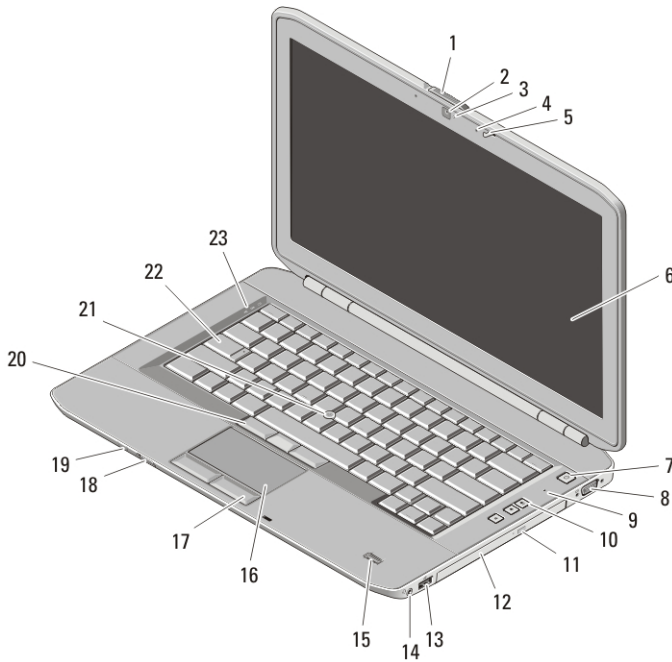


Figure 1. Front View

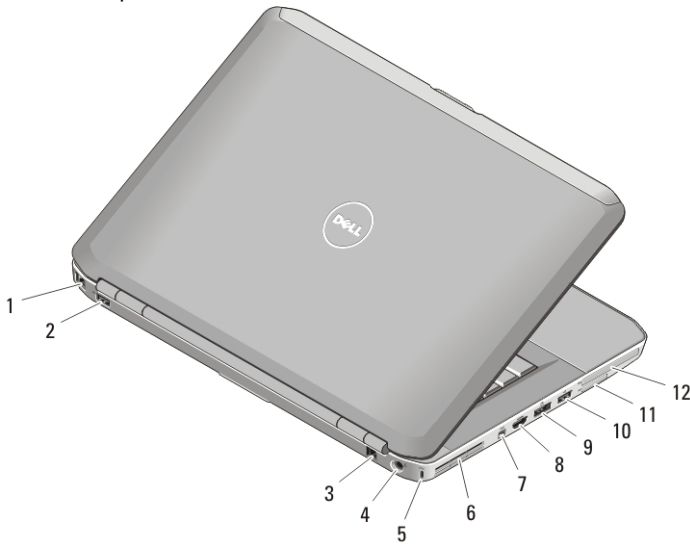


Figure 2. Back View

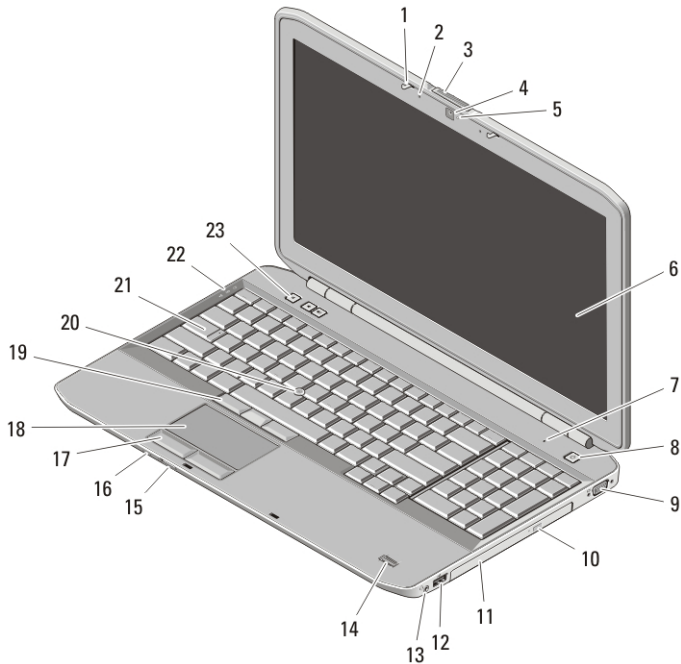


Figure 3. Front View

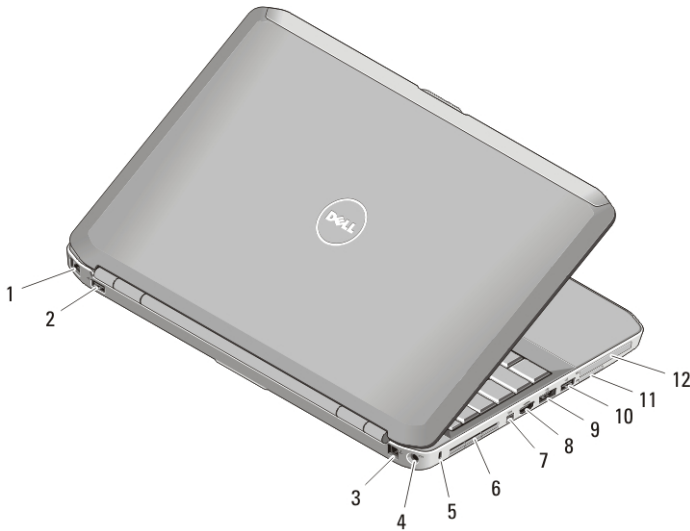


Figure 4. Back View

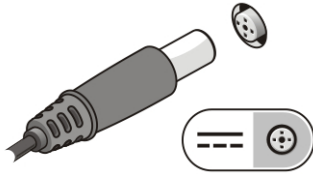


Figure 5. AC Adapter

2. Connect the network cable (optional).

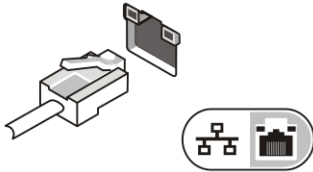


Figure 6. Network Connector

3. Connect USB devices, such as a mouse or keyboard (optional).

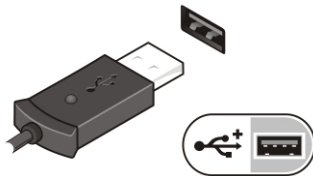


Figure 7. USB Connector

4. Connect IEEE 1394 devices, such as a 1394 hard drive (optional).

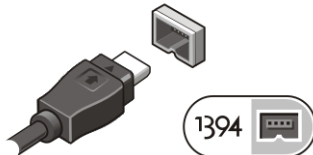



Figure 8. 1394 Connector
