To operate the CD player

Button/Switch	Function/Operation
1 SOUND/AVLS ^{*1}	Use to emphasize the bass-boosted sound. Press repeatedly to select BASS or BASS . BASS enhances more than BASS . ^{*2}
2 P MODE/◀ (play mode/repeat)	Also use to keep down the maximum volume to protect your hearing. Press and hold until “AVLS” appears in the display. The AVLS function is turned on. To turn off the AVLS function, press and hold again until “AVLS” disappears.
3 VOL +/-	Press to adjust the volume.
4 ◀◀/▶▶ (AMS ^{*3} /search)	Press ◀◀ or ▶▶ once to find the beginning of the current/next track. Press ◀◀ or ▶▶ repeatedly to find the beginning of the previous/succeeding tracks. Press and hold ◀◀ or ▶▶ to go backward/forward quickly.
5 ▶▶ (play/pause)	Press to start play. Press again to pause play. To play from the first track, press for 2 seconds or more while the CD player is stopped.
6 ■ (stop)	Press to stop playing.
7 HOLD	Use to lock the controls to prevent accidental button presses.
8 G-PROTECTION	Set it to ON to protect against sound skipping. ^{*4}

*1 AVLS = Automatic Volume Limiter System
*2 If the sound is distorted when using the SOUND function, turn down the volume.
*3 AMS = Automatic Music Sensor
*4 Sound may skip:
– if the CD player receives stronger continuous shock than expected,
– if a dirty or scratched CD is played or
– when using poor-quality CD-Rs/CD-RWs or if there is a problem with the recording device or application software.

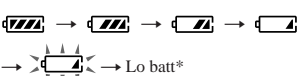
