# DESCRIPTION

NBJ-/NBJ-B night switch-over devices are designed for AIPHONE NEM/NEM-A Lamp Memory Intercom systems most suitably used in nursing homes, private clinics, schools and correction institutions, etc.

The calls from subs being answered by the master A in nurse center during daytime, can be routed via NBJ/NBJ-B unit to the master B during nighttime.

It may also be a popular application that a single master of one floor controls the subs of the other floor(s) during nighttime, while each master controls its subs separately during daytime.

NEM master unit mounts onto the NBJ unit and NEM-A master unit onto the NBJ-B unit.

#### SYSTEM COMPONENTS

NBJ-20Night switchover deivicefor NEM-10 and NEM-20NBJ-40- do -for NEM-30 and NEM-40NBJ-20B- do -for NEM-10A and NEM-20ANBJ-40B- do -for NEM-30A and NEM-40A, along with the standard NEM-/NEM-A masters, subs and accessories.

#### INSTALLATION

NBJ-/NBJ-B units are desk-top use only. First, remove four screws on back of NEM/NEM-A master unit, and remove the sub chassis. Then, attach the NEM/NEM-A unit to the NBJ-/NBJ-B unit, re-screwing at four points.

#### **OPERATION**

A rotary switch is provided on NBJ-20 and NBJ-20B units and two rotary switches on NBJ-40 and NBJ-40B units. Be sure that all the switches are set to either position 1 or 2 at a time.

When the switch is set to 1 position, the subs wiring is connected to the master  $\overline{A}$ , and by setting the switch to 2 position, the subs wiring is switched to the master  $\overline{B}$  (See SYSTEM LAYOUT EXAMPLE # (1)).

SYSTEM LAYOUT EXAMPLE #(1)



The sub stations are controlled by the master  $\boxed{A}$  during daytime. After sub stations wiring is switched to 2 position, the master  $\boxed{B}$  takes responsibility during night.



During daytime, NEM master  $\overline{A}$  and  $\overline{B}$  control communication with each subs separately. By setting switch from 1 to 2 position, NEM-40 (master  $\overline{B}$ ) can receive calls from all the forty sub stations during nighttime.
