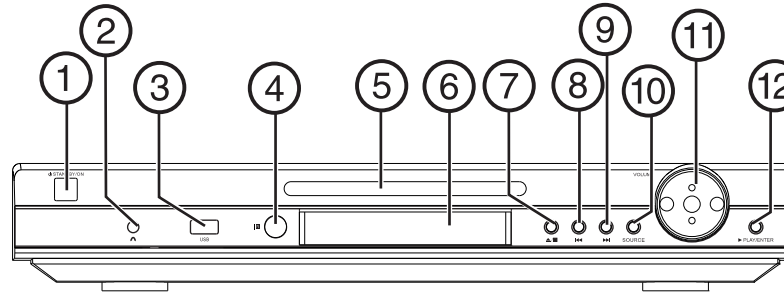


## Setup Guide | DX-HTIB Home Theater System

### Step 1 Get to know your player

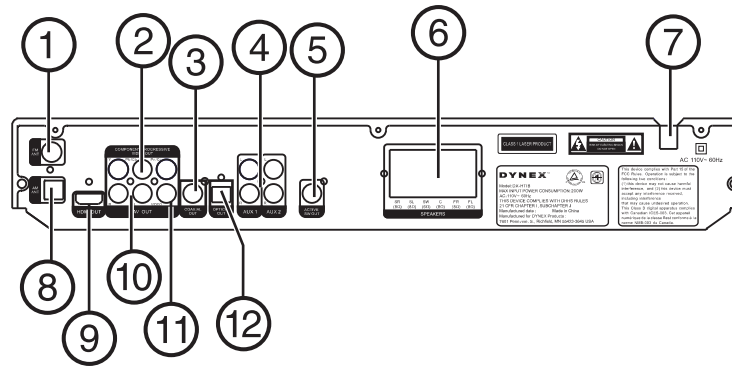
Check out the front and back of your unit to familiarize yourself with button controls and connection options.

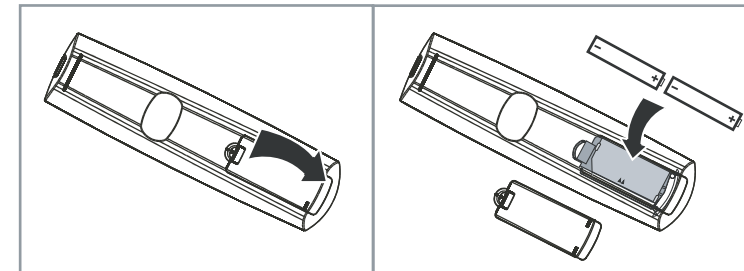

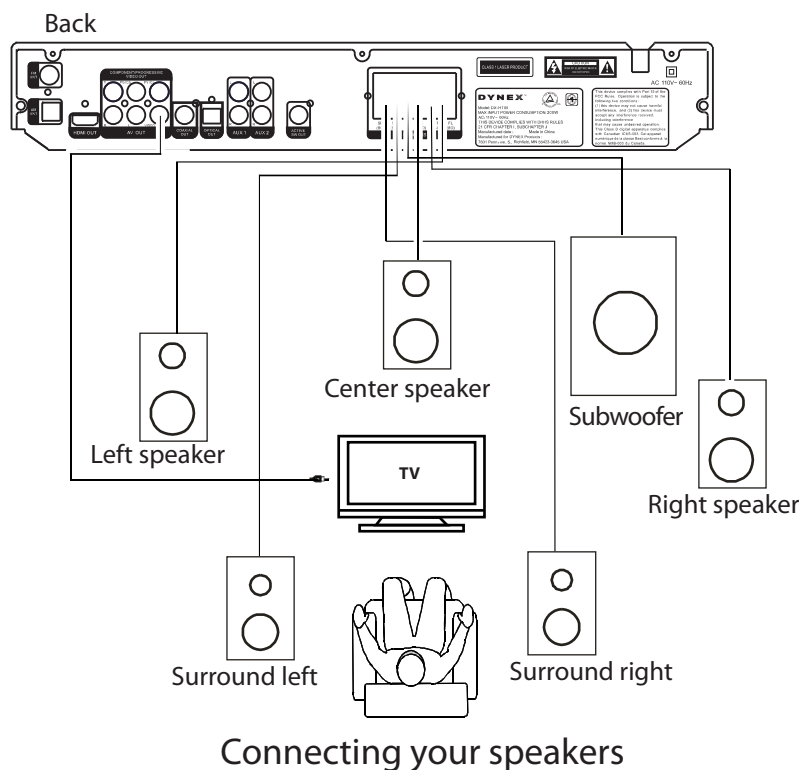
### Step 2 Install remote control batteries

Remove the cover from the back of the remote control, insert batteries as indicated, then replace the cover.

