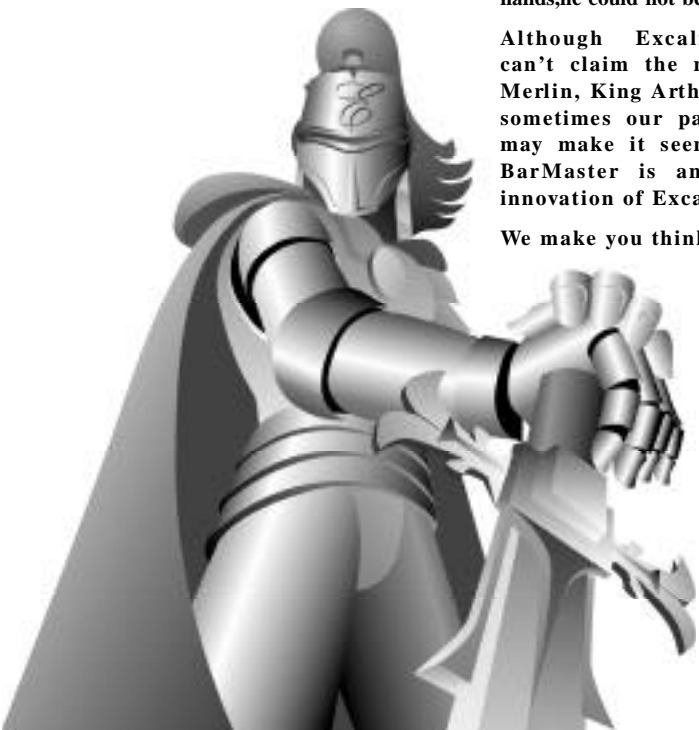

BarMaster is easy to use, but be sure to use it safely. Before starting, please read this manual thoroughly, especially noting safety, care and battery information. Keep this manual for reference.

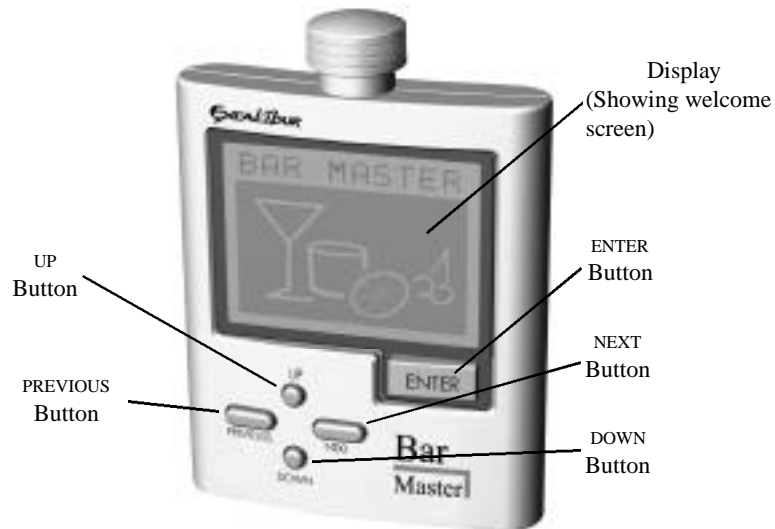
Activating the Batteries or Installing New Batteries

Carefully turn BarMaster over so that the display side is face-down on a soft surface, such as a towel or magazine. Find the battery compartment on the left of the unit's back. (See diagram on page 9.)

Your BarMaster comes with two AG10 batteries already loaded, but you must activate them. To do this, you do not have to remove the battery compartment. Simply pull out

the white tab. Batteries should always be installed by an adult. When you need to replace the batteries, press and slide the battery door off. Remove the used batteries, disposing of them properly, and replace them with two fresh AG10 batteries, making sure the polarity (+ and -) matches the diagram in the compartment. Then replace the battery compartment door.

BarMaster Buttons

BarMaster's four navigation buttons make it easy to find the information you want.

UP

Use this button to scroll up while in menu mode or to page up while in reading mode.

DOWN

Use this button to scroll down while in menu mode or to page down while in reading mode.

PREVIOUS

Use this button to return to the

previous selection or to the main menu (when in menu mode).

