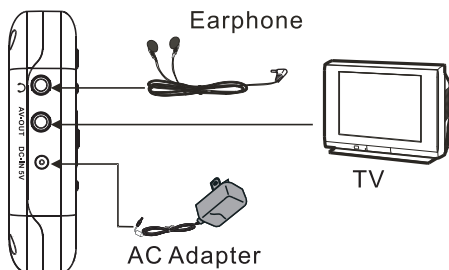

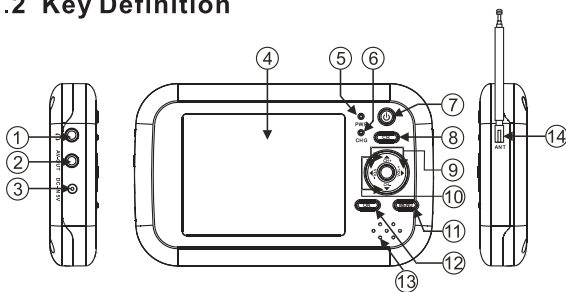

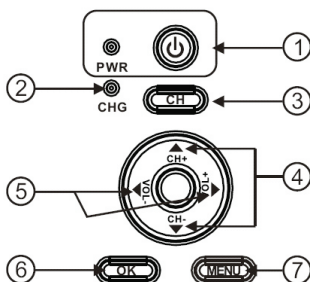

BASIC INSTRUCTION



(1). Power

- Press several seconds to turn power on or off.

(2). LED Indicator

- Power Indicator : When the power is on, the indicator is lighted.
- Charge Indicator

Green : While the power adapter charges built-in Li-polymer battery, the indicator is lighted green.

OFF : When the battery is finished charging, the indicator will be off.

Battery Low : While the factory capacity is low, LCD will display "Battery Low". The system will turn off automatically after a while. Please charge the battery.

(3). Channel List

Press [CH] to enable channel list. Use navigation keys to select desired TV channel.

(4) CH+ / CH- / ▲ / ▼

USE CH+ / CH- to change the current TV channel.

(5). VOL+ / VOL- / ◀ / ▶

- USE VOL+ / VOL- to change the audio volume.
- In menu mode, press [◀] to go back to last menu, press [▶] to select a new function or confirm it.

(6). OK

Select the menu item and confirm it.

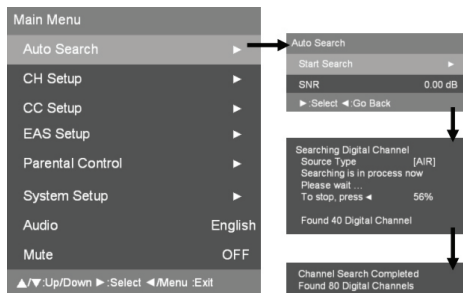
(7). MENU

- Display/leave Main Menu screen.
- Return to last menu.
- While in MENU screen, use [▲] / [▼] and [OK] key to select menu item and confirm.

2.3 Channel Scan / First Installation

When first time installation or move to a new place, you need to perform channel scan to get channel list updated. Stretch the built-in telescopic TV antenna first. Press [MENU] to enter [Main Menu], Select [Auto Search] and [Start Search] then start searching TV channels. All the founded channels stores into the channel list.



2.4 How To Change Channel

There are two options to select desired TV channel.

- (1) CH +/- : Press Key [CH+] / [CH-] to select a next/previous channel from the channel list.
- (2) CH List : Press [CH] and select desired channel from the Channel List.

2.5 Channel List

Press [CH] to display channel list on the screen. Use navigation keys to select desired channel.

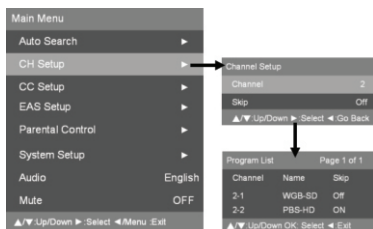

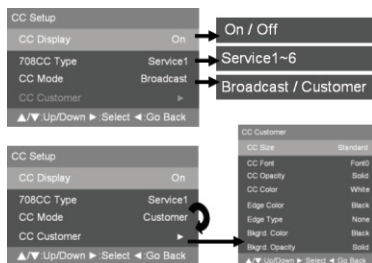
3. Setup Menu

3.1 Channel Setup



You can select a channel and enable [SKIP] to ON then this channel will be bypassed when changing channel by CH+/CH-.

3.2 Closed-Caption / CC Setup



- (1) Enable or disable closed-caption from the [CC Display] menu.
- (2) Select CC Service1~6 from TV program provider.
- (3) To customize CC style, change CC Mode to [Customer] then modify the parameter from the menu.

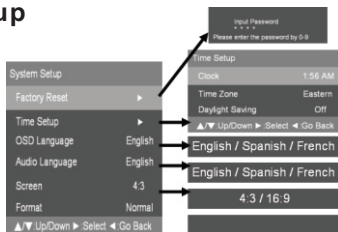

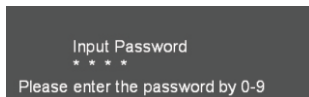
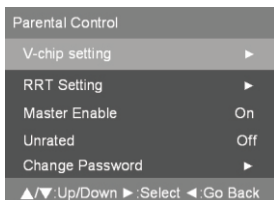

3.5 Parental Control / V-chip

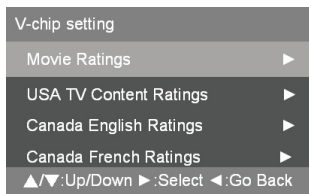
For protecting children from harmful television, parents can change the parameter from the parental control menu.

world. TV program consist related information in the stream. The device will display or block according to the setup level.



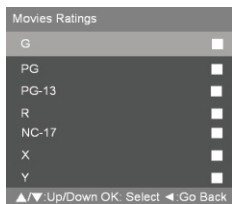
Password required before entering the setup menu of V-chip

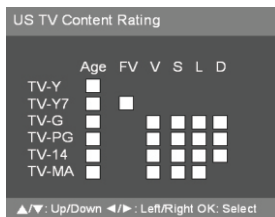

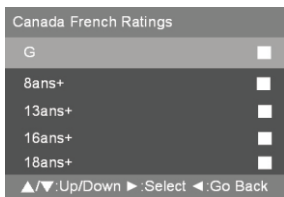

TROUBLE SHOOTING

4. Trouble Shooting

Symptom	Remedy
No power	Check if both plugs of the mains cord are properly connected. Check if there is power at the AC outlet by plugging in another appliance. Check if battery pack is inserted appropriately. Check if car adaptor is connected appropriately.
No picture	Try to re-scan channel again. Check the level setting of parental control.
Distorted picture	Try to stretch TV antenna or move to a place closed to the window.
No sound	Check audio connections. If using a HiFi amplifier, try another sound source.
Some TV program lost	Try to re-scan TV channel again after moving to a new place. Try to stretch the TV antenna. Some TV program broadcasted in lower frequency need longer TV antenna to receive properly, and some TV program broadcasted in higher frequency need shorter TV antenna to receive properly. Change direction or move to place more closed to the window.
Player feels warm	When the player is in use for a long period of time, the surface will be heated. This is normal.
