TO DISCONNECT THE FLASH MEMORY DRIVE:

(A) Windows 2000/XP/VISTA:

Double click on this icon () located at the lower right corner of your screen; the "Safely Remove Hardware" window will pop-up. Select the name of the flash drive from the window and click the STOP button. Another window titled "Stop a Hardware Device" will pop-up. Confirm the flash drive name to be removed and click the OK button. A confirmation message will appear on screen letting you know it is safe to remove the flash drive. You can now remove the device from the USB port.

NOTES:

- Before unplugging the device from the USB port, please make sure the message box "Safe to Remove Hardware" has popped up. You may lose the saved data if you remove the device prior to seeing this message.
- Never partition your device when using the Windows 2000 operating system.
- Removing the flash drive when the LED is ON or flashing may result in data loss. Please follow the instructions above for proper removal.

(B) Mac OS 9.x or above:


