○ Connecting the Player and a PC

Caution: Before connecting the USB cable to the player, stop playback.

- 1 With the USB cable(provided), connect the USB port of the player and your PC.



- 2 Connect the player and the PC, it appears on the LCD of the player as figure:



Connecting to a PC


During connecting the USB cable and your PC, USB port can be used as power supply. It takes about two and a half hours to charge the player. During connecting, it cannot play the music. Disconnect the cable before your listening to music.

○ Connecting the Player and USB Charger

1 Connect the USB Chargeable cable(provided) and the player.



Put down the USB cover, connect the player to power supply. During the connecting, USB port is used as power supply.




2 Connect the player and power supply, it appears on the LCD of the player as this figure:




3 Switch to Hold mode, the player is charged via the USB power supply.



It takes about two and a half hours to charge the player.

○ Power ON / Power OFF

During power OFF, click the button  and turn on the player.

Long click the button  for about 3 seconds, it displays the message to power off.

○ Increase / Decrease Volume



Press "+" on volume button to increase volume and press "-" on button to decrease volume.



○ Selecting Modes



○ Selecting Songs

During play music, press or button to search music.

Switch to the next track.

If is pressed after 5 seconds into the track, the track is played again from the beginning and the button is pressed before 5 seconds, the previous track plays.

○ EQ Selecting

During play music, press to select and change EQ modes.



EQ icon is changed accordingly during selecting




○ Hold

Using hold function to make buttons inoperative and prevents unwanted action caused by accidental pressing.

Switch to hold: Function  button to switch to Hold.



Release: While holding, function  button to release.



While switch to hold function, all the buttons cannot be operated.
It is irrelevant to listen music or FM stations.

● Turning Power Off

Press  button for more than 3 seconds to turn the play power off.



Power cannot be turned off during the player being connected to your PC through USB cable.

● Play, Stop

Press  button to play tracks, and again to pause, press for more than 2 seconds to stop. When the player is stopped, Repeat Section disable automatically.

● Moving within Track


Press the FF button  for more than 1 second to fast forward. If the FF button is pressed until the end of the track, the position returns back to the start of the next track and fast forwards from thereon.

● Control Volume

Use +VOL  or VOL-  to control volume.
Keep pressing the button to change the volume continuously.

Switching Different Modes

There are four modes, MP3 Mode, FM Radio, Voice Recorder and Repeat Mode. Long press **ON/M/EQ** button into four mode selecting. You can switch to the desired mode by using the button **◀** and **▶**.

3. Turn off Screen



- The screen picture can be automatically turn off after a preset time while it is playing.

4. Auto Off



- When there is no button operation during a preset time while the player is stopped, it is automatically turned off.
- You can choose: Off, 1 Min, 2 Min, 5 Min, 10 Min
- Select Auto OFF and press the 'Menu' button. Then choose a value with the ◀ and ▶ buttons.

5. Sleep



- The player can be set to automatically turn off after a preset time while it is playing.
- You can choose: Off, 10 Min, 20 Min, 30 Min, 60 Min, 90 Min, 120 Min.
- Select Sleep and press the 'Menu' button. Then choose a value with the ◀ and ▶ buttons.





- Select 'Voice bps' and press the 'Menu' button. Then choose a value with the ◀ and ▶ button.

3. Voice Gain




- This adjust the volume level of the sound input to the built-in microphone.
- You can choose: 0dB, 6dB, 12dB, 18dB
- Select 'Mic Volume' and press the 'Menu' button. Then choose a value with the ◀ and ▶ button.

4. FM Radio bps




- This is the menu for setting the transmission rate (quality) of the MP3 files recorded by pressing the 'REC' button while listening to FM.
- You can choose: 32Kbps, 64 Kbps, 96Kbps, 128 Kbps.
- Select 'FM Radio bps' and press the 'Menu' button. Then choose a value with the ◀ and ▶ button.

5. L-in bps



- This is the menu for setting the transmission rate (quality) of the MP3 files recorded via Line In.
- You can choose: 32Kbps, 64 Kbps, 96Kbps, 128 Kbps.
- Select 'Line-in bps' and press the 'Menu' button. Then choose a value with the ◀ and ▶ button.

6. FM/L-in Gain



- This adjusts the volume level of the sound input(recording level) from the direct encoding jack.
- You can choose: 0dB, 6dB,12dB,18dB
- Select 'Line-in bps' and press the 'Menu' button. Then choose a value with the ◀ and ▶ button.

