





TO INSTALL NEW BATTERIES



- With Phillips screwdriver, loosen screw in battery compartment door. Remove door (screw remains attached to door).
- 2. Discard old batteries. Insert 3 fresh 'AA" alkaline batteries into compartment as shown. Replace door and tighten screw.

CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions;
- 2. Do not mix old and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries;
