire or explosion.



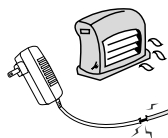

- Doing so poses a serious risk of fire.



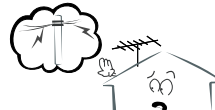
Do not run power cords near heat-producing appliances such as radiators, stoves, or irons.

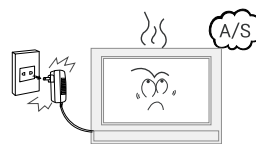
When moving the unit, be sure to turn off unit and unplug the power cord from the wall outlet.

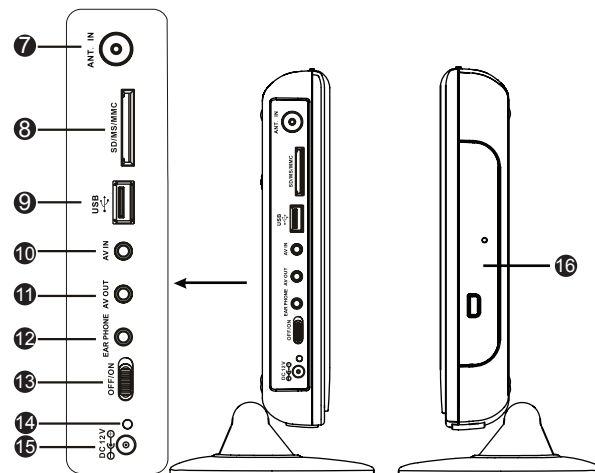

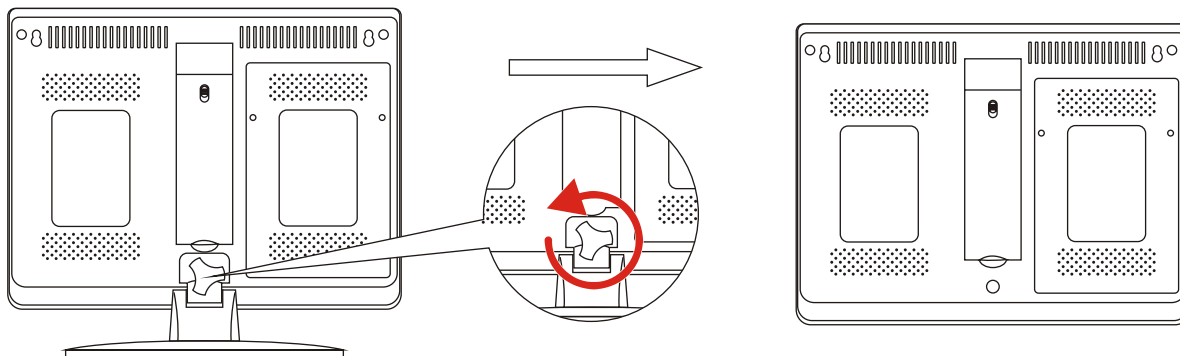

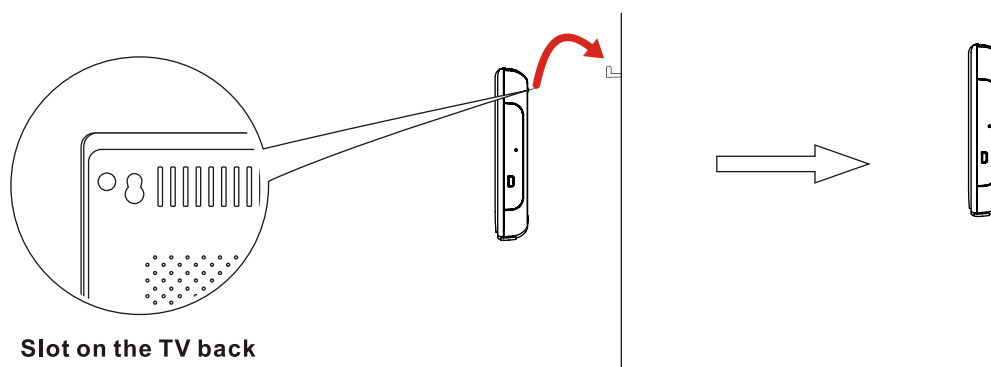
Disassembly of TV Base

- Contrarotate the base bolt to release the base of the TV.

