

## Using SKYPE

You can use your headset when talking with your friends via SKYPE. You first need to install the SKYPE program.  
To install the SKYPE program, insert the supplied Skype install disk in your CD-ROM drive and refer to the display instructions.

## Using your Headset

### Setting up your headset

With most operating systems, you simply plug the USB connector into any USB port on the computer.

### Recording for PC users

1. Go to **Start > Programs > Accessories > Entertainment > Sound Recorder**.
2. With your headset positioned correctly, click ● and record your voice file.
3. Click ■ when you finish recording.
4. To listen to your recording, click ▶.

### SKYPE with sound card option

#### Sound Playback

1. Go to **Start > Settings > Control Panel > Sounds and Multimedia**.
2. Choose the **Audio** Tab.
3. Select the appropriate option in **Sound Playback** to play sound by audio card.
4. Click **OK** when finished.

#### Sound Recording

1. Go to **Start > Settings > Control Panel > Sounds and Multimedia**.
2. Choose the **Audio** Tab.
3. Select the appropriate option in **Sound Recording** to record.
4. Click **OK** when finished.

## Helpful Hints

- If there is no sound after connecting to your PC, open the Sound and Multimedia control panel and select USB Audio Device from the **Audio** tab.
- If the mic is mute when you are talking with your friends via SKYPE, open ● from the bottom task bar and unselect **AGC** from Advanced Controls menu.

### For Windows 2000

Go to **Start > Settings > Control Panel > Sounds and Multimedia > Audio > "Volume"** of sound recording.

Select **Options** > click **Advanced Controls**.

Click **Advanced** > unselect **1 AGC** > **Close**.

### For Windows XP

Go to **Start > Control Panel > Sounds and Audio Devices > Audio > "Volume"** of sound recording.

Select **Options** > click **Advanced Controls**.

Click **Advanced** > unselect **1 AGC** > **Close**.
