Product Description

The PS6PM5C-10 ten slot charging cradle is designed to simplify the charging and storing of multiple Palm devices. The cradle employs a universal power supply that accommodates line voltages from 100VAC to 240VAC. This internal power supply accepts standard IEC line cords. The power supplied to each cradle station is designed to mimic the characteristics of the Palm power adapter supplied with the device. Each station provides a current limit by means of a self-resetting thermal fuse.

Troubleshooting Matrix

Problem	Solution
Cradle is not charging device(s)	Ensure that the charging cradle is receiving line voltage and that the power switch is turned on.
	Ensure that one of the Palm devices is occupying the first slot of the cradle.
	Remove Palm from slot wait five minutes and re-insert. If Palm device is suspect, check with power adapter supplied by Palm.
