### **Safety precautions**

- Never disassemble or modify your headset for any reason. Doing this may cause the headset to malfunction or become combustible. Bring the headset to an authorised service centre to repair it or replace the battery.
- When using your headset while driving, follow local regulations in the region you are in.
- Avoid storage at high temperatures (above 50 °C/122 °F), such as in a hot vehicle or in direct sunlight, as this can damage performance and reduce battery life.
- Do not expose the headset or any of its supplied parts to rain or other liquids.

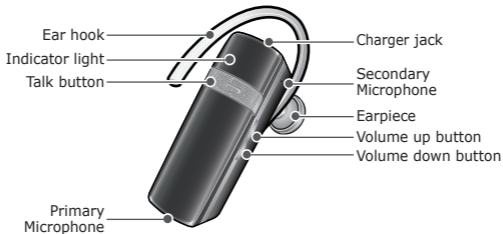


At very high volumes, prolonged listening to the headset can damage your hearing.

## Getting started

This section explains what to remember for the proper use of your Bluetooth headset.

### Your headset overview



Make sure you have the following items with your headset : Charger, User's guide

The items supplied with your headset may vary depending on your region.

## Button functions

### **Talk button**

- Press and hold to turn the headset on or off.
- Press to make or answer a call.
- Press to end a call.
- Press and hold to enter Pairing mode.

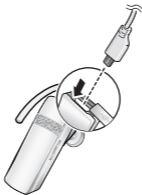
### **Volume up or down button**

- Press to adjust the volume.
- Press and hold both buttons at the same time to turn the indicator light on or off.
- Press and hold to turn the microphone on or off.

## Charging the headset

This headset has a rechargeable internal battery which is non-removable. Ensure that you fully charge the battery before using the headset for the first time.

- 1 Put the charger into the jack on the headset and into a power outlet.



- 2 Disconnect the charger from the power outlet and the headset when the indicator light changes to blue.



- Use only a Samsung-approved charger. Unauthorised chargers may cause an explosion or damage to the headset.
- The battery will gradually wear out while charging or discharging because it is a consumable part.
- The headset is not able to operate while charging. Try connecting after charging is completed.

## When the battery charge gets low

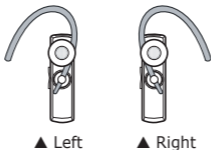
A warning sound beeps and the indicator light flashes red. If you are on a call, transfer the call from the headset to the phone before the headset automatically turns off.

## Wearing the headset

Place the headset on your ear.



Depending on what ear you are going to wear the headset, simply adjust the ear hook accordingly.





## Using your headset

This section explains how to turn the headset on, pair with the phone, and use various functions.




- Activated functions may differ depending on the phone type.
- Some devices, especially those that are not tested or approved by Bluetooth SIG, may be incompatible with your headset.

## Turning the headset on or off

- To turn the headset on, press and hold [  ] until the blue indicator light flashes 4 times.
- To turn the headset off, press and hold [  ] until both blue and red indicator lights flash.

## Pairing with a Bluetooth phone



Pairing will create a unique and encrypted wireless link between two Bluetooth enabled devices, such as a Bluetooth phone and a Bluetooth headset. To use the headset with other Bluetooth devices, both devices must be paired. When trying to pair the two devices, keep the headset and the phone reasonably close together.

- 1 Enter Pairing mode.
  - Turn off your headset and press and hold [  ] until the blue indicator light turns on and stays lit after flashing.
  - If you turn the headset on for the first time, it proceeds into Pairing mode immediately.
- 2 Search for and connect with your phone according to your phone user's guide. (Bluetooth PIN: 0000, 4 zeros)




## Pairing with the other Bluetooth phone

Your headset can be connected with two Bluetooth phones at the same time. This means you can use your headset between two different phones.

- 1 Turn off the headset after connecting with the first Bluetooth phone.
- 2 Press and hold [] until the blue indicator light [] turns on and stays lit after flashing.
- 3 Search for and connect with the second Bluetooth phone. (Bluetooth PIN: 0000, 4 zeros)
- 4 Connect to the headset from the first Bluetooth phone.



- Your headset supports the Simple Pairing feature which allows the headset to be paired with a phone without requesting a PIN. This feature is available when the phone is compliant with Bluetooth version 2.1 or higher.
- The headset attempts to reconnect to the most recently connected phone automatically each time it turns on. Otherwise, press [] to reconnect to the most recently connected phone.

## Using call functions

### Making a call

#### Redialing the last number

Press and hold [↵] to redial the last number of the most recently connected phone.

Press [↵] twice to redial the last number of the other phone.

#### Dialing a number by voice

Press [↵] to dial a number of the first phone by voice, and say a name.

### Answering a call

Press [↵] to answer a call when you hear incoming call tones.


When two calls from the two connected phones come in, pressing [↵] will answer the call of the first phone.

### Ending a call

Press [↵] to end a call.

## Rejecting a call

Press and hold [] to reject a call when a call comes in.

When two calls from the two connected phones come in, pressing and holding [] will reject the call of the first phone.

## Using options during a call

You can use the following functions to control your call during a call.


### Adjusting the volume

Press the Volume up or down button to adjust the volume.

### Muting the microphone

Press and hold the Volume up or down button to turn the microphone off so that the person with whom you are speaking cannot hear you. Press and hold the Volume up or down button again to turn the microphone back on.

### Transferring a call from the phone to the headset

Press [] to transfer a call from the phone to the headset.




### Placing a call on hold

Press and hold [] to place the current call on hold.




When the headset is connected with two phones, this function is not available.

## Answering a second call

When the headset is connected with one Bluetooth phone:

- Press [>] to end the first call and answer a second call of the same phone when you hear call waiting tones.
- Press and hold [>] to place the first call on hold and answer a second call of the same phone when you hear call waiting tones.
- To switch between the current call and the held call, press and hold [>].

When the headset is connected with two Bluetooth phones:

- Press [>] to end the first call and answer a second call of the other phone when you hear call waiting tones.
- Press and hold [>] to place the first call on hold and answer a second call of the other phone when you hear call waiting tones.
- To switch between the current call and the held call, press and hold [>].



You cannot answer a second call of the same phone.

## Appendix

### Frequently asked questions

<b>Will my headset work with laptops, PCs, and PDAs?</b>	Your headset will work with devices that support your headset's Bluetooth version and profiles. For specifications, see page 16.
<b>Will anything cause interference with my conversation when I am using my headset?</b>	Appliances such as cordless phones and wireless networking equipment may cause interference with your conversation, usually adding a crackling noise. To reduce any interference, keep the headset away from other devices that use or produce radio waves.
<b>Will my headset interfere with my car's electronics, radio, or computer?</b>	Your headset produces significantly less power than a typical mobile phone. It also only emits signals that are in compliance with the international Bluetooth standard. Therefore, you should not expect any interference with standard consumer-grade electronics equipment.

<b>Can other Bluetooth phone users hear my conversation?</b>	When you pair your headset to your Bluetooth phone, you are creating a private link between only these two Bluetooth devices. The wireless Bluetooth technology used in your headset is not easily monitored by third parties because Bluetooth wireless signals are significantly lower in radio frequency power than those produced by a typical mobile phone.
<b>The sound is echoing while talking.</b>	Adjust the speaker volume, or move to another area and try again.
<b>How do I take care of my headset?</b>	Wipe it with a soft dry cloth.
<b>The headset does not fully charge.</b>	The headset and the charger may not have been connected properly. Separate the headset from the charger, reconnect, and charge the headset.
