The Remaining Battery Charge icon indicates the remaining time the battery can be used. The more the battery is used, the fewer the number of segments in the icon. For some batteries or rechargeable dry cells, the number of segments in the battery icon may increase of decease irregularly while the remaining charge is measured, but this is normal.

When the battery runs out the icon starts blinking, the power is automatically turned off after about 30 minutes.







### **Inserting Battery**


- Put down and open the battery cover.
- 2. Insert the AAA battery
- ${\it 3. Push the cover} \ in \ the \ reverse \ order \ of \ opening \ it. \ And \ close \ the \ battery \ cover.$



- 1. Make sure to power off the product before your taking out the battery.
- To avoid corrosion, remove the batteries if the player is not to be used for a long time.
- Remove dead batteries immediately to avoid damage from corrosion.
   When corrosion occurs, wipe the battery compartment immediately with a dry cloth and insert a new battery.


# The procedures of using for the first time

- ${\bf 1.\ Open\ the\ battery\ cover}, insert\ battery\ into\ the\ player.$
- 2. Link the PC connection cable to USB port of your PC and the player.
- 3. Install USB driver program (Only for Windows98 system or lower). For details, see "[Installing USB Driver Program]".
- 4. Operate and manage [the mobile disk] on My Computer.
- Disconnect the USB cable to the player.
   (All buttons of the player can not be operated during connecting to PC.)
- 6. Connect the earphone to the player.
- 7. Press the ON button to start the player (It will turn ON automatically if you set and select Auto Play in the player).
- 8. Press the PLAY button 👵 , music is played.

### ■ Connecting the Player to a PC

Caution: Before connecting the USB cable to the player, stop playback.

Connect the USB cable(provided) to the USB port of your computer.



2 Connect the player and your computer, it automatically finds the player. It displays as the Mobile Disc on your PC.



# CONNECTING TO A PC

When USB cable is connected to PC for downloading files onto the player, it appears on LCD as the left figure and switch to PC connecting mode. While connecting to PC, tracks cannot be played. Pulling out the PC connection cable from the player before your listening to music.

#### Install Software

Insert the installation CD into the CD-ROM drive. The following screen appears after inserting the CD.

When installation is automatically not started, execute the setup.exe in the installation CD, and then the Manager program is automatically setup.

The installation CD contains the following contents:

- Device Driver for Windows98 or lower
- Meizu Tools
- MP3 Formatting Tools
- DFU Upgrade Tools
- LOGO DIY tools



### ■ Setting Up the Manager Software

Set up the player manager software on your PC for the following situations: MP3 player Formatting, Firmware Upgrade or when it is not able to connect the PC with the player.

1 Insert the player Installation CD to the CD-ROM in your PC. Run the "setup.exe" file. Then the following window appears.





Read the License Agreement. To continue installation, click on the [Yes] button.





5 Select the type of Setup and then specify a group name.



Then necessary files will be copied into your hard disk and updated the driver information. It will take you a few seconds.



The installation is complete.



After finishing the setup, run the firmware 'upgrade program by selecting Start ->,
Programs -> Meizu MP3 Tools -> DFU Tool.





There are DFU Tool, MP3 Format Tool, MP3 LOGO Tool for Meizu MP3 Tools.


# ■ Formatting the Flash Memory

The flash Memory of the player can be formatted. If the flash Memory is formatted, all data stored within is lost. Take notice of this fact, examine the following procedures.

It is easy to format your MP3 player, please refer to Windows instruction to format on your PC. While using WINDOWS formatting, it appears the warning, click OK and finish it.






You should take special care when you format it since all the data in the memory

■ MP3 files can be downloaded to player using the following steps.

Select the desired music to download onto the player from the PC.





Double click [My Computer], then [Mobile Disk] again.









The player is shown as the Mobile Disk on your PC.





6 After finishing copy, it appears the music files on the mobile disk. Disconnected the player to your PC, then you can start listening the music.



Or you can also drag and drop the selected files from your PC into the [Mobile Disk] window.


# ■ Saving Files and Disconnecting to your PC

Copy the Files in the Player into your PC

- 1. With the USB cable, connect the USB ports of the player and your PC. (It should not use a USB hub. It is assumed that you connect to the USB port on the main board.)
- 2. Save the music files under the hard disk on your PC.
- 3. After saved the files, click the icon and on the screen of your PC.



4. It pops the message as above, then click it.



- $5.\ It\ runs\ 'Safely\ Remove\ Hardware'.$
- 6. Then draw out and disconnect the USB cable.

To make sure to save the data on your player safely and fully, please follow the above steps accordingly when you disconnect the player to the PC.

While disconnecting, it appears the warning, click OK and finish it.





1 Power On Press ON/OFF button, the power comes on and Meizu logo appears.





Press ON/OFF button again, start to play. (Since Auto-play function is set, play automatically starts when the power is turned on.)





