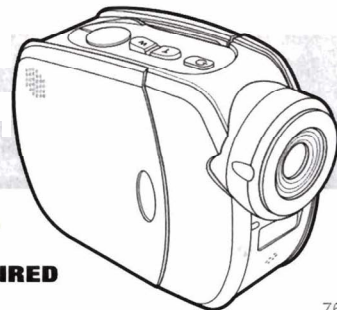

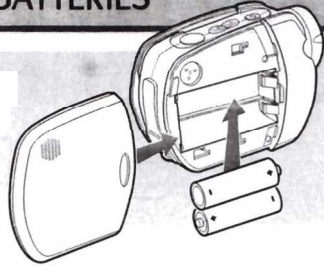
**BATTERIES REQUIRED**

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## TO INSERT BATTERIES

Open cover. Insert 2 x 1.5V "AA" or R6 size batteries (not included). Alkaline batteries recommended. Close cover.



### **CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE**

1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions;
2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries;
3. Always remove weak or dead batteries from the product.

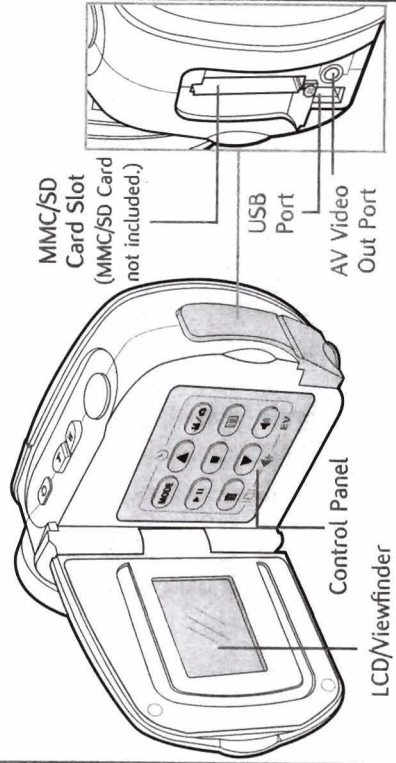
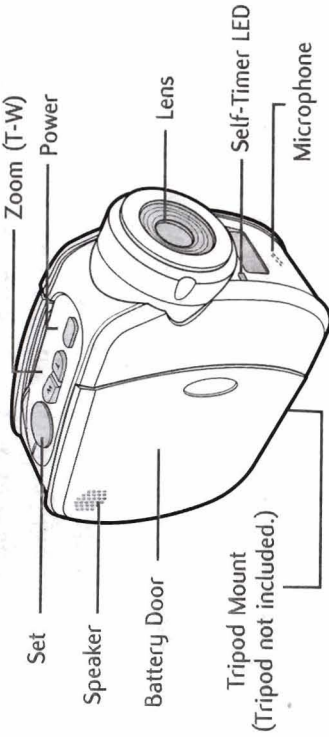

### **CAUTION:**

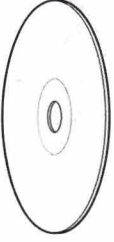
1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert item correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.

3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
6. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.

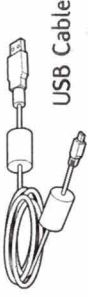

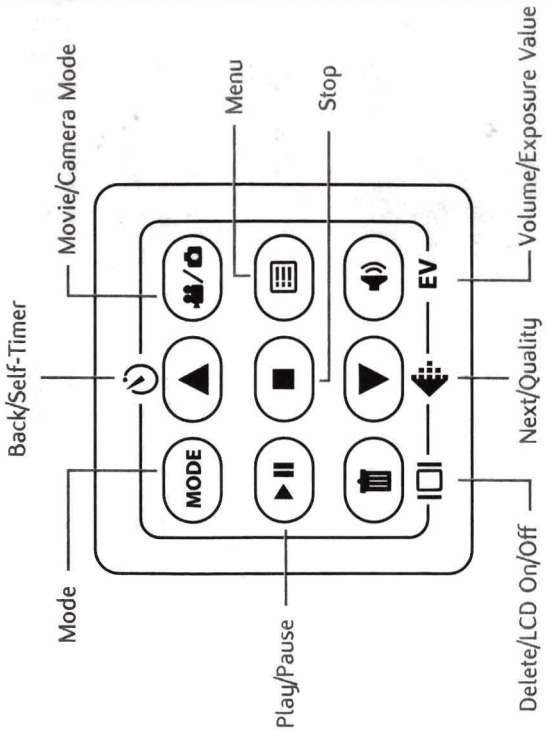

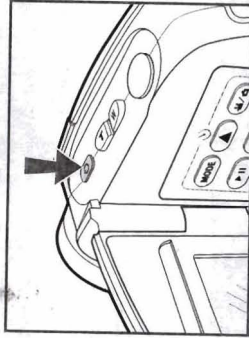
## CONTROL PANEL

Press the Power button to turn your Digital Video Camera ON.