Connect the AC power cord directly to a power outlet. Press the power button.

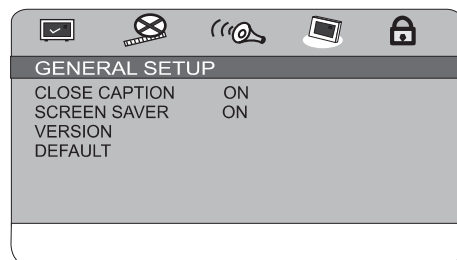
### Step 5 Using the Setup menu

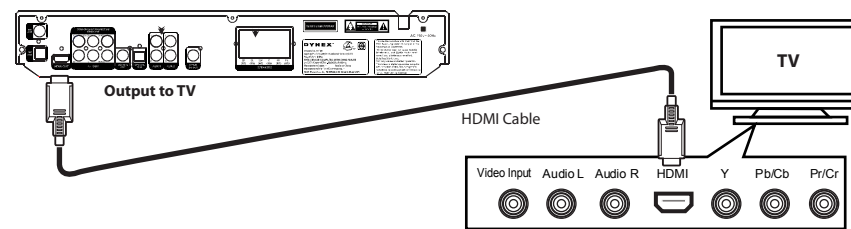
#### To use the Setup menu:

- 1 Press **SETUP**. The *General Setup Page* opens.
- 2 Press **◀** or **▶** to select the menu page you want, then press **PLAY/ENTER**.
- 3 Press **▲** or **▼** to select an option, then press **▶** to open the sub-menu.
- 4 Press **▲** or **▼** select an option, then press **PLAY/ENTER** to confirm your selection.
- 5 Press **◀** to go to the previous menus.
- 6 Repeat Step 2 through Step 4 to select other menu pages.

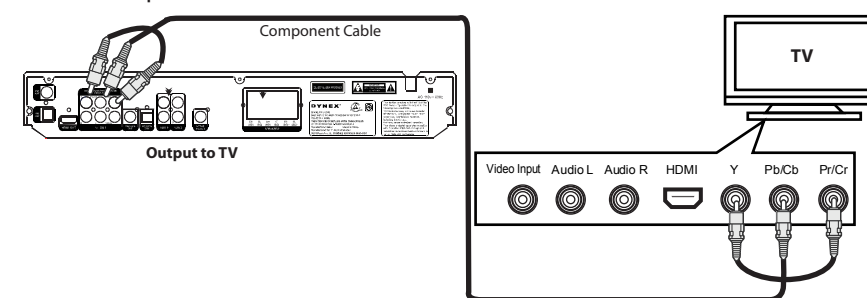


### How to connect your system

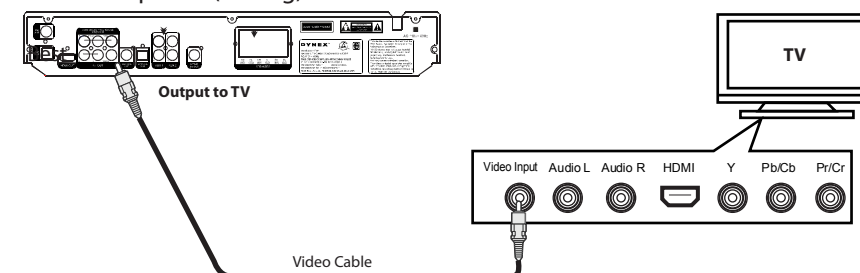
#### Best: HDMI Video connection

### Controlling disc playback

#### To control disc playback:

- Press the **OPEN/CLOSE ▲** button on the remote control (or the **EJECT** button on your player). The disc tray opens.
- Place a disc, label side up, in the disc tray, then close the tray. The disc starts playing automatically.
- Press **▶** to play/pause, press **■** to stop. Press **◂** to navigate in the on-screen DVD menus.

### Using the radio

- Press **STANDBY/ON** to turn on the player.
- Press **AM/FM** to switch the player to radio mode and toggle between the AM and FM bands.
- Press **TUNE+** or **TUNE-** to select a station.
