Using earphones and external microphone When earphones are connected, sound output from speaker will be muted.

2. Press REVERSE or FORWARD to set beep sound ON/OFF. 3. Press MENU to confirm selection.

Setting the Time

REVERSE or FORWARD to increase/decrease the number, press MENU to confirm. Once the hour field is entered, the digits in the minute field will flash.

digits in the month field will flash (default is 1). Press REVERSE or FORWARD to increase/decrease the number, press MENU to confirm.

Bookmark

Creating a bookmark This feature allows you to create an interception point in the recorded message for quick reference.
