
Connect supplies



Connect water supply tubes to hot and cold faucet shanks with coupling nuts supplied. FINGER tighten. NOTE: Do not use supply tubes w/metal formed ends with non-metallic shanks.



Turn on water supplies and check for leaks. With faucet off, remove aerator. Turn on hot and cold water to flush lines and faucet. Turn off faucet and replace aerator.

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

With or Without Pop-Up




Before you begin

Use this diagram to familiarize yourself with the various parts of the faucet assembly. Make sure you have all the illustrated parts before you begin installation.

If you are putting in a new sink, it is easier to mount the faucet, drain and any other accessories **before** installing the sink into the countertop.

- Observe all local plumbing codes.
- Carefully inspect the valve parts for any damage.
- Flush all piping thoroughly before installing.
- Shut off hot & cold water supplies.
- Do not use plumber's putty or thread sealants on mounting nuts or coupling nuts.




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Items you need

Adjustable wrench, Phillips and flathead screwdrivers, and Teflon tape.

Remove old faucet




Turn off both water supplies at valves.

OPTIONAL MATERIALS:

- Supply stops (2) Some installations may require stops to be installed.
- Supply tubing (2) and fittings will need to be provided.

NOTE: Do not use supply tubes w/metal formed ends with non-metallic shanks.



2 Disconnect supply lines.


HELPFUL OPTION

3 Basin wrench for removing old faucet.




Remove mounting nuts, lift off faucet.

Install faucet




Place ring of putty around base edge of faucet. Loosely place washers, spacers, and nuts on threaded bolts. With washers angled, manuever shanks and bolts through holes in deck.




2 From underside of lavatory tighten munting nuts until spacers and washers are flush with deck botom. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN. If deck is thick, spacers may be eliminated.


Install Pop-Up



Thread locknut, flat side up, onto body. Slide rubber washer, beveled side up, onto body. Thread tail-piece into body.




Place seal into opening of strainer tube with beveled edge out. Insert ball rod into strainer tube. Hand tighten ball rod nut.




Place ring of putty around underside of drain flange. Insert strainer tube assembly up through hole of lavatory and screw flange onto top of strainer tube.

Install Pop-Up continued . . .




Drain flange should rest flush with lavatory basin.
Tighten locknut securely against underside of lavatory.
Ball rod assembly must be pointing to rear of lavatory.




Place one end of spring clip over ball rod and slide back 1/2" to 1". Place ball rod through hole in strap that is appropriate for lavatory depth. Compress spring clip and slide ball rod through other spring clip hole to secure.

Install Pop-Up continued . . .



Insert pop-up rod down through hole in back of faucet. With ball rod in down position, attach strap to lift rod by securely FINGER tightening thumb screw.



While pushing down on pop-up rod, insert plug into drain and turn 1/4 turn to engage stopper to ball lever