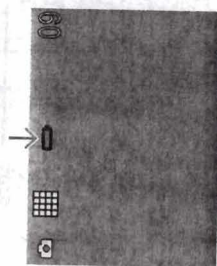
Press the Power button again to turn your Digital Video Camera OFF.




## LOW BATTERY POWER INDICATOR




If your batteries are running low, you will see a battery icon  appear on the top center of the LCD/Viewfinder.

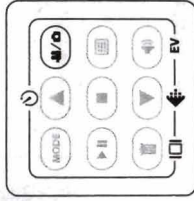


If your batteries are about to run out, you will see a blinking battery icon  appear on the top center of the LCD/Viewfinder. At this point, you'll have 10 seconds before your Digital Video Camera will automatically turn off.

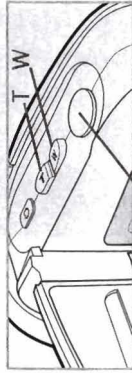
## MOVIES

### HOW TO RECORD A MOVIE

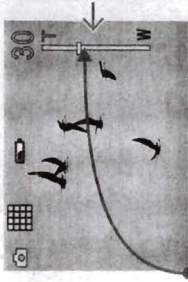
1. Press the  button until you see the movie icon appear on the LCD/Viewfinder.



2. Press the Zoom button, T or W, to adjust the frame of your movie.

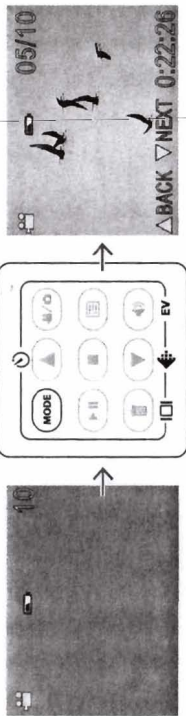

4. Press Set to stop recording.

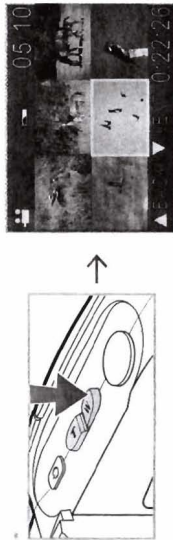

## HOW TO PLAYBACK A MOVIE

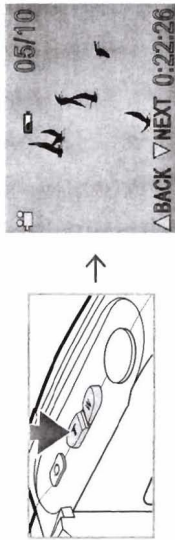
1. Press the "Mode" button to enter playback mode.





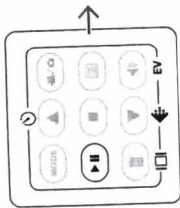
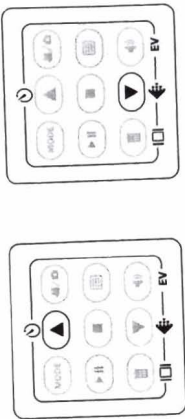
2. Press the W on the Zoom button to view multiple images of the movies on the camera.




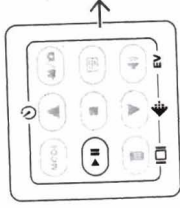
3. Press the T on the Zoom button to view a single image.



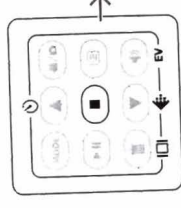
4. Use the  and  buttons to select the movie you wish to view.

6. Press the  button to pause the movie.



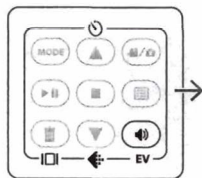
7. Press the  button to stop the movie.