2. Power Off When you press and hold ON/OFF button, the power turns off. If the PC and the player are connected via a USB cable, you cannot turn the power off.





3. Playback & Stop Press ON/OFF briefly, start to play. Press it again while in Play status, the play stops.





- 4. To select music
- To select previous music ▶ To select next music



- 5. To adjust the volume
- + To increase volume To decrease volume



6. EQ Selecting Press MODE/EQ to switch to the different EQ.



EQ icon is changing during selecting.




7 Hold Put the HOLD switch to On/Off.

By turning Hold ON, the buttons on the player will not function. It is irrelevant to listen music or FM radio.


# ■ Listening to Music



- 1. Connect the player and the earphones.
- 2. Turn the player on by press the ON/OFF button.
- 3. The start logo displays on the LCD.
- 4. Press ON/OFF to start to play the music.
- Navigate with the FF/REW buttons, and select the previous / next music.
   Navigate with the '+' or '-' buttons, and adjust the volume.
- 6. Long press ON/OFF button, the power turns off.

Note: If the buttons cannot function, please check if the HOLD is turning on.

# Selecting Music Mode:

- 1. There are three modes available: Music, Radio, Voice Recorder.
- 2. During MP3 mode, long press the MODE/EQ button, the function selection displays on the LCD.
- 3. Push the FF/REW button to select Music mode.
- 4. Click the NAVI/MENU button and the option is applied.
- 5. During the three modes selection, click the '+' button and exit.

#### ■ Menu Controls

















### Select the Menu Options

Click the MENU button, navigate with the '+' or '-' buttons, and select the menu options. Click the MENU button or push the FF button, then enter the submenu. Push the REW button to the upper menu.

# Adjust the Values

Navigate with the '+' or '-' buttons to adjust the volume. Press the MENU button to apply the options. During the selection, click the '+' button and exit.




- 1. Connect the MP3 player and your PC with the USB cable.
- 2. Save the selected text file(.txt suffix name) into your MP3 player.
- 3. Disconnect the MP3 player and your PC.
- Turn on the player, function the Navigation button and select the text file.
   Press the Menu button, you can view the text file on your player.
- 5. Function the '+' or '-' buttons, you can move the text file page by page.
- Press the Menu button and open the individual window, then you can find the specified position.

Note: During view the e-book, you can listen to the music in the mean time. You can set Auto browse and turn the page automatically. The speed is adjustable by press the EQ/MODE button. You can choose: 04, 06, 08, 10, 12 Secretary.

### Displaying Lyric

- Download the lyric files from the internet to the PC. The lyric file is the format of lrc. As suffix.
- 2. Connect the player and your PC via USB cable.
- Copy and drag the MP3 lyric files on your player. (Saved the lyric files and the songs under the same content. Their names should be both the same except for the suffix names.)
- 4. Disconnect the player and your PC.
- 5. Turn on the player, function it with 🕟 and 🕥 button to select the desired song. It starts to play it.



### ■ Listening to FM Radio











### Music -> Radio Mode (see the above)

- Press and hold the Mode/EQ button to show the main screen and then select the "Radio".
- 2. Press the FF/REW button, you can find the frequency.

Note: If the signal and information in the place where you are listening is too weak, it may degrade the FM radio quality.

# Memorize the Auto Searching Channels.







- 1. During the FM mode, press the Menu button to enter menu options.
- 2. Press the '+' or '-' buttons and select "Auto Scan" function, press the Menu button and start scanning.
- 3. It appears the auto scanning on the LCD. The frequency changes by 0.1 Khz.  $\,$
- 4. After finishing it, it changes to Preset mode in which you can select previously saved channels (50 preset channels are provided), then channel 01 is automatically played.

## ■ Manual Memorizing the Current Station



















- 1. During FM mode, long click the Menu button to enter preset mode.
- 2. Function the '+' or '-' buttons to select the location to memorize , then click the Menu button.
- 3. It pops up the menu window, with the '+' or '-' buttons to select Save and then click the Menu button to apply it. Then the current frequency is added to the Preset channel.
- 4. Push the REW button to exit.
- \* Listen: Listen to the current channel.
- \* Save: The current frequency is allocated (added) to the Preset channel.
- \* Delete: The current Preset channel is deleted.

### Preset mode



During FM mode, enter the preset mode to listen to the save channels.

It appears 01 on the LCD during preset mode.

### ■ Delete Channels















- 1. During FM mode, long click the Menu button and enter the preset mode.
- 2. Function the '+' or '-' buttons and select the channel.
- 3. Press the MENU button and pop up the menu window.
- 4. Function the '+' or '-' buttons and  $\,$  select Delete, then press the MENU button to apply it.
- 5. Press the REW button to exit.

### To Record FM















- 1. During FM mode, function the FF/REW button to select the desired FM radio, click the MENU button.
- 2. Function the '+' or '-' buttons to select FM Record.
- 3. Click the MENU button, then start FM recording.
- 4. Long press the REC/A-B button to stop it.
- 5. It returns to the current FM Radio.

