


- Take frequent breaks from working on the computer. Get up and walking around each hour.

- Adjust your chair and keyboard so that your upper arms and wrists are level with the desktop.
- Avoid letting your wrist to rest on sharp edges.

Quick Setup


- Install the Receiver with PS/2 (Mouse) and USB (Keyboard) connectors
 - 1. Please turn off your PC.
 - 2. Plug the mouse PS/2 connector on the receiver into the PS/2 mouse port of the PC.
 - 3. Plug the keyboard USB connector on the receiver into the USB port of the PC.



- Install the Receiver with USB Connector
 - 1. You may only connect the USB connector of the receiver to the PC without plugging the mouse PS/2 connector



- Install the Receiver with PS/2 (Mouse) and UP (Keyboard) Connectors
 - 1. Please turn off your PC.
 - 2. Plug the mouse PS/2 connector on the receiver into the PS/2 mouse port of the PC.
 - 3. Connect the USB-to-PS/2 adapter with the keyboard USB connector of the receiver. Plug the adapter into the keyboard PS/2 port of the PC.



Link the Wireless Keyboard with the Receiver

Note:

- Please link the keyboard within the effective distance.
- The linkage period is 15 seconds. Once press the receiver's Link Button, please complete the keyboard linkage process within the linage period.
- 1. Please turn on your PC. The LED indicator on the receiver will light.
- 2. Press the ID Link Button on the receiver and the LED indicator will blink. There are 15 seconds for the keyboard linkage.
- 3. Press the ID Link Button of the keyboard.
- 4. The keyboard is linked with the receiver.
- 5. The LED indicator of the receiver will blink while you use the keyboard.
- 6. The keyboard set designs with the unique Smart Link function. Once the linkage process is complete, you don't have to re-link the keyboard even if you change batteries or restart the computer.
- 7. If the keyboard does not link with the receiver, please repeat Step $2 \sim 3$.
- 8. If the selected channel is interfered by other wireless-mouse or keyboard users nearby, please change the Link ID by re-linkage or select the other channel immediately.
- 9. There are 256 changeable IDs for each channel.

Install Keyboard Driver

Note:

- The driver supports Windows 95/ 98/ NT/ 2000/ ME and XP.
- When you change the interface port, please reinstall the driver.
- 1. Remove any existing keyboard drivers completely.
- 2. Insert the driver CD-ROM to your PC \rightarrow If the driver CD-ROM does not be automatically installed, please double click "Setup.exe" to install the keyboard driver.
- 3. Restart the PC \rightarrow A keyboard setting icon will appear on the task bar of Windows \rightarrow Double click the icon to set the keyboard functions.

Troubleshooting

Function keys, or hot keys do not work properly

- Check to see if there are other keyboard drivers install on your system. If so, then uninstall all keyboard drivers and re-install your ViewSonic ViewMate keyboard drivers.
- Check to see if one of the LED lights is on. Press the corresponding key to turn that function off. For example, if the Undo key does not work and the Scoll LED light is on, press the Scoll Key. The Scroll Lock LED turns off and the Undo Key functions properly.

Other software applications do not install properly

- Uninstall the keyboard drivers from your system. See the Uninstall keyboard software section above. To do this, right click on the keyboard icon in the tool bar and choose EXIT. Install the desired software application. Restart your system. For more information, see the Keyboard Functions diagram on page 5.
- If a key malfunctions, please contact Customer Support. See the Customer Support table in this guide.

VCD or MPEG files do not display properly

VCD (video CD) titles or MPEG files need Media Player 7 installed on your system. Media Player 7 can be downloaded from the Microsoft Website.

Cleaning Instructions

- **2.** Use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment. Or, use a can or air to spray out any loose dirt. Do not spray liquid on the keyboard.

What the warranty covers:

ViewSonic[®] warrants its products to be free from defects in material and workmanship during the warranty period. If a product proves to be defective in material or workmanship during the warranty period,

ViewSonic will, at its sole option, repair or replace the product with a like product. Replacement product or parts may include remanufactured or refurbished parts or components.

How long the warranty is effective:

ViewSonic Keyboard (if included in package) are warranted for one (1) year for all parts and one (1) year for all labor from the date of the first consumer purchase.

Who the warranty protects:

This warranty is valid only for the first consumer purchaser.

What the warranty does not cover:

- 1. Any product on which the serial number has been defaced, modified or removed.
- 2. Damage, deterioration or malfunction resulting from:
 - a. Accident, misuse, neglect, fire, water, lightning, or other acts of nature, unauthorized product modification, or failure to follow instructions supplied with the product.
 - b. Repair or attempted repair by anyone not authorized by ViewSonic.
 - c. Any damage of the product due to shipment.