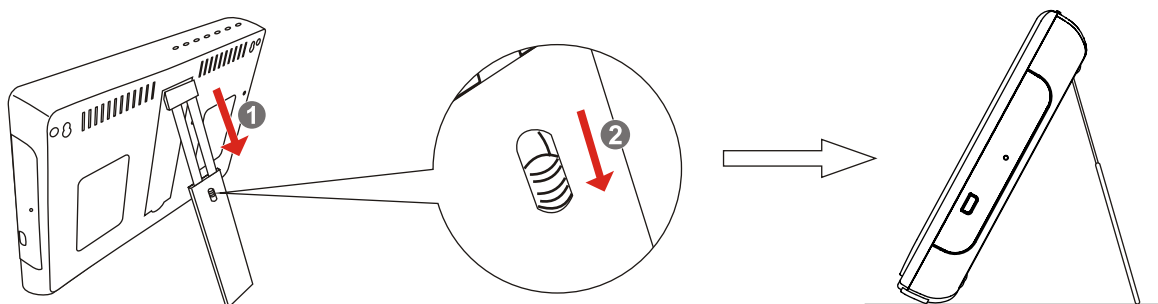


Wall-Hanging

Standing the TV with Bracket



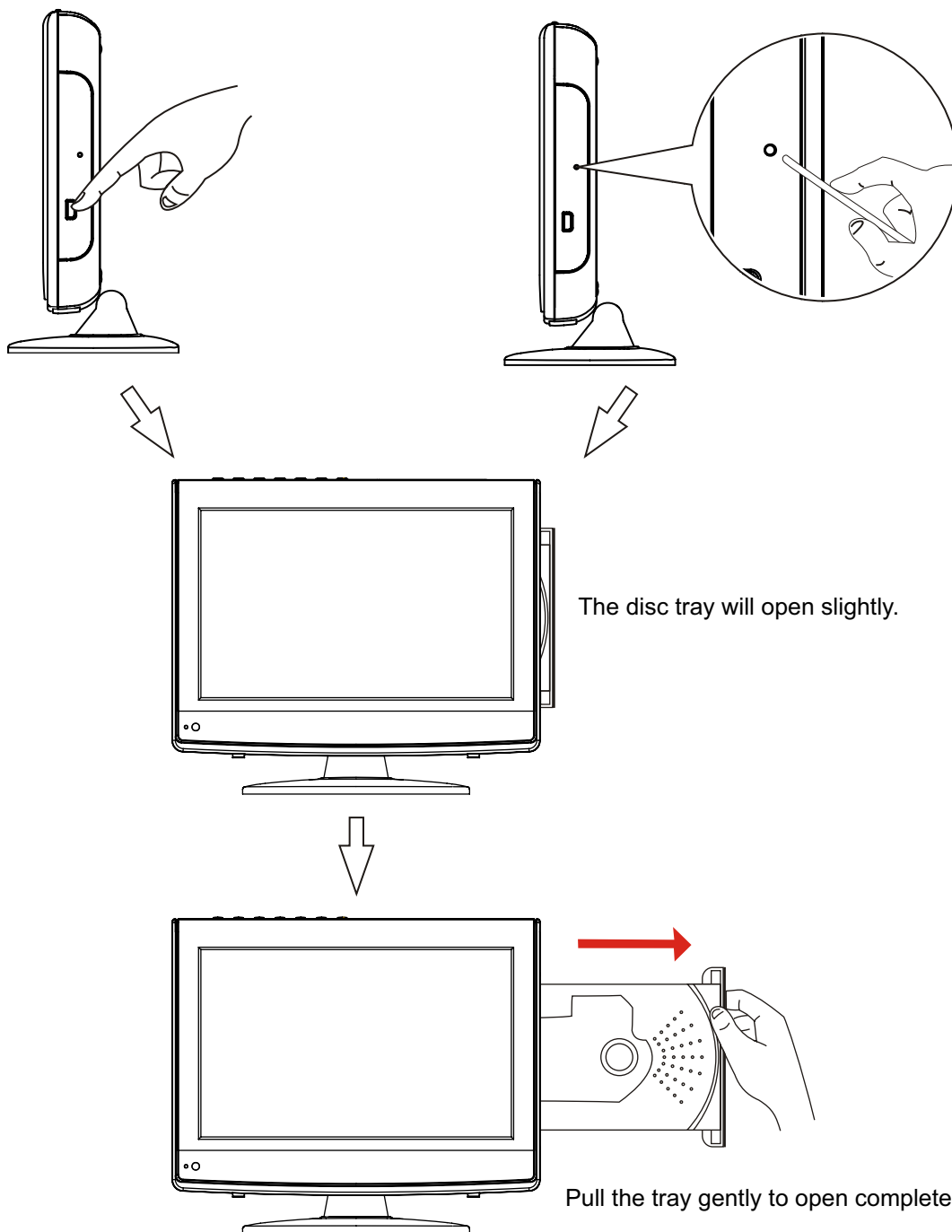
1 Pull the bracket out.

Inserting Discs

There are two ways to open the disc tray:

- If the TV is connected with the power and the power switch is ON, you can push the button on the right edge of TV.
- You can insert something slender into the slot to open the disk tray even there is no power supply to the TV.



Remote Control

● Function of remote control buttons

The remote control uses infra-Red(IR). Point it towards the front of the LCD TV. The remote control may not work correctly if it is operated out of range or out of angle.



STANDBY : Press to turn the TV on/standby.

TV/AV : Press to display the input source menu.

MUTE : Press to mute the TV, press again or press **VOL+/-** button to unmute.

DISPLAY : Press to display the current program information.

NUMBER buttons and -/-- button:

Choose channel directly.

Press -/-- buttons to select "-", and press a number button to select the channel;

Press -/-- buttons to select "- -", and press two number buttons to select the channel;

Press -/-- buttons to select "- - -", and press three number buttons to select the channel;

: Return to the previous channel viewed.

LANG : Press to display the language select menu.

CC : Closed caption(see page 17).

EPG : To show the Electronic Program Guide during no-menu state only(see page 17).

VOL+/- : Volume up/down.

SLEEP : Timer.

LCD-MENU : Press to display OSD menu.

THUMBSTICK (▲/▼/◀/▶) : Allows you to navigate the on-screen menus and adjust the system settings to your preference.

ENTER : Confirm for source menu.

CH+/- : Channel/program up/down.

Buttons for DVD/Media operation

A-B : Select and play the preferable paragraph of program by pressing this key twice at the beginning and end of it.

SUB : Press to turn on/off the subtitle display.

ANG : Select DVD picture angle.

ZOOM : Press to change the screen display mode.

▶|| : Play/pause. ■ : Stop

SLOW : Slow the playing speed.

DVD SETUP : Press to display the SETUP menu.

◀▶ : Fast reverse/forward.

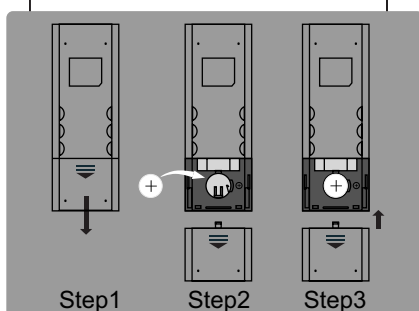

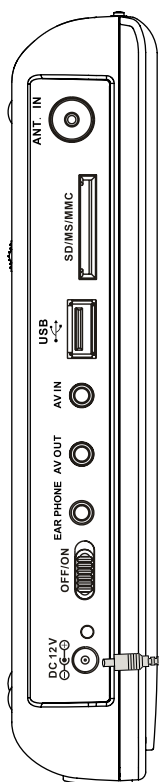
Insert a batteries.

Ensure that the polarities(+ and -) of the batteries are aligned correctly.

How to use the remote control

- Check the polarity(+,-) of the batteries in the remote control.
- Check that the batteries have power.
- Check that the LCD TV is powered and that it is properly plugged in.
- Check if any three-wavelength lamp, special fluorescent or neon sign is turned on near the LCD TV.
- The remote control should be operated within 30 feet (7m) and 30° to the left and the right of the IR receiver at the front of the LCD TV.
- Used batteries should be disposed properly.

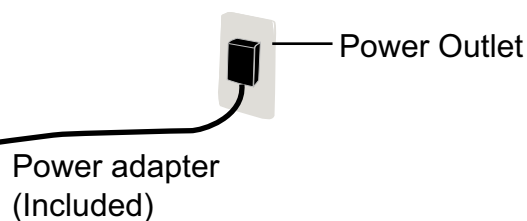

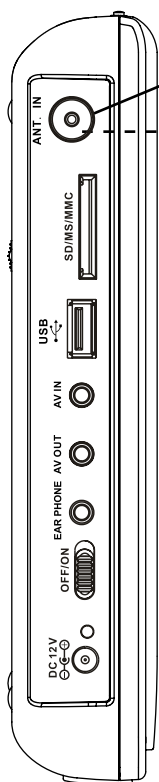
1. Connect the small round plug on the power adapter cable to the power input socket at the rear of the set.
2. Connect the power adapter to the main supply.

Note:

This model has a built-in rechargeable Li-ion battery. You can enjoy watching TV for approximately 2 hours using battery power after a full charge. You can charge the battery by connecting the supplied AC adapter. It will take about 3 hours to charge fully.

