## Connecting the Player and A PC

#### O Connecting the Player and a PC

Caution: Before connecting the USB cable to the player, stop playback.



Connect the player and the PC, it appears on the LCD of the player as figure:





#### Connecting to a PC

During connecting the USB cable and your PC, USB port can be used as power supply. It takes about two and a half hours to charge the player. During connecting, it cannot play the music. Disconnect the cable before your listening to music.

#### O Power ON / Power OFF

During power OFF, click the button (OWMED) and turn on the player. Long click the button (r) for about 3 seconds, it displays the message to power off.

#### Increase / Decrease Volume



Press "+ " on volume button to increase volume and press "- " on button to decrease volume.







## **Basic Operation**

## Meizu

### O Hold

Using hold function to make buttons inoperative and prevents unwanted action caused by accidental pressing.

Switch to hold: Function button to switch to Hold.

While switch to hold function, all the buttons cannot be operated. It is irrelevant to listen music or FM stations.



#### O Turning Power Off

Press button for more than 3 seconds to turn the play power off.



Power cannot be turned off during the player being connected to your PC through USB cable.

#### O Play, Stop

Press button to play tracks, and again to pause, press for more than 2 seconds to stop. When the player is stopped, Repeat Section disable automatically.

#### O Moving within Track

Press the FF button () for more than 1 second to fast forward. If the FF button is pressed until the end of the track, the position returns back to the start of the next track and fast forwards from thereon.

#### Control Volume

Use +VOL or VOL- to control volume. Keep pressing the button to change the volume continuously.



### Four Operating Modes

#### O Switching Different Modes

There are four modes, MP3 Mode, FM Radio, Voice Recorder and Repeat Mode. Long press ovweo button into four mode selecting. You can switch to the desired mode by using the button and .

Long press (RCC/Au) button to start FM recording. The recorded file is saved as 'M\*\*\*.MP3' under 'REC' folder in a certain sequence. (\*\*\*: A3-digit serial number)

Long press (RECIAN) and stop recording. And return to FM Radio automatically to continue to listen.



You can listen FM radio while FM recording in the meantime. Volume is not controlled during recording.



Please make sure that the battery volume is enough during Voice Recording. Shortcut Recording: During MP3 mode, press (Record) button for 2 seconds and recording starts.



- The recorded file MP3 format (during FM recording, LINE-IN and Microphone recording) and ADPCM format during the Microphone recording are saved in the REC folder under ROOT. ADPCM format for LINE-IN and FM recording is saved in the FM folder under ROOT.
- If it displays The Memory is Full on the LCD, to record, delete files and/or folders on the player in order to make some space available.



WAV format is recommended to use during MIC recording to get high quality recording. Only RECIAND button is useable during recording.

0	Trouble Shooting

No Power	Check that the battery 's polarity is correct. Check the voltage of battery. Take out the battery for a short while and reinsert.
No sound from earphones	Check whether VOLUME is set to "0". Connect the earphones/ remote plug firmly. Check whether plug is dirty. Clean the plug with a dry and soft cloth. Corrupted MP3 or WMA files may make a static noise & the sound may cut off. Check your files on the PC to see if they are corrupted.
Characters in LCD are corrupted	Check whether you select the correct language.
Poor FM reception	Adjust the position of the player and earphones. Turn off the power of other electric devices nearby the player. Earphones function as the antenna.
Failed download of MP3 file	Check the condition of the battery. Check the connection between your computer and the player to ensure that the cable is secure. Check the Manager program to make sure it is operating. Check whether the player 's Memory is full.