Use it also to move to the left while in selection mode—i.e., when selecting the first letter of a drink's name.

NEXT

Use this button to page down while in menu mode and to move right while in selection mode.

ENTER

Use this key to turn BarMaster on and to confirm menu selection.

Using Your BarMaster

Press and hold the ENTER button for two seconds to turn the BarMaster on. A welcome screen showing the word "BARMAS-TER" and images of beverage glasses will be displayed.

Press ENTER again to open the main menu. You'll use this menu to find the information you want. (You can return to the main menu from any screen by pressing the PREVIOUS key up to three times, depending on which screen you are viewing.)

The main menu on the right is displayed five lines (down) at a time, including the title. Lines are dis-

played up to ten characters, but highlighting the longer items will cause them to scroll from right to left, spelling out the category.

On the initial screen, the categories are displayed only down to "MIXERS + MODIFIERS." Use the DOWN button to reveal the rest.

Finding a Drink

You can find out everything you want to know about popular drinks from an Absolute Salty Dog to a Zorbatini. You can find them by name, category, liquor, and by occasion.

Finding Drinks by Name

Step 1. On the main menu page, use the UP and DOWN keys to highlight "DRINKS" on the Main Menu and press ENTER.

The following new menu is displayed. If longer than 10 characters, an item will scroll from left to right when highlighted.

NAME
CATEGORY
LIQUOR
OCCASION

Step 2. From the drinks menu, highlight "NAME" and press ENTER. The letters of the alphabet will be displayed.

Step 3. Use any of the four navigation keys to highlight the first letter of the name of the drink you wish to select and press ENTER.

(Drinks like "7 & 7" that begin with numbers, are found under "A.")

For example, you can select "T" to find "Tom Collins." The drinks beginning with "T" will be displayed. From any letter grouping, you can scroll to the letter grouping before and the one after. For example, from the "T's" you can scroll up to the drinks beginning with "S" and down to the drinks beginning with "U."

Step 4. Use the UP, DOWN, and NEXT keys to highlight the desired drink and press ENTER.

A new, information menu will be displayed:

CATEGORY
GLASS TYPE
OCCASION
RECIPE
TECHNIQUE

Step 5. Highlighting one of these categories and pressing ENTER will reveal information about the drink. After choosing a category, you can return to the above menu by pressing the PREVIOUS button.

If no button is pressed in approximately four minutes, your BarMaster will turn itself off to save batteries. To turn it on again, press and hold the ENTER key for two seconds.

Finding Drinks by Category

Step 1. On the main menu page, use the UP and DOWN keys to highlight “DRINKS” on the Main Menu and press ENTER.

Step 2. Select “CATEGORY” from the drinks menu and press ENTER. A list of 14 categories will be displayed. Although only five lines are displayed at one time, you can use the DOWN key to reveal the remaining categories.

Step 3. Use any of the four navigation keys to highlight the category you wish to select. For example, you can select “HOT DRINKS,” and all hot drinks will be listed.

Step 4. Use the UP, DOWN, and NEXT keys to highlight the desired drink and press ENTER.

Once again, the information menu will be displayed:

Step 5. Highlighting one of these categories and pressing ENTER will reveal information about the drink. After choosing a category, you can return to the above menu

by pressing the PREVIOUS button.

Finding Drinks by Liquor

Step 1. On the main menu page, use the UP and DOWN keys to highlight “DRINKS” on the Main Menu and press ENTER.

Step 2. From the drinks menu, highlight “LIQUOR” and press ENTER. The letters of the alphabet will be displayed.

Step 3. Use any of the four navigation keys to highlight the first letter of the name of the liquor you wish to select and press ENTER.

For example, you can select “D” to find “DARK RUM” or “R” to find all types of “RUM.” All drinks containing the type of liquor selected will be displayed.

From any letter grouping, you can scroll to the letter grouping before and the one after.

Step 4. Use the UP, DOWN, and NEXT keys to highlight the desired drink and press ENTER.

Once again, the information menu will be displayed:

CATEGORY
GLASS TYPE
OCCASION
RECIPE
TECHNIQUE

Step 5. Highlighting one of these categories and pressing ENTER will reveal information about the drink. After choosing a category, you can return to the above menu by pressing the PREVIOUS button.

