Warning

Do not open the TV unit and attempt any service. Any TV unit that has its seal tampered will void the factory warranty. Opening any service panel may also cause electric shock. Please contact us for service.

Installation

- There is a ventilation grill placed on back on of the unit in order to avoid overheating the TV. Please make sure to keep any objects at lease 10 inches away from the grill.
- Do not expose the TV to direct sun light or other heat-source.
- Do not expose the TV to liquids.
- Do not put magnetized objects near TV unit.


Safety Precautions

- Do not put any objects into the ventilation grill; otherwise, it may cause fire, electric shock or other malfunctions.
- Do not place any liquids (including water) on or near TV.
- Damaged or exposed power cable may cause fire, electric shock or other malfunctions. Please disconnect the power plug by pulling it out gently from the outlet.
- Do not place any heavy objects on the power cable.
- Do not twist power cable in order to avoid short-circuit.
- Please power off the TV and pull out the power plug when not in use.
- Please pull out the power plug, antenna cord and do not touch the antenna during thunder storms.
- Please shut off this TV unit and pull out the power plug when not in use.


ABOUT THE PORTABLE TU



Charge indicator /power indicator: the indicator will not light when the power is off. The indicator is red when charging, and it will turn green when charging full. If the power is on, the green indicator indicates that the battery has energy.

Remote Control Appearance

Inserting Batteries Into The Remote Control:
The supplied remote can be used to control the player.
Insert one "CR2025" type batteries into the compartment,
matching + and - as indicated on the inside of the battery
housing. The remote must be pointed directly at the player.



Notes:


- 1. Avoid exposing the remote control to extremes of temperature e.g. direct sunlight.
- 2. Ensure that no foreign objects enter the battery housing, especially metal objects.
- 3.If the player's infra red sensor sensor is bathed in strong direct sunlight, or intense artificial light, then it may not be able to detect signals sent from the handset.
- 4.If the remote is not to be used for an extended period then please remove the batteries to avoid leakage and corrosion.



System Connection





There are two options for operating the FM function:

Inserting the FM ANT or the Earphone into the FM ANT input to receive the FM signal. Insert the Earphone to the earphone input to receive the FM signal. At this operation, the earphone works both as the FM ANT to receive the FM signal and also as an earphone to listen.

Note: For best FM signal reception, please move the FM ANT around to search for the best signal. Then, fix the position and keep the FM ANT steady. If you move the FM ANT constantly around you may not get the desired signal you wish.

BATTERY FEATURES

Charging process:

Please first connect the power adapter to the AC power. Insert the DC plug of the power adapter to the DC IN port of the TV. Please make sure that you must switch off the player first so that you can start to charge the TV.

Charging indication:


When the indicator of "CHARGE" is RED, it means that the battery is charging now! When the indicator of "CHARGE" is GREEN, it means that the battery has been charged fully. Then you can make your TV work now.

Charging time:

Please charge it for 3.5 hours to 4 hours.

After a period time of working, the battery of the TV will be exhaust, then a battery sign will be appeared on the TFT panel. It indicates that you must charge the battery of your TV. If you have not charge it, the player will be standby automatically. So you should charge the battery immediately, when you see the battery sign.

BASIC OPERATION



Caution:

Most of the functions can operate on machine, but a few function only can use by remote control.


Press the sourse button to select TV

TV Programs Auto Scan



With access to the AIR or CATV. Press MENU to enter the main menu interface, and then press ▶ to enter search interface. Select Auto Scan, press ENTER. It will automatically scan and store TV programs. All Digital TV (DTV) and Analogue TV (ATV) programs will be stored.

Choice Of TV Programs



Press • on top of the TV or on the remote control to change the channels. You can also input the channel number directly.

Sleep Mode



Sleep timer: you can set the sleep time of this portable TV for 5 minutes-240minutes to enter the sleep mode, and press any button on the remote or panel to wake up.

Image Quality Adjustment



Press MENU to select picture submenu.

Press ♦ to choose sub-menu. Use ◄► button to adjust.

Image quality adjustment options:

Picture Mode/Brightness/Contrast/Color/ Sharpeness/Tint/Color Mode

Sound Adjustment

Press VOL+ to increase volume; Press VOL- to reduce volume. Press Mute to turn off the sound

Sound Effect Adjustment



Press MENU to select sound submenu.

Press ♦ to choose sub-menu. Use ◄► button to adjust. Sound Effect options:

- 1) Sound Mode: Standard, Music, Movie, Sports
- 2) Treble/Bass: Treble, Bass, Balance
- 3) Prefer Language: English, French, Spanish

AV In Mode

Select source AV

Use the AV cable to input the signal source to this TV. Then you can enjoy high-quality images and sound on this TV.

AV Out Mode

Under the TV status or AV-IN mode, the AV signal can be output to another device. Connect AV Cable from the TV to the output device, and then power on the TV. Power on your input device. The signal will be shown on your device.

FM Mode

Please insert the antenna line into the FM ANT. Select source FM to enter the FM mode, on this mode, you can search the radio channel. Before searching, please insure to connect a antenna, then press the INFO button to search automatically.

After searching all the FM radio channel, you can press the CH+/- to select the channel you want to listen, and press the ◀▶ to adjust the frequency one by one.


External Storage Mode



Support SD/MMC/MS and USB2.0

* If USB or Card device is connected, the USB or Card Logo will turn to be active. Select USB or Card and Press Enter.

You will find the following 3 folders:pictures, music and videos. You can use the ◆▶ to move the focus and then press Enter.



Picture Viewer



Supported formats: EXIF, JPEG, JPG, DCT.

When you enter into the Photos, there will be list of ALL supported pictures on your USB or Card Reader Devices. You will find a picture preview at the right.

After entering the full-screen picture viewer, Press Enter to enter Slideshow options. Use **◄▶**/ **♦** to select and adjust your selections.

MP3 Player



Supported formats: All MP3 files.


A list of all Mp3 files will be shown at the left side, when you enter into the MUSIC Folder. Use ♦ to select the files, press ENTER to play your selected file.




The bottom line of screen function keys are: rewind, on one, pause, stop, next song, fast forward, volume.

Use ♦ to move Left and Right; Press Enter to make your Choice; Press ◄► to adjust your selections.

Video Player



Enter into the Video list; There will be preview on the right, if the file format is supported. Then press Enter to view in Full Screen. Please Exit to quit to video file list. Please Exit again to quit to the Photo/Music/Video menu.



In full-screen playback, press ENTER to enter the video play menu. Press ◆▶ to move left and right. Press Enter again to select submenu.

Common Troubleshooting
