The Cisco 7937G is a variant of the Polycom IP 7000 and has the same programming instructions.



- 3. Polycom SoundStation IP Multi Interface Module (P/N 2200-19300-001)



Connecting the Cables

CONNECTING A REVOLABS SINGLE CHANNEL TO THE POLYCOM IP 7000 SPEAKERPHONE

1. Connect the Single Channel System to the SoundStation IP 7000 the left "Audio In" port on the Multi Interface Module using the Revolabs 2.5mm to RCA cable





Configuring the IP 7000 Speakerphone

CONFIGURING THE AUDIO MENUS OF THE IP 7000 SPEAKERPHONE

- 1. Press the MENU button
- 2. Scroll down to SETTINGS (3)
- 3. Select BASIC (1)
- 4. Scroll down to AUDIO (5)
- 5. Select AUXILIARY AUDIO (2)
- 6. Select AUX AUDIO IN (1)
- 7. Verify that OTHER INPUT (2) is active
