




Removing the spare tire

Anti-lock brake system warning¹


∧CAUTION

When the anti-lock brake system (ABS) function is in action, you may feel the brake pedal pulsating and hear a noise. In this situation, to let the anti-lock brake system work for you, just hold the brake pedal down more firmly. Do not pump the brake as this will result in reduced braking performance.








Engine maintenance


FEATURES/OPERATIONS

Auto lock functions (Automatic Transmission only)

Automatic door locks can be programmed to operate in 4 different modes

- -Doors lock when shifting from Park.
- Auto lock function cancelled.
- -Doors lock when shifting from park, and unlock when shifting into park.
- -Doors lock when shifting from Park, and unlock when the ignition key is turned to the "ACC" or "LOCK" position.

Automatic transmission (if equipped)



¹The ignition must be ON, and the brake pedal depressed.

Downshifting increases power going uphill, or provides engine braking going downhill. For best fuel economy during normal driving conditions, always drive with the shift lever in the "D" position.


Overdrive switch

To turn "ON" or "OFF" Depress the overdrive switch to choose either four-speed ("OFF") or five-speed ("ON") operation. During normal driving conditions, always drive with overdrive "ON;" this allows the transmission to shift automatically into five-speed operation at higher speeds, improving fuel economy. If the O/D indicator light on the instrument cluster is illuminated, overdrive is "OFF."


Manual transmission (if equipped)

For safety, the engine will not start unless the clutch pedal is FULLY depressed.


Tilt steering wheel








Lights & turn signals

- -Automatic light cut off system Will automatically turn lights off after a delay of thirty (30) seconds. Or turn off by pushing "LOCK" button on remote twice.








CASSETTE TAPE PLAYER (Type 2 and 3)

To fast forward Push "▶▶."

To rewind Push " ◀◀."

To change a direction Push "∢|▶."

CD PLAYER

To scan tracks on a disc Push and hold "SCAN." Push again to hold selection.

CD Changer (Type 3 only)

- -To load one disc Push "LOAD" and insert 1 disc.
- **-To load multiple discs** Push and hold "LOAD" until you hear a beep. Insert one disc. Shutter will close and then re-open for next disc.

RADIO

To scan stations Push "SCAN." Push and hold to scan preset stations. Push again to hold selection.



To preset stations Tune in the desired station and press a preset button (1-6) until you hear a beep. Push desired preset button (1-6) to select.

RDS (Radio Data System-FM only)(Type 3 only)

- -Push TYPE " \wedge " or " \vee " to view current program genre. Push again within 6 seconds to select new genre.
- -Push "SEEK/TRACK" or "SCAN" to find same genre programs.
- -Push "TEXT" to receive information transmitted from radio stations.






SAFETY AND EMERGENCY FEATURES

Doors-Child safety locks



Move the lever to "LOCK," allowing the door to be opened only from the outside.

Seat belts



If belt is fully extended, then retracted even slightly, it cannot be re-extended beyond that point, unless fully retracted again. This feature is used to help hold child restraint systems securely.