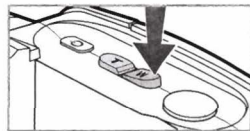
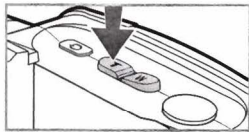
### HOW TO TAKE A PICTURE

1. Press the  button until you see the camera icon appear on the LCD/Viewfinder.

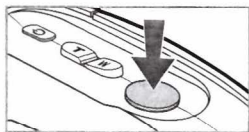


2. To set the resolution of your picture, press  to switch between 2048 x 1536, 1600 x 1200 or 640 x 480.

3. Press the Zoom button, T or W, to adjust the frame of your picture.

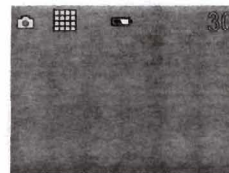
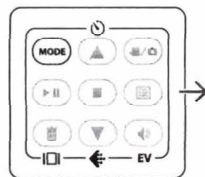


4. Press Set to take a picture.

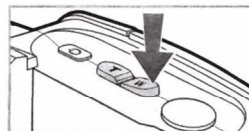
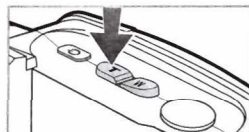


### HOW TO REVIEW A PICTURE

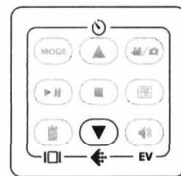
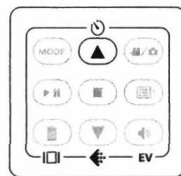
1. Press the "Mode" button to enter playback mode.



2. Press the T or W on the Zoom button to preview one picture or multiple pictures on the LCD/Viewfinder.



3. Press  or  to select the picture that you want to view.



NOTE: If you have an MMC/SD Card inserted (not included), your picture will be automatically stored to the MMC/SD Card, not the internal memory and will be reviewed from this location. If you want to take pictures and review them from the internal memory only, remove the MMC/SD Card.

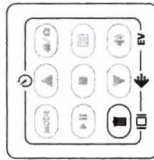
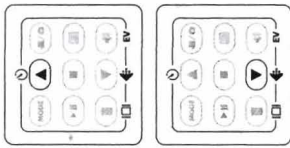
## DELETE ONE

This mode allows you to delete one movie or picture at a time.

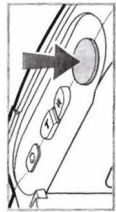
1. Press the "Mode" button to enter playback mode.



2. Use the and buttons to select a specific movie or picture and then press the button. The screen will say "DELETE ONE?"



3. Press Set to confirm the deletion.

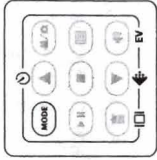


4. Press the button to keep your picture or movie and exit back to the picture or movie menu screen.

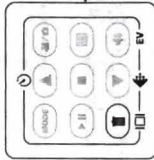
## DELETE ALL

This mode allows you to delete all of your pictures and movies at once.

1. Press the "Mode" button to enter playback mode.



2. Press the button twice. The screen will say "DELETE ALL?"



3. Press Set to confirm the deletion.



4. Press the button to keep your pictures or movies and exit back to the picture or movie menu screen.

## HOW TO INSTALL THE SOFTWARE ON YOUR COMPUTER

[PC Compatible Only]

The VCAMNOW 2.0 software will help you transfer your picture and movie files from your Digital Video Camera to your computer.


1. Place the CD into your computer's CD drive.
2. Follow the on-screen installation instructions.

If the CD does not begin automatically, double-click "My Computer" then double-click the CD icon with the name "VCAMNOW 2.0." Double-click the "Install" icon and follow the on-screen installation instructions.

Once the software has been installed, refer to the software user guide for instructions. To read the software user guide, go to Start > Programs > VCamNow 2.0 > Software User Guide.

## WEBCAM

### HOW TO USE YOUR DIGITAL VIDEO CAMERA AS A WEB CAM

Once connected to your computer, the Digital Video Camera can be used as a Web Cam displaying live, real-time action! To use your Digital Video Camera as a Web Cam, press the  button on your camera once it's connected to your computer.


May be used with Web Cam compatible software or capture live video with MaxConsole 2.0 software (included on CD).

To capture live video, launch MaxConsole 2.0, click on the Import tab, and click on Cam Capture Genie button.

## MEMORY

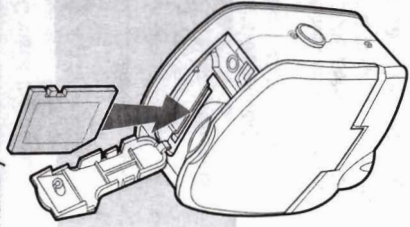
### MEMORY FULL



If your 32MB built-in memory and/or MMC/SD Memory Card is full, you will not be able to take any more pictures or record any more movies. The LCD/Viewfinder will display  for 2 seconds. When this happens, you can either delete some of your pictures and movies to make room for new ones, or transfer them to your computer, then go back and delete them from the memory.

### MEMORY CARD INSTALLATION

MMC/SD Memory Card not included.



1. To install an MMC/SD Memory Card, first turn off the power.
2. Open the door.
3. Insert the MMC/SD Memory Card into the slot.
4. Close the door.