7. FM/L-in Auto sync



- This is the feature to automatically detect the sound input from the Line-in jack and recognize blanks between tracks to save the tracks separately as individual files.

Firmware Version

Memory

- Information on the flash memory in the Player is displayed.
- You can check usage and remaining memory size.
- Some of the flash memory in the Player is used for system area. Therefore, when we exclude the system area essential for normal operation of the Player, the actual capacity of the flash memory is somewhat reduced.
- For example, with a 256MB product, about 243MB of memory capacity is normal.

Free Memory Space

- Insert the installation CD into the CD-ROM drive. The following screen appears after inserting the CD.



- When installation is automatically not started, execute the setup.exe under the Root folder of the installation CD, and then the Manager program is automatically setup.
- The installation CD contains the following contents:
 - MP3 Driver for Windows98 or lower
 - Firmware Package
 - LOGO DIY tool
- You can update the features of the player by downloading from the internet.
- It is not need to install the program of USB Port Driver for Windows 2000 SP3 system or higher.
- You can use LOGO DIY program to make the desired LOGO interface by yourself.

○ Install the Manager Software

Set up the player manager software on your PC for the following situations:
MP3 player Formatting; Firmware Upgrade; the player can not be connected to PC.

- 1** Insert the player Installation CD to the CD-ROM in your PC. **Click Meizu MP3 Drive** to start the installation.







To uninstall the the player Manager Software, select the Start - Programs - SigmaTel MSCN Audio Player - Uninstall

1 Connect the earphones as below.



2 Turn the player on by pressing the ON button **ON/M/EQ**. Then press **▶** button to start playing music.



It displays the picture as the right finger on the LCD. Up to 50 channels can be memorized.

After finished, the player turn to FM preset mode and start playing channel 01.

During FM mode, long click the Menu button  to enter Menu.







To select a channel saved in memory, press the Navi/Menu button and find the channel by pushing **+** or **-** switch to the left or right. It displays CH** on the LCD during preset mode.

During FM mode press the ON/OFF button  to enter preset mode. Press it again and exit.



○ How to select channels

To select a memorized channel, with  and  to switch to the previous or the next channel.

Long press  button to start FM recording. The recorded file is saved as 'M***.MP3' under 'REC' folder in a certain sequence. (***: A3-digit serial number)

Long press  and stop recording. And return to FM Radio automatically to continue to listen.



You can listen FM radio while FM recording in the meantime. Volume is not controlled during recording.



Please make sure that the battery volume is enough during Voice Recording.

Shortcut Recording: During MP3 mode, press **REC/A-B** button for 2 seconds and recording starts.

Starting Recording

Press **REC/A-B** button for more than 2 seconds to start recording.



Stop Recording

Press **REC/A-B** button for more than 2 seconds again to stop the recording.



- The recorded file MP3 format (during FM recording, LINE-IN and Microphone recording) and ADPCM format during the Microphone recording are saved in the REC folder under ROOT. ADPCM format for LINE-IN and FM recording is saved in the FM folder under ROOT.
- If it displays The Memory is Full on the LCD, to record, delete files and/or folders on the player in order to make some space available.



WAV format is recommended to use during MIC recording to get high quality recording. Only **REC/A-B** button is useable during recording.



What is Firmware?

Firmware is a program embedded in the hardware, which activates various features. By upgrading, you can enhance the features and eliminate the bugs.

When you upgrade the firmware, all the data in the flash memory is deleted. Therefore, users should personally back up important MP3 files and data saved in MP3 player to their PC before upgrading the firmware.

All firmware upgrades are intended for overall enhancement of performance. The upgrades will be provided when available based on our company's judgment.

Some beta versions of the firmware included in our development roadmap may have minor bugs that will be corrected in the official versions of the firmware. We are warning you beforehand of this possibility through this Guide.

Conditions for Firmware Upgrade

Upgrading the firmware requires the basic environment where the USB feature of the Windows OS works properly.

You can check "mobile Disk" in "My Computer" on Windows 98/ME/XP/2000/2003.

Either 'Mobile Disk' must be displayed or a firmware upgrade to be possible. If it is not displayed, we recommend that you check the menu that asks whether or not to use a USB Device from the main board CMOS, or reinstall Windows, or have the USB port on the main board examined.