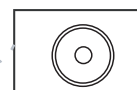

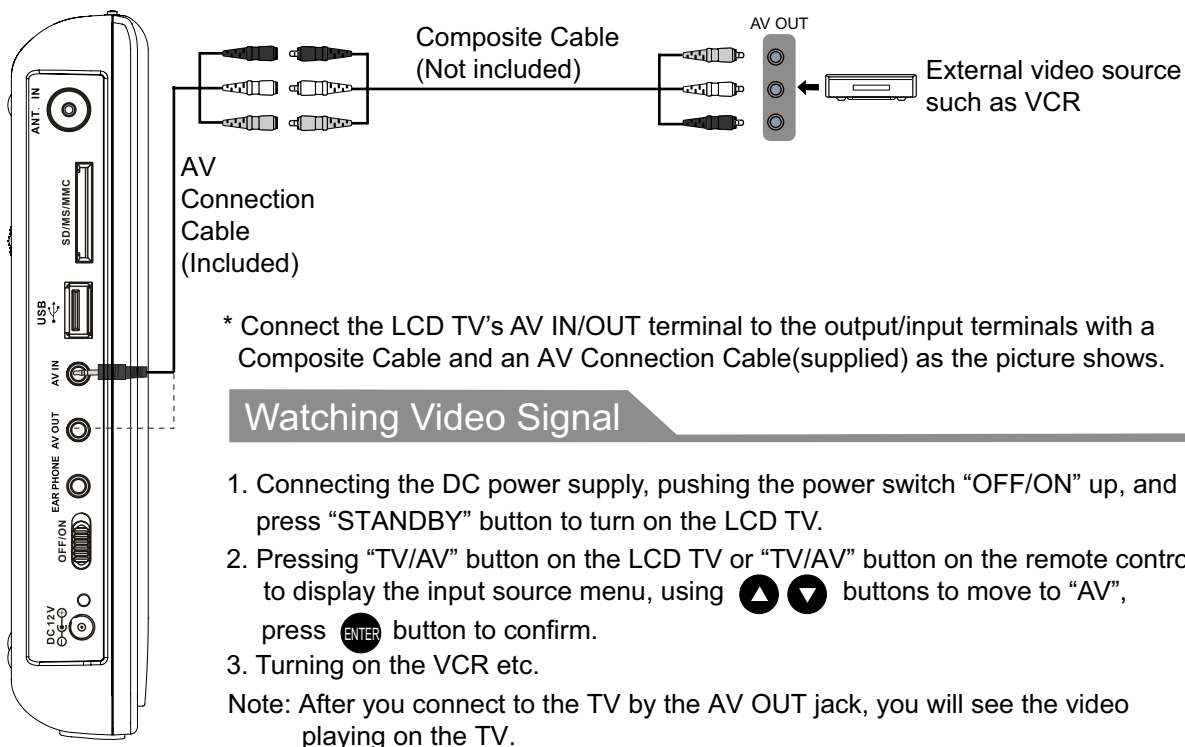

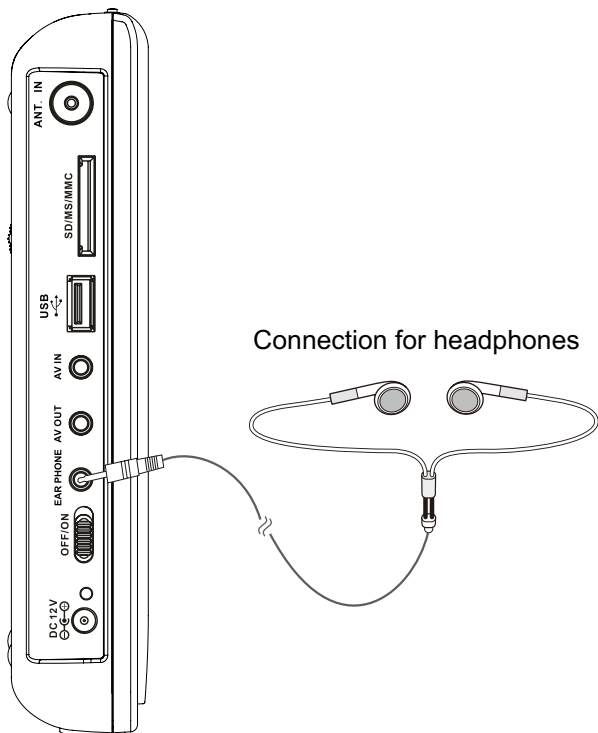


Watching Video Signal


1. Connecting the DC power supply, pushing the power switch "OFF/ON" up, and press "STANDBY" button to turn on the LCD TV.
2. Pressing "TV/AV" button on the LCD TV or "TV/AV" button on the remote control to display the input source menu, using buttons to move to "AV", press button to confirm.
3. Turning on the VCR etc.

Note: After you connect to the TV by the AV OUT jack, you will see the video playing on the TV.

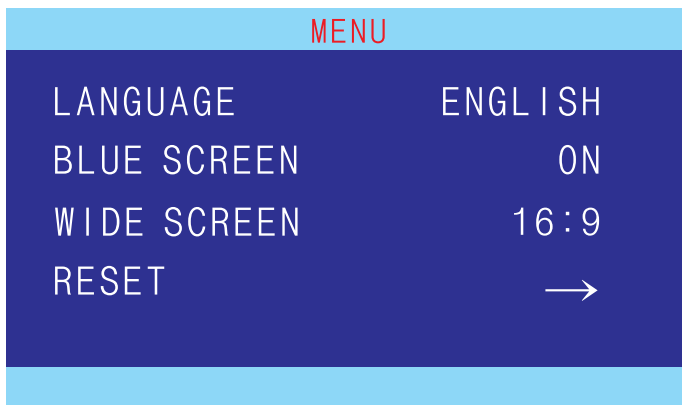

Saturation	Controls the saturation of the picture.
Sharpness	Increase this setting to see crisp edges in the picture; decrease it for soft edges.
Hue	Controls the hue(only used in NTSC mode).

