
Requires 3 "AA" batteries, alkaline recommended (not included). Phillips screwdriver (not included) needed for assembly and battery placement.

This product uses #10 (3/4") Phillips head sheet metal screws.


Replacement screws, if needed, are available at most hardware stores.



BATTERY PLACEMENT






Battery compartment is located under upper wheel half. Loosen screw in battery compartment cover (screw stays attached to cover). Remove cover. Insert 3 fresh "AA" alkaline batteries. Replace cover and tighten screw.

CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions;
- Do not mix old and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries;
- 3. Always remove weak or dead batteries from the product.

ASSEMBLY

Remove 2 screws taped to bottom of base.



- Insert wide end of post into top of base.
- Flip base upside down, and push down on base until post touches bottom of the base. Tighten screw into hole in base bottom to secure post to base.
- Press lower wheel half firmly onto top of post. Be sure that post is through bottom of wheel half as far as it can go. Tighten screw into hole in lower wheel half to secure it to post.
- 4. Fit upper wheel half onto lower half, aligning screws on top with holes in bottom. Tighten the 4 screws to secure wheel halves.


Note: Check to be sure that all assembled parts are securely attached before using the toy.
