


AC/DC ADAPTER

Use the included AC/DC Adapter to connect the unit to an AC power source.


USING THE BUILT-IN STAND

There is a small metal support built into the bottom of the unit. When setting the unit in place, fold out the metal stand to provide support for the unit.

- 2. Press the **Open/Close Button** to open the Motorized CD/iPod Door.
- Dock an iPod onto the **Dock Connector**.
- 4. Press the **Open/Close Button** to close the Motorized CD/iPod Door

UN-DOCKING AN IPOD

- 1. Press the **Power Button** to turn the unit on.
- Press the **Open/Close Button** to open the Motorized CD/iPod Door.
- 3. Press down the **iPod Eject Button** to the left of the iPod inside the dock for iPod. This will lean the iPod out of the dock, making it easier to grab and remove.



PLAYING AN IPOD

- Dock an iPod onto the unit's **Dock** Connector
- Press the **Power Button** to turn the unit 2. on.
- Press the **Source Button** to switch to iPod Mode.
- 4. Press the Play/Pause Button to begin playing the docked iPod.
- Press the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to skip between tracks on the docked iPod.
- Press and hold the Skip/Tune Buttons to fast forward and rewind on the current track
- Press the **Random Button** on the remote to play the current album or playlist in random order.
- Press the **Repeat Button** on the remote once to repeat the current track.
- Press the **Repeat Button** on the remote twice to repeat an entire album or playlist.
- Press the **iPod Select Button** on the remote to make selections on a docked iPod.

This button works exactly like the select button on an iPod

Press the Mem+/iPod Menu on the remote to move back through the menus on a docked iPod.

This button works exactly like the menu button on an iPod.

Press the Menu- and Menu+ Buttons to move up and down in any menu on the docked iPod.

- Press the **Power Button** to turn the unit on
- Press the **Open/Close Button** to open the Motorized CD/iPod Door.
- Load a CD into the CD player.
- Press the Open/Close Button to close the Motorized CD/iPod Door
- Press the **Source Button** to switch the unit to CD Mode. "CD" will appear on the LCD Display, indicating that the unit is in CD Mode.
- Press the Play/Pause Button to begin playing the loaded CD.
- Press the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to skip between tracks on the loaded CD.
- Press and hold the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to fast forward and rewind on the current track.
- Press the **Stop Button** to stop a CD during play.
- Press the **Intro Button** on the remote to activate Intro Mode. When in Intro Mode. the unit will play the first 10 seconds of a track and then skip to the next track.
- Press the **Random Button** on the remote to play the tracks of a loaded CD in random order.
- Press the **Repeat Button** on the remote once to repeat the current track.
- Press the **Repeat Button** on the remote twice to repeat an entire album.

PROGRAMMING A CD

Follow the Steps for Playing a CD.

- 1. Press the **Stop Button** to stop the CD
- Press the **Program Button** on the remote.
- Press the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to select the track you want to play first.
- Press the **Program Button** on the remote, to save the selected track as the first programmed track.
- Repeat steps 3 and 4 until the desired tracks have been programmed.

Up to 20 tracks can be programmed at one time.

TUNING THE AM/FM RADIO

- 1. Press the **Power Button** to turn the unit on.
- 2. Press the **Source Button** to switch the unit to *Tuner Mode*. "Tuner" will appear on the LCD Display, indicating that the unit is in Tuner Mode.
- 3. Press the **Source Button** to switch to *AM* or *FM radio mode*.
- 4. Press the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to tune the AM or FM radio stations.
- 5. Press and hold the **Skip/Tune Buttons** for 3 seconds to search for a receptive AM or FM radio station.
- 6. Press the **St./Mono Button** to turn the *FM Stereo Mode* off and on .
- 7. Adjust the **FM Wire Antenna** to improve FM radio reception. An AM antenna is built into the unit. Adjust the position of the unit to improve AM radio reception.

SAVING AN AM/FM RADIO STATION TO THE UNIT'S MEMORY

- 1. Tune the AM/FM Radio to the desired station.
- 2. Press the Mem/Clk Adj Button.
- 3. Press the **Stop/Mem+ Button** to select a memory channel for the current radio station.
- 4. Press the Mem/Clk Adj Button.
- 5. To cycle through saved radio stations, Press the **Stop/Mem+ Button.**

USING THE AUXILIARY INPUT

- 1. Connect an MP3 Player or other audio source to the **Auxiliary Input**.
- 2. Press the **Power Button** to turn the unit on.
- 3. Press the **Source Button** to switch the unit to *Aux Mode*.

Use the connected device's controls to control the audio playing through the unit.


SETTING THE CLOCK

- 1. Press the **Power Button** to turn the unit off.
- 2. The **Power Indicator Light** will illuminate red, indicating that the unit is in Standby Mode.
- 3. Press the Mem/Clk Adj Button.
- 4. The Hour will begin to blink.
- 5. Press the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to adjust the hour.
- 6. Press the **Mem/Clk Adj Button** to set the hour.
- 7. The Minute will begin to blink.
- 8. Press the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to adjust the minute.
- 9. Press the **Mem/Clk Adj Button** to set the minute, and finish setting the clock.