AFC (in TV mode)	Automatic frequency control, the LCD TV will autosearch the best signal on the appointed frequency if you turn on the function.
Fine Tune (in TV mode)	Fine tune the frequency of the channel. Note: the AFC will be turned off automatically when you start to fine tune.
Time Zone	Select the Time Zone for your TV set according to you area.
Daylight Save	Turn on/off the Daylight Save function.

Getting Started

1. Select DVD source

- Turn on the LCD TV and press **TV/AV** button to display the input source menu, select **DVD** by **▲/▼** button, and press **OK** button to enter the DVD source.

2. Insert Disc

- Insert the disc according to the instructions on page 8. The screen will display "READ" and the disc contents will be read.

NOTE: When inserting the disc, make sure that the printed side of the disc is facing forward. Inserting discs incorrectly may damage the player.

Region Code 1

As it is usual for DVD movies to be released at different times in different regions of the world, all players have region codes and discs can have an optional region code. If you load a disc of a different region code into your player you will see the region code notice on the screen. The disc will not playback and should be unloaded. The region code for this player is 1(refer to the symbols below).



3. Play the DVD

- After the disc has been read, the title menu will be displayed. Select "PLAY" to commence playback. The **▶||** button may be used to toggle between PLAY and PAUSE modes.

DVD Functions operating instructions

1. Menu playback (for DVD/ super VCD and VCD 2.0 discs)

- Press MENU button
- For DVD discs, the screen will display the DVD Disc Menu (Root Menu)
- For Super VCD & VCD2.0 discs, the screen will display the Super VCD, VCD2.0 Disc Menu (PBC: [OFF])(Press the MENU button to display the PBC status).
- Playback the Super VCD & VCD2.0 discs, the default PBC status is ON.
- For DVD discs, use the navigation buttons to select and Play the highlighted contents; For Super VCD & VCD2.0 discs, use the numeric buttons to play your favorite content directly.
- NOTE:** PBC should be OFF.
- Press **ENTER** or **▶II** button to start from the highlighted content.
- Return to the Root Menu when playing the disc
- For DVD discs, press MENU to display the Disc Menu.
- For Super VCD & VCD2.0 discs, when PBC is ON, press MENU to display the Disc Menu.
- STOP
- Press **■** button once to stop. Press **▶II** button to resume from where you stopped.
- Press **■** button twice to stop. Press **▶II** button to start from beginning.
- In order to protect the disc, press **■** button then press EJECT button to take the disc out. When the disc is ejected, hold the disc edge slightly and take it from the eject direction to prevent scratches.
- When not using the DVD function (in stand-by mode or using other modes for a long time), please take out the disc to protect the DVD loader and the disc.

2. Title playback (for DVD disc only)

- Press **TITLE** button. The screen will show "TITLE".
- Press the direction or numeric buttons to select your favorite title.
- Playback will commence from the first chapter of the selected title.

3. Sequential playback (for DVD/ Super VCD/ VCD/ CD/ CD-G/HD-CD and Mp3/ JPEG discs)

- For Super VCD & VCD discs, if PBC is "ON" status, press **▶II** button will enter the disc menu. Press **MENU** button to turn PBC OFF. Press **▶II** button to start in sequent. For others, while it stopped, press **▶II** button to start in sequent.

4. Program playback (for DVD/ Super VCD/ VCD/ CD/ CD-G/HD-CD and Mp3/ JPEG discs)

- Using Program playback, you can select max. 16 tracks from the disc to playback in programmed order.

- If it is in PBC ON status, using program playback will turn to PBC OFF automatically.
- According to the highlight area input the title and chapter number by numeric buttons, press **▶II** button to start; or move to the <PLAY> by navigation buttons, press **ENTER** button to start.
- While playing the program, you may press **PROGRAM** button to display the program menu for edit. To clear the program by moving to <CLEAR> and press **ENTER** button. Or press **■** button to end the program. When press **▶II** button again, the disc will play by sequent.
- While playing the program, there will have an on screen indication "PRG PLAY" and the current title and chapter number.

