Installing the Drivers:

Windows 98, Windows 2000, and Windows ME



You must install the driver from the included CD-ROM before installing the hardware. Refer to the uninstall procedure if required to begin a clean installation process.

- 1. Insert the Installation CD-ROM provided with the modem.
- 2. Click **Install** in the dialog box to begin the installation process.
- 3. Click **OK** to install the appropriate modem driver on your system.
- 4. When the installation is complete, the dialog box will appear. Click Exit.
- 5. Proceed to the hardware installation procedure.

Windows NT 4.0

- 1. Follow the hardware installation procedure first before continuing with the driver installation.
- 2. Insert the Installation CD-ROM provided with the modem.
- 3. Click **Install** in the dialog box to begin the installation process.
- 4. Click **OK** to install the appropriate modem driver on your system.
- 5. Click **OK** to restart your computer.

Windows XP

- 1. Follow the hardware installation procedure first before continuing with the driver installation.
- 2. Insert the Installation CD-ROM provided with the modem.
- 3. Click **Install** in the dialog box to begin the installation process.
- 4. Click **OK** to install the appropriate modem driver on your system.
- 5. When the installation is complete, the dialog box will appear. Click Exit.



Installing the Hardware:

- 1. Turn off and unplug the computer and all peripherals. Open the computer case and discharge any static electricity by grounding yourself (touch the power supply, etc. or wear a grounding strap).
- 2. Carefully insert and secure the modem into an open PCI slot and close the computer.



3. Connect the modem **Line** input to an analog phone jack using an RJ-11 phone cable. Optionally connect a telephone to the **Phone** input on the modem card. Reconnect the peripherals and start the computer.

Uninstall Procedure:

- 1. Insert the CD-ROM provided with the modem.
- 2. Open the CD-ROM from the desktop and double-click the "LT Remove.exe" application.
