



# **Charge Batteries**

- 1. Press the OPEN button to release the latch and open the player.
- 2. Remove the battery compartment cover inside the player.
- 3. Insert the two supplied 1400mAH rectangular NiMH rechargeable batteries. Ensure the batteries are inserted properly by matching the + and - on each battery with the symbols on the player.
- 4. Replace the battery compartment cover. Close the player.
- 5. Connect the supplied AC adapter into the DC IN JACK on the side of the
- player. Let the batteries charge for at least five hours before using the player.6. When the batteries are charged, unplug the AC adapter and disconnect it from the player.

Note: Do not play CDs with the RioVolt while the batteries are charging.

**Play Disc** 

Press and slide the OPEN button to release the latch and open the player.
Insert an audio CD or MP3/WMA CD into the player, label side up.

1. Press the PLAY/PAUSE ► II button to turn on the player and begin playback.