DVD Functions operating instructions

5. Play (for DVD/ Super VCD/ VCD/ CD/ CD-G/HD-CD and Mp3/ JPEG discs)

- For DVD disc, press **▶** button from root or title menu; while playing the DVD, you may play your favorite title directly with title selection by pressing the **TITLE** button.
- For Super VCD & VCD discs, while playing the disc, you may play your favorite tracks by numeric buttons.
(NOTE: When using the Program playback or when it is PCB ON status, you can only use ◀◀ or ▶▶ buttons to change the track)
- For CD, CD-G & HD-CD discs, while playing the disc, you may play your favorite tracks by numeric buttons.
- For MP3 / JPEG disc, you may play your favorite tracks by numeric buttons from the content menu.
- If input track number is not valid, it will not function.

NOTE: From track 1-10, use numeric buttons directly; For tracks over 10, press - / -- button first. (E.g. Track 15, press - / -- then 5)

6. Previous/Next (for DVD/ Super VCD/ VCD/ CD/ CD-G/HD-CD and Mp3/ JPEG discs)

- While playing the disc;
 - Press **◀◀** button to play to the last Title / Chapter / track.
 - Press **▶▶** button to play to the next Title / Chapter / track
- For super VCD & VCD discs, in PBC OFF status;

 - If the current track is the last one, press **▶▶** button will stop the playback.
- For DVD discs, the above functions may vary due to different DVD disc's structure.

- While playing the disc, you may use forward or backward function.
- There are 4 speeds for forward. Press **▶▶** button to toggle between different speeds in sequent. (FORWARDx2 / FORWARDx4 / FORWARDx8 / FORWARDx20 / Play).
- While in backward, you may press **▶** to resume normal speed.
- For CD, HD-CD, MP3, backward also has audio output.
- For DVD discs, if backward to first title / chapter, it will start from the beginning.

NOTE: During Forward or Backward, the sound will be off.

8. Slow motion(for DVD/ Super VCD/ VCDdiscs)

- FOR CD, CD-G, HD-CD & MP3/JPEG discs, press **▶** button to pause; press **▶** button to resume.
- FOR DVD, Super VCD, VCD discs, press **▶** button to pause; press **STEP** button to playback frame by frame; press **▶** button to resume.

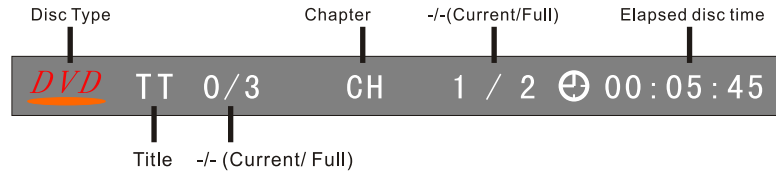
10. Repeat (for DVD/ Super VCD/ VCD/ CD/ CD-G/HD-CD and Mp3/ JPEG discs)

- Press **REPEAT** button once to display the current repeat mode.
- For Super VCD, VCD, CD, CD-G, HD-CD, discs, while playing in sequent, you may use the repeat playback. There are 2 repeat modes, press REPEAT to toggle between different modes in sequent. (REPEAT (OFF)/ REPEAT (1)/REPEAT (ALL)).
- For DVD discs, you may setup the repeat playback mode. There are 2 repeat modes, press REPEAT to toggle between different modes in sequent. (REP: (OFF) / REP: (CHAPTER) / REP: (TITLE) / REP: (ALL)).
- For MP3 / JPEG discs, while playing the disc, you may use the repeat playback. There are 3 repeat modes, press **REPEAT** to toggle between different modes in sequent. (REPEAT (OFF) / REPEAT (1) / REPEAT (DIR) / REPEAT (ALL)).