### Note:

During FM mode, or you can long press the REC/A-B button to start the recording.

### ■ MIC Recording













- 1. After turning the player on, long press the MODE/EQ button, then switch into Voice recording mode.
- 2. Long press the REC/A-B button and start recording.
- 3. Click the button again, you can pause it. Long press it to stop.

Note: 1) Please make sure the battery volume is enough during Voice Recording. If it displays "The Memory is Full!" on the LCD, to record, delete files and/or folders on the player in order to make some space available. 2) Shortcut Recording: Long press the REC/A-B button to start Voice Recorder immediately. 3) Only the REC/A-B button is useable during recording.

### ■ Play Recording Files













During MIC voice recording, the recorded file is saved under the REC\ root. The file name is V001.WAV, or V002.WAV, or V003.WAV and etc.. During FM recording, the recorded file is saved under the FM\ root. The file name is F001.WAV, or F002.WAV, or F003.WAV and etc..

- 1. After finish recording, long press the MODE/EQ button, it displays the MODE selection.
- 2. With the FF/REW button, select the Music mode, then click the MENU button.
- 3. With the FF/REW button, you can find and play the recorded files.



- When you select and option with the '+' and '-', press the 'Menu' button, the selection is applied.

# 4. A-B Repeat



- This is the feature to set the A-B Repeat during Music mode.
- You can choose: A-B Repeat, Rewind 3sec., Rewind 5sec., Rewind 8sec., Rewind 10sec., Rewind 15sec., Rewind 20sec., Rewind 30sec., Rewind 60sec..
- Click 'A-B Repeat' and press the 'Menu' button.

# 5. Battery Type



- This is the menu to directly set the battery type used.
- Since the measurement of the Remaining Battery Charge depends on the battery type, you need to choose the correct one.
- You can choose either 'Alkaline' or 'Rechargeable'. We officially recommend a 1.2 to 1.5V nickel hydride fast rechargeable dry cell or alkaline battery for the player.
- Select 'Battery Type' and press the 'Menu' button.
   Then choose a battery type with the '+' and '-' buttons.

# 6. Load Default



- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  This is the menu to return to the default setting originally.
- · Select 'Load Default'.

### 2. ScreenOff - Spar



- · This is the visualization effect provided by the player itself, it can be set sparkling after the screen close up.

# **Guide to Firmware Upgrade**

#### ■ What is Firmware?

Firmware is a program embedded in the hardware, which activates various features. By upgrading, you can enhance the features and eliminate the bugs.

#### ■ Notice for Legal Limitations and Responsibilities Regarding Firmware

- 1/ The performance and menu of MP3 Player may change without prior notice through firmware upgrades of regular or beta versions supported by the manufacturer.
- 2/ We recommend that users should personally back up important MP3 files and data saved in MP3 player to their PC before upgrading the firmware.
- 3/ All firmware upgrades are intended for overall enhancement of performance. The upgrades will be provided when available based on our company's judgment.
- 4/ Some beta versions of the firmware included in our development roadmap may have minor bugs that will be corrected in the official versions of the firmware. We are warning you beforehand of this possibility through this Guide.

# ■ Conditions for Firmware Upgrade

- 1/Up grading the firmware requires the basic environment where the UMS feature of the Windows OS works properly.
- 2/ You can check the player in 'My Computer' on Windows 98/ME/XP/2000/2003.
- 3/ 'Mobile Disk' must be displayed for a firmware upgrade to be possible. If it is not displayed, we recommend that you check the menu that asks whether or not to use a USB Device from the main board CMOS, or reinstall Windows, or have the USB port on the main board examined.

# Downloading and Installing Firmware

You can download the latest firmware from our website free of charge. In order to upgrade the firmware of the player, you need the firmware upgrade program and the firmware data file, which are provided separately.



# Trouble Shooting

The player does not power on.	Check that the battery 's polarity is correct. Check the voltage of battery. Replace it with a new one. Remove the battery and insert it again. Check whether the HOLD switch on the player is ON (Switch to OFF position) Check whether it was failed upgrading the firmware, upgrade it again.
There is no sound.	Check that there are mp3 files in the memory. Check whether VOLUME is set to "0". Connect the earphones/remote plug firmly. Corrupted MP3 or WMA files may make a static noise & the sound may cut off. Check your files on the PC to see if they are corrupted.
Characters in LCD are broken.	Check out Menu Display Language and confirm whether the right language has been selected. If the problem continues, contact our AS Center.
Poor FM reception	Adjust the position of the player and earphones. Turn off the power of other electric devices nearby the player. Earphones function as the antenna. FM reception sensitivity may be weak and you may not be able to hear FM Radio clearly depending on where you are, such as inside a building or a moving car, or on some stretches of a subway.
Failed download of MP3 file	Check the connection between your computer and the player to ensure that the cable is secure. Check the Manager program to make sure it is operating. Check whether the player's Memory is full.