SETTING THE TIMER

- 1. To set the timer, you must first go through the steps of Setting the Clock.
- 2. After the clock is set, "Timer" will appear on the LCD Display and the timer hour will begin to blink, indicating that you are now editing the timer.
- 3. Press the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to adjust the hour.
- 4. Press the **Mem/Clk Adj Button** to set the hour.
- 5. The Minute will begin to blink.
- 6. Press the **Skip/Tune Buttons** to adjust the minute.
- 7. Press the **Mem/Clk Adj Button** to set the minute, and finish setting the timer.
- . After setting the timer, press and hold the Mem/Clk Adj Button to activate the timer. The word "Timer" will appear on the LCD display once the timer is activated.

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01. CD Player

Use the CD Player to load a CD into the unit.

02. Power Button

Press the Power Button to turn the unit off and on.

03. Power Indicator

The Power Indicator light will illuminate red when the unit is powered off.

04. Source Button

Press the Source Button to switch between CD, Tuner, iPod, and Aux modes

05. Mem/Clk Adj. Buttons

Press the Memory Button to save an AM or FM radio station to the unit's memory..

Press the Clock Adjust Button to set the unit's clock.

06. Volume Buttons

Press the Volume Buttons to adjust the volume of the unit.

07. Infrared Receiver

The Infrared Receiver receives signals sent from the remote control.

08. LCD Display

09. Auxiliary Input

Use the Auxiliary Input to connect an MP3 player or other audio source to the unit.

10. Speaker Connections

Use the Speaker Connections to connect a set of speakers to the unit.

11. iPod Eject Button

12. Dock Connector

Use the Dock Connector to connect an iPod to the unit.

13. Open/Close Buttons

Press the Open/Close Button to open or close the Motorized CD/iPod Door.

14. Play/Pause/St./Mono Button

Press the Play/Pause Button to play and pause a loaded CD or docked iPod.

Press the St./Mono Button to switch between FM Stereo and FM mono modes.

15. Stop/Mem+ Button

Press the Stop Button to stop a CD during play.

Press the Mem+ Button to cycle through saved radio stations.

16. Skip/Tune Button

Press the Skip Button to skip between tracks on a loaded CD or docked iPod.

Press and hold the Skip Button to search through an individual track on a docked iPod or loaded CD.

Press the Tune Button to tune the AM or FM radio.

17. DC Power Input

Use the DC Power Input to connect the included AC/DC adapter to the unit.

18. FM Wire Antenna

Adjust the FM Wire Antenna to improve FM radio reception.

An AM antenna is built into the unit. Adjust the position of the unit to improve AM radio reception.

20. Power Button

Press the Power Button to turn the unit off and on.

21. Source Button

Press the Source Button to switch between CD, Tuner, iPod, and Aux modes.

22. Program Button

Press the Program Button to program a loaded CD.

Press the Program Button to save an AM or FM radio station to the unit's memory.

23. St./Mono Button

Press the St./Mono Button to switch between FM Stereo and FM mono modes.

24. Menu -/+ Button

Press the Menu - and + Buttons to move up and down through an iPod's menus.

25. Mem+/iPod Menu Button

Press the Mem+ Button to cycle through radio stations saved to the unit's memory.

Press the iPod Menu Button to move back through previous menus on a docked iPod.

This button works exactly like the menu button on an iPod.

26. iPod Select Button

Press the iPod Select Button to make selections on a docked iPod.

This button works exactly like the select button on an iPod.

27. Skip/Tune Button

Press the Skip Button to skip between tracks on a loaded CD or docked iPod.

Press and hold the Skip Button to search through an individual track on a docked iPod or loaded CD.

Press the Tune Button to tune the AM or FM radio.

28. Mem-Button

Press the Mem- Button to cycle through saved radio stations.

29. Stop Button

Press the Stop Button to stop a CD during play.

30. EQ Button


Press the EQ Button to adjust to Classic, Jazz, Rock, or Pop equalizer modes.


31. Bass Button

Press the Bass Button to turn the Bass Enhancement on.

32. Mute Button

Press the Mute Button to mute the volume.





33. Repeat Button

Press the Repeat Button on the remote once to repeat the current track.

Press the Repeat Button on the remote twice to repeat an entire album or playlist. Sleep Button.

34. Sleep Button

Press the Sleep Button consecutively to set the sleep timer between 90 and 10 minutes (in 10 minute increments).

35. Open/Close Button

Press the Open/Close Button to open or close the Motorized CD/iPod Door.

36. Random Button

Press the **Random Button** on the remote to play the current album or playlist in random order.

37. Intro Button

Press the **Intro Button** on the remote to activate *Intro Mode*. When in *Intro Mode*, the unit will play the first 10 seconds of a track and then skip to the next track.

38. Play/Pause Button

Press the Play/Pause Button to play or pause a CD or iPod.

39. Clock Adj Button

Press the Clock Adjust Button to set the unit's clock.

40. Volume Buttons

Press the Volume Buttons to adjust the volume of the unit.
