




## Welcome

## 19 Key USB Slim Keypad




## 6 Foot Auto Retractable Phone Cable

**STEP 1** - Hold your 6' Auto Retractable Phone Cable with one hand while gently pulling the modules outward.



**STEP 2** - Be careful not to pull the cable past the intended length or it could result in damage to the cord or mechanism inside.



**STEP 3** - To retract the cable, push black button located on the bottom.

## 3 Button Optical Scroll Mouse