Finding Drinks by Occasion

Step 1. On the main menu page, use the UP and DOWN keys to highlight “DRINKS” on the Main Menu and press ENTER.

Step 2. Select “OCCASION” from the drinks menu and press ENTER. A list of nine occasions (including “ALL”) will be displayed.

Step 3. Use any of the four navigation keys to highlight the occa-

sion you wish to select.

Step 4. Use the UP, DOWN, and NEXT keys to highlight the desired drink and press ENTER.

Once again, the information menu will be displayed:

CATEGORY
GLASS TYPE
OCCASION
RECIPE
TECHNIQUE

Step 5. Highlighting one of these categories and pressing ENTER will reveal information about the drink. After choosing a category, you can return to the above menu by pressing the PREVIOUS button.

Finding Other Information

The main menu gives you access to lots of other information:

DRINKS
SETTING UP
MEASURES
MIXERS + MODIFIERS
FOOD + DRINK
SLANG
BLOOD ALCOHOL LEVEL
CALCULATOR

We’ve seen how to use “DRINKS” to find the drink you’re looking for by drink, category, type of liquor or occasion. Selecting any of the main menu items and pressing ENTER will give you access to helpful facts and tips.

Blood Alcohol Level Calculator

Step 1. On the main menu page, use the UP and DOWN keys to highlight “BLOOD ALCOHOL LEVEL CALCULATOR” on the Main Menu and press ENTER.

Step 2. You will be presented with the warning message given at the beginning of this section.

Use the DOWN key to read this warning carefully.

Step 3. When you finish reading the warning, press DOWN again, and a list of weights from 100 pounds to 240 pounds will be displayed.

Use the UP and DOWN keys to highlight your weight and press ENTER.

Step 4. The display will give you

information regarding what constitutes one drink. Use the DOWN key to scroll to the end of this information, and a list of the number of drinks will be displayed.

Use the UP and DOWN keys to highlight the number of drinks. Press ENTER.

Step 5. The display will list periods of time since the last drink. Select and highlight a time and press ENTER.

Blood alcohol level will be displayed as a percentage.

Press ENTER again to return to the list of weights to recalculate a different blood alcohol percentage.

Special Care & Handling

- Avoid moisture and extreme temperatures.

- For best results, use between the temperatures of 39°F and 100°F (4° C and 38° C).

- Clean using only a slightly damp cloth.

- Do not use cleaners with chemical agents.

Battery Information

- **CAUTION:** Batteries should be removed and replaced by adults only.

- Do not mix old and new batteries.

- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadium) batteries.

- Do not use rechargeable batteries.

- To avoid explosion or leakage, do not dispose of batteries in a fire or attempt to recharge standard or

alkaline batteries.

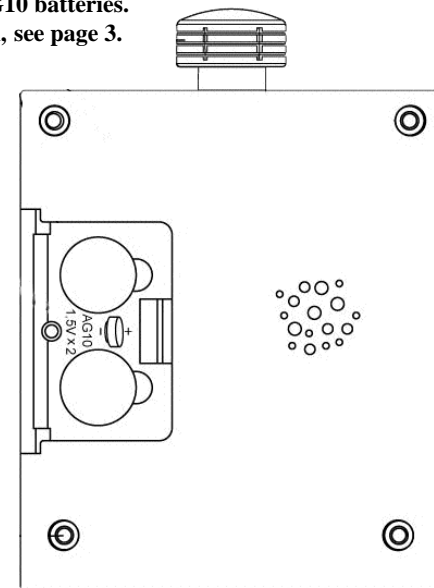
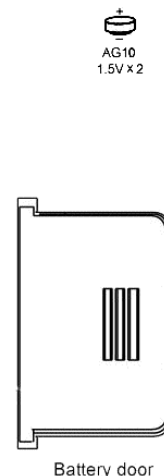
- Be sure to insert batteries with the correct polarities and always follow the toy and battery manufacturer’s instructions.

- Remove batteries and store them in a cool, dry place when not in use.

- Always remove old and dead batteries from the product.

- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

The battery compartment is accessible from the back of your unit. Your unit uses 2 AG10 batteries. For battery activation and installation, see page 3.

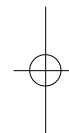
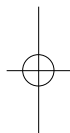
