
- Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Unclip and remove the panel above the radio including the a/c vents and the climate controls. Unplug and remove the panel. (Figure A)
- 3 Unclip and remove the panel below the radio. (Figure B)
- 4 Remove (6) Phillips screws securing the radio. Unplug and remove the radio. (Figure C)
- 5 Remove (5) Torx head screws securing each side bracket to factory radio and remove brackets and module. (Retain brackets, module and (2) screws from module for re-use during kit assembly.) (Figure D)




DOUBLE DIN RADIO PROVISION OR STACKED ISO MOUNT UNIT(5) PROVISION

1 Attach the factory brackets and module to the Double DIN or stacked ISO mount unit(s) with the screws supplied with the unit(s) and (2) screws from



95-7427 FINAL ASSEMBLY

FINAL ASSEMBLY



- (A) Strip wire ends back 1/2"
- B) Twist ends together
- C) Solder
- D) Tape
- 1 Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter and making the connections as shown. (Isolate and individually tape off the ends of any unused wires to prevent electrical short circuit).
- 2 Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- 3 Position the factory bracket/aftermarket radio assembly into the dash and secure using the factory hardware.
- 4 Secure the Double DIN radio housing to the sub dash using the factory hardware.
- 5 Reassemble the rest of the dash in reverse order of disassembly.

Make wiring connections using the EIA color code chart shown below and the instructions included with the head unit. Metra recommends making connections shown below; Strip, Splice, Solder, Tape. Isolate and individually tape off ends of any unused wires to prevent electrical short

METRA / EIA WIRING CODE

12V Ignition / Acc Red	Right Front (+) Gray
12V Batt / Memory Yellow	Right Front (-) Gray/ Black
GroundBlack*	Left Front (+) White
Power AntennaBlue	Left Front (-) White / Black
Amp Turn-On Blue / White	Right Rear (+)Violet
Amp GroundBlack / White	Right Rear (-) Violet / Black
Illumination Orange	Left Rear (+) Green
Dimmer Orange / White	Left Rear (-) Green / Black

*NOTE: When a Black wire is not present, ground radio to vehicle chassis. All colors may not be present on all leads due to manufacturer's specifications.
