

TO ASSEMBLE

NOTE: THE FOLLOWING STEPS ARE A ONE-TIME ASSEMBLY. ONCE THE BOW IS ASSEMBLED, YOU CANNOT TAKE THE BOW APART.


 Lay the pieces of the bow out as shown. Assemble the pieces as indicated by the arrows.






Attach the string to each bow section by threading it through the holes in the wheels as shown. Pull the string through the hole in the bow. Next, tie a double knot in the end.


NOTE: String is for decoration only and does not affect the function of the bow.



Load an arrow onto the launcher. Arrows can be stored in holders as shown.



4. Apply the labels to the bow using the numbers on the label sheet and this illustration as a guide. Opposite side is reversed.



6. To ready, pull back on the handle until it locks into position. Aim at your target through the rear sight. Pull the trigger to launch an arrow. Push the handle in and repeat the process to launch again. The bow can also be used traditionally by pulling back on the handle and releasing it before it locks.