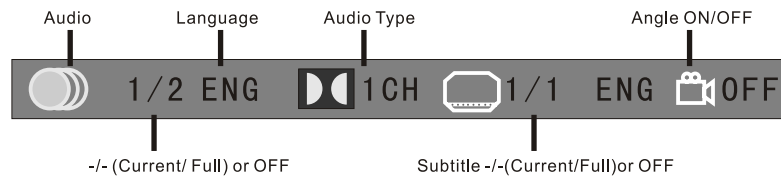

11. Display (for DVD/ Super VCD/ VCD/ CD/ CD-G/HD-CD and Mp3/ JPEG discs)

- Press **DISPLAY** button to activate the on screen roll-down menu for the current Title, Chapter, time and other information
- For DVD discs, (2 pages) Press **DISPLAY** button once to display first page as shown below:



Press **DISPLAY** button again to display second pages shown below:



- For Super VCD discs, (2 pages), Press **DISPLAY** button once to display first page: Disc type, Track --(Current / Full), Mute status, PBC status, Repeat mode status, Current track time. Press **DISPLAY** button again to display second page: Audio/--(Current/Full) or OFF, Audio type, Language, Subtitle/--(Current/Full) or OFF. Press **DISPLAY** button again to turn off the on screen display.
- For CD, CD-G, HD-CD, MP3 / JPEG discs, Press **DISPLAY** button once to display first page: Disc type, Track --(Current / Full), Mute status, Repeat mode status, Current track time.
- Press **DISPLAY** button again to turn off the on screen display.

12. Goto (for DVD/ Super VCD/ VCD/ CD/ CD-G/HD-CD and Mp3/ JPEG discs)

- This function allows you to play your favorite Title / Chapter / track. Press **GOTO** button to activate the on screen scroll-down menu for edit.  - Press **▶** button to playback the current selection.
 - Press 1 - 9 button to activate corresponding small screen directly.
 - For CD, CD-G, DTC-CD, HD-CD discs, while the disc had stopped, press **PREVIEW** button. It will start to play each track by 15 sec. according to the tracks order.
 - Press numeric buttons directly to select the tracks for preview
 - Press **▶** button to playback the current track
 - While playing the discs, you may also press **PREVIEW** button to activate this function.
- NOTE: - If started the disc menu, preview will not function.
- if the current track started over 15 sec. this function will start from next track.

Maintenance for disc

Cleaning the screen

1. Here's a great way to keep the dust off your screen for a while. Wet a soft cloth in a mixture of lukewarm water and a little fabric softener or dish washing detergent. Wring the cloth until it's almost dry, and then used it to wipe the screen.
2. Make sure the excess water is off the screen, and then let it air-dry before you turn on your TV.

Cleaning the cabinet

To remove dirt or dust, wipe the cabinet with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Please be sure not to use a wet cloth.

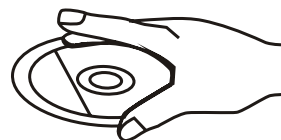
Extended Absence



If you expect to leave your TV dormant for a long time (such as a vacation), it's a good idea to unplug the power cord to protect against possible damage from lightning or power surges.

Handling Discs

1. To remove a disc from its storage case, press on the centre of the case and take the disc out.
2. Hold the disc by the edges, to avoid touching the Recorded side of the disc.



Cleaning discs

1. Fingerprints and dust should be carefully wiped from the disc's surface with a soft Cloth. Audio discs and DVD discs have no grooves to collect dust and microscopic debris so gently wiping with a soft cloth should remove most particles. Wipe in a straight line from the inside to the outside of the disc. Small dust particles and light stains should have no effect on reproduction quality.
2. Never use chemicals such as record sprays, antistatic sprays, Benzine, or thinners to clean the discs. These chemicals can irreparably damage the disc's surface.
3. Discs should be returned to their cases after use. This avoids serious scratches that could cause the laser pickup to skip.
4. Do not expose discs to direct sunlight, high humidity, or high temperature for extended periods. Exposure to high temperatures can warp the disc.
5. Do not stick paper or write anything with a ball point pen on the label side of the disc.



Trouble shooting

- In case a problem occurs with your LCD TV, please take the following steps first.
- If the problem still occurs, turn the power off and contact your dealer or an authorized service center.

The screen does not appear.	Is the power plug pulled out? Insert the power plug. Press the power button.
