# 1. Charge the Power Pack

- 1. Plug charger into a 120V household outlet.
- 2. Charge the power pack for 4hrs. Note: Pack is not charged when new.
- 3. After charging for 4hrs, unplug charger and disconnect pack.
- 4. IMPORTANT: The first 3 times you charge the battery, charge for at least 5.5 hours in order to condition the battery, and run battery until it is fully exhausted.



Approximate running time is 12-18 min. Power nack may quit suddenly. Let pack cool, then recharge after removing pack from vehicle.

#### CAUTION

Do not remove warm or hot power packs. Wait 20 min. until pack has cooled. Recharging too early will shorten pack life.


- · Recharging near fire or high temperature is dangerous.
- Do not recharge packs that show wear or leakage.
- · Always unplug power pack when not in use.
- . Do not dispose of pack in fire, explosion or personal injury may occur. Dispose of power packs properly, do not disassemble.
- · Always remove power pack from vehicle before charging
- . Do not use charger for any use other than instructed in directions.

# 2. Install Battery In Hand Controller

- 1. Remove cover of battery compartment on the hand remote.
- 2. Insert one "9V"/6LR61 Heavy Duty Battery.
- 3. Be sure the + and are properly matched.

Note: FOR BEST PERFORMANCE ALWAYS USE ALKALINE BATTERIES.





# 3. Install Charged Power Pack in Vehicle


#### TO INSERT BATTERY

1. Unlock battery door by tuning latch to the right.



PREVENT ELECTRIC SHOCK, INPUT: AC120V, 60HZ 4.5W OUTPUT: DC6V 240MA.

2. Slide fully charged Ni-Cd Battery pack forward.



3. Relock the battery door.

#### TO REMOVE BATTERY


- 1. Unlatch battery door.
- 2. Slide battery backward.

To ensure proper function


- . Do not mix old and new batteries.
- · Do not mix alkaline, standard, or rechargeable batteries.
- · Batteries installation should be done by an adult.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- · Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being recharged (if removable).
- · Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision (if removable).
- Only patteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used
- ·Batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy
- . The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

#### 4. Driving


1. Turn On/Off switch on vehicle to the On position.




2. Operation


































3. When you're done driving your Havoc RC turn the On/Off switch . I. (3) Filter 1 - 3 - 5

# **Operating And Caring For Havoc**

- DO NOT drive Havoc on streets. Streets are for real cars only.
- · Always operate your vehicle within a range of 50 feet from you.
- Always store your vehicle in a cool, dry place and off of painted or varnished surfaces.
- Keep vehicle away from wet surfaces or rain. If your ven de ACCIDENTALLY gets wet and stops running, let it dry overnight before trying to run it again.
- · Keep vehicle away from sandy, dusty areas.
- Electronic instruments are sensitive to direct suntignt or heat. Avoid long periods of play under girect suntight.

# **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE HINTS**

- · Brush areas where dirt and dust get trapped.
- · Wipe body off with a soft rag or tact cloth.
- · Do not clean vehicle with chemicals or water.

## **GUIDE FOR TROUBLE SHOOTING**

Check the points below if you are experiencing difficulty. Sometimes an apparent malfunction is the result of a simple cause and effect as shown below.

SYMPTOM	PROBABLE CAUSE	CORRECTION
Vehicle runs slowly or will not run.	Main vehicle switch not ON.	Check vehicle switch, must be ON.
	Weak vehicle or controller batteries.	Replace with fresh alkaline battery for controller. For vehicle, replace with fully charged Ni-Cd battery.
	Using wrong transmitter.	Use correct transmitter.
Erratic operation or only short range possible.	Radio Interference likely.	Change location (SEE OPERATING AND CARING FOR HAVOC)
Short vehicle battery life.	Continues use on rough terrain or steep hills.	Use on less severe terrain.

# CAUTION

- Radio interference can be caused by the presence of other radiocontrolled vehicles operation on the same frequency as your vehicle.
- Radio interference can be caused by the operation of your vehicle near high voltage electrical wires, large steer reinforced concrete buildings and passing trucks with CB radios.

- 5. For best results, hold antenna up, not pointed down toward the R/C ehicle. Too far away from the transmitter, your signal strength will become weak and the vehicle will not function property. If e maximum range for the vehicle should be between 30 and 50 feet depending on conditions.
