SUPPORTS THAT ARE INDEPENDENT OF THE OUTLET BOX FOR A SAFE AND SECURE INSTALLATION, THESE FIXTURES MUST BE INSTALLED BY MEANS OF

HANGING THE FIXTURE

- 1. Shut off the power at the circuit breaker and removed old fixtures from ceiling, including the old
- 2. Carefully unpack new fixture and lay all the parts on a clear surface.
- Thread nipple into coupling tight with hex nut.
- Put center column over nipple and secure with fixture loop.
- washer and hex nut. 5. Thread nipple into coupling tight with hex nut, place caps and tube over nipple and secure with
- Place glass over nipple and secure with washer and hex nut.
- Place decorative cap and small cap over nipple and secure with finial.
- 8.Place glass shield over studs on support plate and secure with rubber washer and knurled knobs.

CONNECTING THE WIRES

- 9. Take the black wire from the ceiling junction box and the smooth wire leg from the fixture and twist bare ends together. Twist wire connector onto the end of wires until snug.
- wires together in the same direction as you twist the wire connector onto wires 10. Repeat same process with white junction box white and ribbed wire leg of fixture wire. NOTE: Twist
- the junction box with a screw. copper wire from the fixture. If junction box has no ground wire, attach the bare copper fixture wire to 11. If your junction box has a grounding wire (green or bare copper), attach this wire and the bare
- to the ceiling. Thread onto ceiling loop protruding through canopy 12. Tuck these wire connections neatly into the ceiling outlet box and then raise the canopy all the way
- Install the light bulbs in accordance with the fixtures specifications

NOTE: DO NOT EXCEED THE SPECIFIED WATTAGE

Your installation is now complete. Return power to the junction box and test the fixture
